Player Of The Week

**Tyler Lamb • Long Beach State
Jr. • 6-5 • Guard
Ontario, Calif./UCLA**

Tyler Lamb (Ontario, Calif./UCLA) impressed in his Long Beach State debut, averaging 24.5 points in two victories to capture Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

The UCLA transfer learned hours before tip-off against USC that he had officially become eligible to play as grades following fall exams had been finalized. The timing could not have been more auspicious as Lamb terrorized the Trojans to the tune of 20 points, four rebounds, two assists and three steals in 27 reserve minutes, resulting in a 72-71 victory for the 49ers. The junior made 7 of 15 floor shots, including a pair of three-pointers, and sank all four free throw attempts as LBSU vaporized a nine-game losing streak.

Lamb, a 6-5 guard, also was instrumental in LBSU's 82-75 win over Montana State-Billings. Facing a six-point halftime deficit, the 49ers turned to Lamb and he responded with 24 of his career-high 29 points in the second half. Lamb scored LBSU's first nine points of the half in less than three minutes. In all, he notched 21 points during a 25-12 run that created some separation from the Yellowjackets. Lamb finished the game 9-of-17 from the field and 4-of-8 from three-point range.

For the week, Lamb shot 50 percent (16-of-23) from the field, 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from three-point range and 91.7 percent (11-of-12) at the foul line as the 49ers won back-to-back games for the first time this season.

Eversley Tops 20: Senior Chris Eversley posted his second 20-point effort of the 2013-14 campaign in Cal Poly's 79-59 loss at Loyola Marymount on Tuesday. The forward notched 21 points on 9-of-16 shooting against the Lions. Eversley is now 117 points away from reaching the 1,000 point mark for his career.

Big Road Win: Cal State Northridge upended Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, 67-66, on Friday to secure the program's first non-conference road win in a year. The Matadors defeated Utah on Dec.

21, 2012 for their previous non-league road win. CSUN shot a season second-best 52.3 (23-of-44) percent against the Islanders. CSUN has won four of its last five contests heading into this Friday's home matchup with Morgan State.

Maxwell Joins 500 Club: Junior Stephen Maxwell yanked down 11 rebounds in a 79-69 victory over Idaho on Sunday to increase his career total to 505 boards. He became just the 15th player in Matador history to surpass 500 rebounds for his career. Maxwell recorded 10 or more boards for the sixth time this season.

Tre-Hale Storm: Sophomore Tre-Hale Edmerson played a big role in the win over Idaho. The 6-7 forward gobbled up a career-high 13 rebounds to help the Matadors to a 47-33 advantage in that category, and he added five assists and three blocked shots.

Streak Silenced: Long Beach State stopped a nine-game losing streak in a big way last week with a win over local non-conference rival USC. The 49ers knocked off the Trojans in a 72-71 thriller,

securing the program's first home win over a Pac-12 school since Dec. 16, 1999. That last win also happened to be against USC.

Lamb Chopped: UCLA transfer Tyler Lamb infused a huge chunk of all around production for the 49ers in his first two games of the season. He had 20 points against USC and 29 more versus Montana State-Billings, and he pestered on defense to help LBSU win back-to-back games for the first time this season.

Monson Moves Up: The win over USC gave head coach Dan Monson his 106th victory at LBSU, making him the second-winningest coach at the school. He is now 107-100 in his seventh season.
