Player Of The Week

Brandon Spearman • Hawai'i
Sr. • 6-3 • Guard
Chicago, Ill./Indian Hills CC

Senior Brandon Spearman secured Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors as he led Hawai'i to a 2-1 record at the prestigious Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic and captured all-tournament honors.

The 6-4 guard averaged 14.3 points per game in lifting UH to back-to-back wins against Saint Mary's and Oregon State. He scored a season-high 17 points in a narrow 62-61 loss to Boise State in the tournament opener, making 6 of 9 shots overall, including 3 of 6 from three-point range.

In a 76-74 triumph over the Gaels, Spearman contributed 12 points and seven rebounds. In UH's 79-73 win over Oregon State, the first meeting against a Pac-12 squad in seven years, Spearman notched 14 points and 10 rebounds for his first career double-double. He also had a pair of assists and shot 5-for-10 from the field.

For the tournament, Spearman shot 53.6 (15-of-28) percent from the floor and 54.5 (6-for-11) from three-point territory. He helped UH to a 9-3 record overall, including wins in seven of the last eight games.

Need Easternly Win: Cal Poly fell to 0-6 on the road this season with Sunday's 79-62 loss at Stanford. It was also the 11th straight non-conference road loss for the Mustangs since upsetting

UCLA at Pauley Pavilion on Nov. 25, 2012. All six road defeats this year have come by double digits. Cal Poly has one more chance to register a non-league road win when it takes the long trip east to face Delaware on Saturday.

Three-Point Tracker: Senior Kyle Odister knocked down two three-pointers against Stanford, marking the 11th time in the last 12 games that the guard has had at least one trey. With 140 career treys, he sits 10th in the Cal Poly record book and needs three more to tie Shawn Lewis (2007-11) for ninth on the list.

Turnover Toppler: The Mustangs continue to do a good job of valuing the ball as their eight turnovers against the Cardinal marked the fifth time this year that they committed single-digit miscues. Cal Poly leads the Big West in fewest turnovers per game (10.6).

Williams Streak Continues: Senior Michael Williams notched 13 points against the Rebels to secure his 13th straight game in double figures, the only Titan to do so this season. The 6-2 guard also has connected for at least one three-pointers in every game.

In the team's last road outing, also in the state of Texas, CSUN nipped Texas A&M-Corpus Christi by one point on Dec. 20.

Maxwell's House: Junior Stephen Maxwell had another dominating performance in CSUN's 86-80 win versus Morgan State on Friday.
