Player Of The Week

Michael Bryson • UC Santa Barbara
So. • 6-4 • Guard
Sacramento, Calif./Foothill HS

UC Santa Barbara sophomore Michael Bryson notched Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week accolades as he recorded a season-high in points in a big road victory.

The 6-4 guard amassed 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting in UCSB's 72-61 win at San Diego, which entered the game at 8-3 and without a loss by more than five points. Bryson scored 11 first half points, sinking 3-for-3 from three-point range and 4-for-5 overall to help UCSB take a 34-30 lead at the break. Bryson's performance came as Alan Williams, the team's leading scorer and rebounder, sat out the final 17:09 of the first half in foul trouble.

Bryson maintained his production in the second half and finished with a season-high five three-pointers (in seven attempts) and connected on 8-of-12 from the field overall. He added four rebounds, two assists, a block and a steal in 33 minutes of action.

The three-point shooting display was all the more impressive as USD entered the contest ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense at 27 percent. UCSB hit 45 percent for the game.

Two In A Row: Cal Poly won its second straight game, scoring a season-high in points to defeat Cal State Dominguez Hills, 85-49, on Saturday. The Mustangs were victorious for the 15th

time in their last 16 contests played at the Mott Athletics Center.

Long Range Loving: The Mustangs set season highs for three-pointers made (12) and three-point field goal percentage (.500) in the win over Cal State Dominguez Hills. In six minutes off the bench, freshman Taylor Sultive hit all five of his shots, including four treys, for a career-high 14 points.

Nwaba Outstanding: Sophomore Dave Nwaba posted his second consecutive 20-point game, scoring a game-high 22 points against the Toros. Nwaba leads the Mustangs with seven double-digit scoring games. He is also shooting 73.7 percent (42 of 57) from the field over the last seven games.

Ball Control: Cal Poly is tied for 12th nationally in fewest turnovers per game (9.9).

Titans Set Highs: Cal State Fullerton tallied a season-best in points in its 87-80 home win over Texas Southern on Sunday. Two Titans scored 20 points for the first time in a game this season as senior Michael Williams had 24 and junior Alex Harris 21.

Williams Keeps Rolling: Williams delivered his 11th straight game with double-digit points in the Texas Southern victory. His 24 points was the most by a Titan this season. The point guard ranks eighth in the Big West with 15.5 points per game.

Definite Correlation: Cal State Fullerton improved to 4-0 this year when shooting better than 50 percent. The Titans knocked down 54.4 (31 of 57) percent from the field against the Tigers. CSF also shot above 50 percent in victories against Montana State, Santa Clara and Pepperdine.

Value The Ball: In committing just nine turnovers against Texas Southern, the Titans won for the third time when finishing with single-digit miscues.

On A Break: Cal State Northridge is in the midst of a two-week hiatus to take fall finals, and resume action this Friday at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. It will be the first time the Matadors take the court since losing on Dec. 5 to Seattle.

Greene Eyes Scoring Top 10: Currently No. 12 in the Matador annals with 1,121 career points, senior Josh Greene is just 38 shy of joining the top 10 list. Calvin Chitwood (2004-08) and George Robnett (1970-74) are tied for 10th.

Maxwell Preparing For 500 Club: Junior Stephen Maxwell, who has five games with double-digit rebounds to his credit, ranks No. 2 in the Big West in rebounds (8.8 rpg). The 6-7 forward is also approaching a career milestone, as he needs just eight more boards to reach 500. He would become the 15th player in CSUN history to accomplish the feat.

Road Win Needed: CSUN is looking for its first non-conference road win in a year. The Matadors defeated Utah, 76-71, on Dec. 21, 2012 for their last such triumph.

Big Game Ahead: Long Beach State hopes a 12-day break in between games is the elixir to snap a nine-game losing streak. For the first time since 2001, the 49ers are hosting USC on Thursday in a game televised on Prime Ticket. LBSU's skid is the longest in one season since dropping 10 straight in 2003-04.

Previous Success: LBSU's last home date against USC resulted in an 86-68 loss on Dec. 12, 2001. But prior to that, the 49ers have had success at home against the Trojans, winning three straight in 1988, 1997 and 1999.

Caffey Steps Up: Junior Mike Caffey has scored in double figures in six straight games, averaging 15.8 points over that span. The point guard had a solid game in his last outing against North Carolina State as he posted 16 points on 7-of-14 shooting with six assists.

Free Throws Improving: The 49ers have exhibited much better accuracy at the free throw line the last two games, connecting at 75.0 (30-of-40) percent. In LBSU's first eight games, the team shot below 70 percent in all of them.
