UC Riverside junior Drake Zarate claimed Big West Baseball Field Player of the Week honors after accounting for two game-winning RBI and belting his first career home run against Cal State Fullerton.

As the designated hitter for the Highlanders, Zarate drove in six of their 11 runs to help UCR win the series. He hit .417 (5-for-12) and slugged .667 to keep UCR in fourth place in the Big West.

In Friday's 3-2 victory, Zarate's sac bunt in the top of the second scored David Andriese to give UCR a lead it would not relinquish. On Sunday, Zarate made his first career home run extra memorable with a first-inning grand slam, staking the Highlanders to a 5-0 lead. After the UCR bullpen squandered the advantage to let the game go into extra innings, Zarate was the hero in the top of 11th. With runners at the corners and one out, his base knock to left field scored the winning run in an 8-7 victory.

Zarate, who entered the series with nine RBI on the year, totaled six against the Titans. He notched a career-high five RBI in the finale.

Pitcher Of The Week

UC Santa Barbara junior Austin Pettibone threw a complete game shutout against Cal State Northridge to collect Big West Baseball Pitcher of the Week praise.

The 6-4 right-hander needed just 85 pitches to pace the Gauchos to the 6-0 victory on Saturday. Pettibone scattered just four hits for his second career shutout. He exhibited superb control, throwing a first-pitch strike to 22 of 30 batters and retiring 29 of 30 batters with four pitches or less. Pettibone, who retired the first 10 batters he faced to open the game, struck out five Matadors and finished with no walks.

Pettibone improved to 3-1 on the year and earned the UCSB pitching staff's first shutout of the season. He also earned his 21st career victory, moving into a tie for fourth in program history. He is just one win shy of tying for third.

BIG WEST TID BITS

- The Cal State Fullerton and UC Irvine baseball rivalry highlights this week's docket as postseason potential hangs in the balance. The league-leading (15-3) Anteaters host Cal State Fullerton (8-10), who is coming off back-to-back series losses to Long Beach State and UC Riverside. UC Irvine suffered its first Big West series loss last week at No. 5 Cal Poly.

The first game of the Titan-'Eater showdown will broadcast live on ESPN3 at 6:30 p.m. The final two games of the Big West baseball series from Cicerone Field at Anteater Ballpark will be featured on Prime Ticket with game times listed at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 17 and 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 18.

Also getting some television coverage this week is the match-up at the Riverside Sports Complex where the Highlanders entertain Long Beach State, who has gotten hot down the final stretch of the season. The Dirtbags enter the week having won four straight conference series against No. 17 UCSB, No. 1 CP, CSF and Hawai'i, launching them to third place in the Big West with a 12-6 mark. The Highlanders are coming off a 2-1 series victory over Cal State Fullerton. The Saturday and Sunday contests will be aired live on ESPN3 with game times scheduled for 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m.

No. 5 Cal Poly, who sits second in the league with a 16-5 mark, plays its final conference series of the year at Cal State Northridge (6-12). Hawai'i visits UC Davis and UC Santa Barbara faces San Francisco in a nonconference weekend showdown.

- UC Irvine's Sam Moore collected two saves last week to bump his season total to a nation-best 23, which is also a Big West record. The Rancho Palo Verdes, Calif., native surpassed Long Beach State's Gabe Gonzalez, who recorded 20 saves during the 1995 season. Moore needs just one more save to tie UCLA's David Berg for the nation's top spot, which was set last year. With seven games remaining in the regular season for UC Irvine, and the potential for postseason play, the national mark is well within reach for the Anteater closer.

- The Big West Conference continues to dominate the other west coast conferences (Mountain West, Pac 12, WAC and West Coast), posting an overall record of 98-76-1 (.563) among its western opponents. The league owns a .500-or-better winning percentage against each individual conference as well.

- The Big West Conference led all conferences on the USA Baseball 30-man midseason Golden Spikes Award watch list last week with four student-athletes earning recognition. The quartet includes UC Santa Barbara's Joey Epperson, Cal State Fullerton's Thomas Eshelman, Cal Poly's Matt Imhof and UC Irvine's Andrew Morales. The Golden Spikes Award is presented to the top amateur baseball player in the country.

- UC Irvine pitcher Andrew Morales is one of 10 finalist for the 2014 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate baseball, it was announced last week. To be eligible for this award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. Fans are encouraged to vote on the Senior CLASS Award website through June 9. Fan votes will be combined with media and Division I head coaches' votes to determine the winner. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2014 College World Series® in June.

A total of 19 Big West baseball games will be carried on ESPN3. All games will originate from Southern California member institutions Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, UC Irvine and UC Riverside. Every Big West team will make an appearance on the baseball schedule.

Through the Big West's new mobile production facility, each game will be produced by the Conference utilizing full ESPN production standards, including graphics, replay and on-air crew. It is the first fully operational mobile production unit of its kind that expands upon what ESPN Emerging Technology has already done at the institutional level.

Every game on ESPN's platforms will also be available through WatchESPN, accessible online at WatchESPN.com, on smartphones and tablets via the WatchESPN app, through ESPN on Xbox LIVE to Gold members, on Apple TV and Roku to fans who receive their video subscription from an affiliated provider.
