Player Of The Week

**Michael Bryson • UC Santa Barbara
Jr. • 6-4 • Guard
Sacramento, Calif./Foothill HS**

Averaging 23.5 points in two conference victories, UC Santa Barbara junior Michael Bryson collected Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

Bryson took hold of the scoring and rebounding reins in the absence of reigning Big West Player of the Year Alan Williams, who missed his sixth and seven straight games with a shoulder injury.

It was Bryson who helped the Gauchos improve to 5-2 without the services of Williams as UCSB knocked off Long Beach State at home, 70-55, and CSUN on the road, 65-57.

The 6-4 guard notched 21 points on 6-of-11 shooting against the 49ers. He knocked down a trio of three-pointers and hit all but one of his seven free throw attempts. Bryson also corralled a game-high nine rebounds.

In avenging an earlier loss this season to the Matadors, the Gauchos leaned on Bryson once again for offense, and he responded with a season-high 26 points and a team-high seven rebounds. He made 9-of-14 floor shots, including 5-of-7 from three-point range, with the five three-point makes tying a season-best.

Bryson has scored 20 or more in three straight and four of the last five games.

This Week In The Big West

• UC Davis travels to Long Beach State for a Thursday night showdown on ESPN3 as the first place Aggies attempt to stretch their lead on the third place 49ers. At 19-4 overall and 9-1 in the Big West, UC Davis is on the verge of some big accomplishments in 2014-15, including:

- Becoming just the third team in Big West history to transition from single-digit wins one season to 20 the next. The other two teams to accomplish that feat – Utah State went 4-23 in 1981-82 and 20-9 in 1982-83, while Fresno State was 7-20 in 1976-77 and 21-6 in 1977-78.

- Going from nine wins last season to 19, UC Davis is one of just 16 clubs in Big West history to make a +10 improvement in the win column. The all-time conference record for greatest win differential over a two-year period is +16.

- With a two-game lead in the standings on second place UC Irvine, the Aggies are in position to become the third team in league history to go from last to first, but the FIRST to do so OUTRIGHT in a single-division setup.

Roaring Back: Cal Poly halted a three-game losing streak with a pair of home victories against CSUN and Long Beach State, improving to 7-2 at the Mott Athletics Center. The Mustangs look

to win three straight for the second time this season when they travel to Cal State Fullerton on Thursday.

Awich Taking Off: Junior forward Joel Awich notched a career-high 19 points and hit a collegiate-best four three-pointers in Saturday's win against LBSU. Awich has scored in double figures in 10 straight games after doing so just twice through the first 13. During that 10 game span, Awich is averaging 13.3 points.

Super Sub: Junior Reese Morgan has developed into one of the Big West's top reserves. He has been the team's leading or second-leading scorer in each of the last five contests, averaging 16.2 points during that span. He turned in a season-high 18 points against LBSU.

Tourney Bid In Reach: It is shaping up to be a two-team race for the final Big West Tournament bid. The Titans (1-9) have played two less conference games than CSUN (2-10), and have an opportunity to gain ground when they host Cal Poly and UC Santa Barbara this week.

Free Throws Are Fantastic: The Titans posted a season-high 85.0 percent (17-for-20) showing at the free throw line on Saturday night at Hawai'i.

McBoarder: The Big West's leading rebounder at 8.6 per game, senior Steve McClellan bested that average with 10 against Hawai'i, giving him 10 or more in nine of the last 14 contests. He ranks third in the conference with 10 double-digit rebounding games, despite the fact that he had none of that variety through the first eight.

Back Into Gear: After playing limited minutes off the bench last week, junior Lanerryl Johnson returned to the starting lineup against UH and responded with 23 points, his sixth 20-point game this season.

They're All Big Now: CSUN's losing streak reached eight straight after setbacks to Cal Poly and UC Santa Barbara last week. The eight straight losses represents the longest slide for the Matadors as a Big West member and the most since dropping 10 straight to open the 1991-92 campaign.

Hicks Sniffs Scoring Top 10: Senior Stephan Hicks is on the verge of entering the Big West top 10 career scoring list. With 1,873 career points, Hicks is within range of the No. 10 spot inhabited by Cal Poly's Mike Wozniak (1996-00), who is at 1,903.

At The Top...Again: CSUN is shooting a conference-best 76.2 percent (435-of-571) at the free throw line this season, more than three percent better than the next best team. At that pace, the Matadors look to lead the Big West in foul shooting for the third time in the last four seasons.

More On Hicks: Hicks, who is the Big West's all-time free throw king with 571 makes, has connected on 18 straight going into Tuesday's game against Bethesda University.

BIG AL JOINS EXCLUSIVE CLUB

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams joined an exclusive Big West club as just the fifth player to collect 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. He eclipsed 1,000 rebounds on Jan. 15 versus CSUN. With 1,014 boards, Williams ranks third in conference history and trails only Cal State Fullerton's Tony Neal (1,115, 1981-85) and Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson (1,208, 2008-12). Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4.

HICKS IS FREE THROW KING

CSUN senior Stephan Hicks became the Big West's all-time leader in career free throws made on Jan. 29 against Hawai'i when he made a pair with 7:37 remaining in the first half. That allowed Hicks to eclipse Long Beach State's Lucious Harris (1989-93), who had held the record of 549 for nearly 20 years. Hicks is now at 571 made free throws. He is also chasing the free throws attempted record, also owned by Harris with 755. Hicks currently has 707.

ESPN TABS HAWKINS ONE OF NATION'S 25 BEST

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, seeking to become Big West scoring champion for the second time in his career, recently was named by ESPN's John Gasaway as one of the nation's 25 players. The 6-3 guard leads the Big West and ranks No. 4 nationally in scoring with 21.3 points per game. He is also the nation's most prolific shooter, ranking No. 1 in three-point field goal percentage (.526).

UC DAVIS COULD JOIN EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Coming off of a 9-22 season, UC Davis has set a Division I record for most victories (19) and is on pace for a 20-win campaign. Should the Aggies accomplish that, they would become only the third team in Big West history to win single-digit games one year and 20 the next. Fresno State (7-20 in 1976-77, 21-6 in 1977-78) and Utah State (4-23 in 1981-82, 20-9 in 1982-83) are the others.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
