Player Of The Week

Alan Williams • UC Santa Barbara
Jr. • 6-7 • Forward
Phoenix, Ariz./North HS

UC Santa Barbara junior Alan Williams captured his second straight Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award with back-to-back impressive performances against Pac-12 foes, one of which keyed a victory against Cal.

The 6-7 forward averaged 23.5 points and 10.0 rebounds as the Gauchos lost a hard fought battle to UCLA (89-76) and toppled Cal (72-65) for the first time in school history. Williams shot 59.4 (19 of 32) percent from the field in doing the majority of his damage in the second halves of both games.

Against the Bruins, Williams poured in 17 of his game-high 23 points in the second half as UCSB was tied with the nation's 16th-ranked squad with just over eight minutes remaining. He hit 1-of-2 free throws to tie the game for the last time at 64 with 8:21 to play in the game. Williams added eight rebounds.

Williams notched his second double-double of the season with 24 points and 12 rebounds in the win over the Bears. It was the first win in 10 tries against Cal. Williams energized the Gauchos with 20 second half points, helping UCSB take a 40-34 lead with a natural three-point play at 15:04 left in the game. After Cal scored six straight to narrow UCSB's advantage to 60-55, another three-point play by Williams widened the lead. This is the fourth career Big West Player of the Week award for Williams.

On The Rebound: Cal Poly extinguished a brief two-game losing streak, holding Santa Clara to 38.0 percent shooting in a 64-53 victory on Saturday. The Mustangs won at home for the 14th time

in the last 15 games, and remain idle until Saturday's game against Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Nwaba Breaks Out: Sophomore Dave Nwaba scored a career-high 21 points in 20 minutes to pace the Mustangs to victory against Santa Clara. It was the sixth time in eight games that Nwaba reached double figures in scoring.

Eversley Equals Career Rebounding High: Senior Chris Eversley matched his career high with 15 rebounds against the Broncos, and notched double-digit boards for the third time in the last four games. Eversley ranks third in the Big West with 8.6 rebounds per game.

Ball Control: The Mustangs continue to handle the ball with care. They have committed 11 or fewer turnovers in seven of the eight games.

Ups And Downs: Cal State Northridge looked impressive in a 27-point blowout of Southern Utah on Tuesday, shooting 50.0 percent or better for the third time in four games. However, two nights

later against Seattle, the Matadors were held to their lowest point total of the season in a 58-53 loss.

Hicks Hits Milestone: Cal State Northridge junior Stephan Hicks knocked down two free throws early in Tuesday's game against Southern Utah to cement his standing as the 17th player in school history to score 1,000 career points. Hicks finished with his fifth consecutive game of 20 points or more. He sits at No. 2 in the Big West in scoring (18.4 ppg).

Nice Company: Senior Josh Greene (1,121) and Hicks (1,031) make CSUN the only school in the Big West with two active career 1,000-point scorers.

Edmerson Protecting The Rim: Sophomore Tre Hale-Edmerson has blocked 10 shots over the last three games, and now ranks fourth in the league with 1.8 blocks per game.

Stop The Streak: The 49ers take a break from their brutal non-conference schedule with a 12-day break, before taking on local rival USC on Dec. 19. LBSU has lost nine straight games, the program's longest in one season since dropping 10 straight in 2003-04.

Samuels Stands Out: Junior David Samuels produced his first career double-double as a 49er with 15 points and 11 rebounds against North Carolina State. The 6-7 forward has scored in double figures two of the last three outings.

Jennings Keeps It Coming: Senior Dan Jennings is averaging 16.7 points and 6.0 rebounds over the last three games and is shooting .575 (23-of-40) during that same span. He stands fourth in the conference in rebounds per game (8.3).

Shooting Struggles: Improvement in overall and three-point shooting is among the top items on the LBSU holiday wish list. The 49ers rank last in the Big West in field goal percentage (.399) and are tied for last in three-point marksmanship (.267).
