Player Of The Week

Josh Ritchart • UC Davis
Sr. • 6-9 • Forward
Auburn, Calif./Forest Lake Christian HS

Senior Josh Ritchart stepped into the primary scorer's role to lead UC Davis to a pair of conference road wins and garner the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award.

Ritchart, the team's No. 2 scorer at 13.2 points per game, impacted both wins against UC Irvine (75-56) and CSUN (68-55) as he filled in admirably for the nation's No. 1 3-point shooter and No. 6 scorer, Corey Hawkins, who was unavailable for both contests.

The 6-9 guard/forward averaged 21.5 points and 4.5 rebounds while shooting 70.8 percent (17-of-24) overall and 60 percent (6-of-10) from three, helping the Aggies leave southern California all alone in first place with a Big West record of 8-1.

Ritchart scored a game-high 22 points on 10-of-11 shooting against the Anteaters, including 2 of 3 from three-point range.

He notched another game-high in scoring with 21 points versus the Matadors. Ritchart canned four 3-pointers (in seven attempts), including a crucial one with 1:43 remaining that extended the Aggie lead to nine and sealed the victory. It was his third consecutive 20-point game and sixth of the season.

Streak At Three: The Mustangs are mired in their second three-game conference losing streak after falling, 59-56, to Hawai'i at the Mott Athletics Center on Thursday. Cal Poly's six league defeats

have been by a combined total of 30 points, with four of those losses coming by five points or less.

Threes And Twos: In the loss to Hawai'i, Cal Poly shot 47.8 percent from three-point range, while registering their second-highest season total for makes (11) and attempts (23). However, the Mustangs were only able to muster 13.3 percent shooting on two-point field goal attempts, the team shooting a collective 4-for-30.

Ramping It Up: Junior Joel Awich recorded his second double-double in the last four games with 10 points and 10 rebounds against UH. After scoring in double figures just twice in the first 13 games, he has reeled off eight straight games with 10 or more points.

Bench Boost: Junior Reese Morgan is averaging 15.7 points over his last three appearances.

Streak Broken: Cal State Fullerton wiped away a six-game losing streak last Thursday with a convincing 69-53 win against CSUN, led by Josh Gentry's career-high 19 points. It was the Titans' largest margin of victory over a Division I foe this season.

Overtime Blues: The Titans went for two straight wins on Saturday in a Homecoming showdown against Cal State Fullerton, but lost in overtime for the second time this season against the Highlanders. The Titans have lost a total of three overtime contests in conference play, which makes their 1-7 Big West record a bit misleading.

McBoarder: Senior Steve McClellan tied his season high with 14 rebounds in the win over CSUN, pitching in 15 points to secure his fifth double-double. The 6-7 forward has nine games of 10 or more rebounds, the third-best total in the Big West.

Season High: CSF notched a season-best 13 steals against the Highlanders. It was just the second time this season that the Titans recorded double-digit steals.

Streak Halted: Long Beach State's six-game winning streak came to an end in a heartbreaking 56-55 loss to Black and Blue rival UC Irvine on Saturday. The 49ers have lost four of the last five regular season meetings to the Anteaters by three points or less.

Caffey Now Fourth In Assists: Back-to-back five-assist performances last week gave Mike Caffey 430 assists, moving him from sixth to fourth on the LBSU career list. Caffey surpassed Kevin Houston (423, 2003-07) and Morlon Wiley (425, 1984-88). The 6-0 point guard is now sneaking up on Craig Hodges for the No. 3 spot. Hodges is at 437.

BIG AL JOINS EXCLUSIVE CLUB

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams joined an exclusive Big West club as just the fifth player to collect 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. He eclipsed 1,000 rebounds on Jan. 15 versus CSUN. With 1,014 boards, Williams ranks third in conference history and trails only Cal State Fullerton's Tony Neal (1,115, 1981-85) and Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson (1,208, 2008-12). Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4.

CSUN senior Stephan Hicks became the Big West's all-time leader in career free throws made on Jan. 29 against Hawai'i when he made a pair with 7:37 remaining in the first half. That allowed Hicks to eclipse Long Beach State's Lucious Harris (1989-93), who had held the record of 549 for nearly 20 years. Hicks is now at 559 made free throws. He is also chasing the free throws attempted record, also owned by Harris with 755. Hicks currently has 689.

ESPN TABS HAWKINS ONE OF NATION'S 25 BEST

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, seeking to become Big West scoring champion for the second time in his career, recently was named by ESPN's John Gasaway as one of the nation's 25 players. The 6-3 guard leads the Big West and ranks No. 4 nationally in scoring with 21.3 points per game. He is also the nation's most prolific shooter, ranking No. 1 in three-point field goal percentage (.526).

UC DAVIS COULD JOIN EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Coming off of a 9-22 season, UC Davis has set a Division I record for most victories (18) and is on pace for a 20-win campaign. Should the Aggies accomplish that, they would become only the third team in Big West history to win single-digit games one year and 20 the next. Fresno State (7-20 in 1976-77, 21-6 in 1977-78) and Utah State (4-23 in 1981-82, 20-9 in 1982-83) are the others.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
