Player Of The Week

Jaylen Bland • UC Riverside
Jr. • 6-3 • Guard

Junior Jaylen Bland staked UC Riverside to two wins, putting his team above the .500 mark in conference play, and he earned Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week accolades.

Bland led the Highlanders in scoring in both games as the Highlanders improved to 7-6 in Big West action and moved into sole possession of fifth place, a half game behind third place UC Santa Barbara and Long Beach State.

The 6-3 guard scored 13 of his game-high 21 points in the second half of Thursday's 64-62 win versus UC Santa Barbara, helping the Highlanders end a four-game slide against the Gauchos. He knocked down four three-pointers in eight attempts and seven of nine from the free throw line while adding seven rebounds and a pair of steals.

In Saturday's 48-44 victory over Cal Poly, Bland posted 14 points, seven rebounds and two blocked shots. He provided two clutch free throws with 10 seconds remaining to ice the game, and his stellar defense helped hold the Mustangs without a point for a 10-and-a-half minute stretch in the second half.

Bland hit another four treys against Cal Poly to give him 86 for the season, placing him 15 short of the single-season school record of 100.

This Week In The Big West

• First place UC Davis (21-4, 11-1) can take another step toward the program's first Big West regular season championship with a successful trip to UC Santa Barbara and Cal Poly. The Aggies lead second place UC Irvine by two games with four left to play.

• UC Davis is the third team in Big West history to improve from single-digit wins one season to 20 the next. The other two teams to accomplish that feat – Utah State in 1981-82 (4-23) and to 1982-83 (20-90), and Fresno State in 1976-77 (7-20) to 1977-78 (21-6). In addition, UC Davis is 12 wins better than last season, and the +12 improvement ranks as sixth-best in Big West history. The all-time greatest turnaround in league history is +16.

• In a streak that goes back four-plus years, UC Irvine has won 45 straight games when holding an opponent to 60 points or less.

• Seven schools already have qualified for the Big West Tournament at Honda Center from March 12-14, leaving the one remaining spot to a battle between CSUN and Cal State Fullerton. The two foes square off against each other in Northridge on Thursday. A CSF win gives the Titans a season sweep over the Matadors and a crucial tiebreaker advantage. The Matadors would go up by two in the win column with a triumph over the Titans.

Tough Setbacks: Cal Poly dropped to 1-5 in Big West games decided by five points or less after losing 48-44 at UC Riverside on Saturday night. The Mustangs have lost seven conference games

by a combined total of 34 points.

Morgan's The Man: Super sub Reese Morgan led the Mustangs with a season-high 21 points in last Thursday's 65-54 win against Cal State Fullerton. The junior guard leads all Big West reserves in scoring during conference games only, averaging 12.2 points per game. Morgan is averaging 15.3 points over his last seven outings.

That's Impressive: To emphasize the importance of Morgan's contributions off the bench, consider that he has outscored the ENTIRE opponent's bench himself SEVEN times during Big West play.

Shipley Strong: Since reentering the starting lineup six games ago, sophomore guard Ridge Shipley is averaging 14.2 points with double-digit scoring performances in five of them.

Huge Game On Tap: Cal State Fullerton's hopes for a Big West Tournament bid come down to Thursday's showdown at CSUN. The Titans – 1-11 in Big West play – trail the Matadors (2-11) by a

half-game in the standings. While a loss does not eliminate them from tournament contention, the Titans would be forced to win their last three games to have any shot of getting in.

On The Other Hand...: Should CSF defeat CSUN, it would give the Titans a season sweep over the Matadors and the key tiebreaker in the event both teams had identical records to end the regular season. The Titans look to sweep the season series for the first time since the 2011-12 campaign. CSF has won nine of the last 11 meetings in Northridge.

Solid Effort: Despite a 65-54 loss to Cal Poly last Thursday, the Titans shot a season-high 54.5 percent (24-of-44) from the field.

Lanerryl's Land: Junior Lanerryl Johnson has scored in double figures in four straight games, and has led or co-led the team in scoring in three of them.

Streak Snapped: CSUN halted its eight-game losing streak with a resounding 89-61 victory over Bethesda University on Tuesday. However, the Matadors also dropped their ninth consecu-

tive Big West decision when they fell at UC Irvine, 67-58, on Saturday.

Hicks Enters Big West Top 10 For Scoring: Senior Stephan Hicks supplanted Cal Poly's Mike Wozniak (1996-00) from the Big West career top 10 scoring list with his 16-point performance on Saturday. Hicks, who enters this week with 1,916 career points, moved past Wozniak's 1,903 total. Next up for Hicks is Cal State Fullerton's Bobby Brown (2003-07), who scored 1,961 points during a four-year career.

Hicks Continues Quest For 2,000: Sitting 84 points away from becoming the seventh player in Big West history to score 2,000 career points, Hicks needs to average 21.0 points over the next four games, and that assumes the Matadors play a minimum of one game in the conference tournament.

Cleanse The Wound: Long Beach State's losing streak reached four straight games for the first time since year one of the Dan Monson era, following Thursday's home setback to first place UC Davis. It is the longest conference skid for the 49ers since the 2007-08 club finished with five consecutive league losses.

Caffey Climbs Steals Chart: With at least one steal in 16 straight games, senior Mike Caffey's two swipes in the UC Davis game pushed his career total to 171, tying him with Ron Johnson (1998-02) for fifth place in 49er history.

Thievery: The 49ers established a season-high for steals against UC Davis with 13 as six different players finished with two apiece.

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams joined an exclusive Big West club as just the fifth player to collect 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. He eclipsed 1,000 rebounds on Jan. 15 versus CSUN. With 1,031 boards, Williams ranks third in conference history and trails only Cal State Fullerton's Tony Neal (1,115, 1981-85) and Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson (1,208, 2008-12). Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4.

ESPN TABS HAWKINS ONE OF NATION'S 25 BEST

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, seeking to become Big West scoring champion for the second time in his career, recently was named by ESPN's John Gasaway as one of the nation's 25 players. The 6-3 guard leads the Big West and ranks No. 6 nationally in scoring with 20.8 points per game. He is also the nation's most prolific shooter, ranking No. 1 in three-point field goal percentage (.528).

UC DAVIS JOINS EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Coming off of a 9-22 season, UC Davis has set a Division I record for most victories (21). In doing so, the Aggies also became just the third team in Big West history to win single-digit games one year and 20 the next. Fresno State (7-20 in 1976-77, 21-6 in 1977-78) and Utah State (4-23 in 1981-82, 20-9 in 1982-83) are the others.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
