Player Of The Week

Aaron Parks • CSUN

Baltimore, Md./Notre Dame Prep

Sophomore Aaron Parks helped CSUN secure a spot in the upcoming conference tournament with averages of 20.5 points and 5.5 assists in a pair of crucial home wins, earning him Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week accolades.

In defeating UC Riverside, 83-76, on Saturday night, the Matadors wrapped up the eighth and final seed for the Big West Tournament. Parks was vital in that effort, as he contributed a career-high 29 points on 5-of-9 shooting and added six assists.

However, the majority of his scoring resulted from a continuous parade to the free throw line. Parks set school records for most free throws made (19) and attempted (23) in a game, breaking the previous marks of 16 makes and 19 attempts set some 50 years ago.

The 19-of-23 effort from the charity stripe also established Big West single-game records for makes and attempts. UC Irvine's Johnny Rogers held the previous record of 18 makes against UNLV on Feb. 15, 1986. Hawaii's Christian Standhardinger and Cal State Fullerton's Leon Wood were the previous record holders with 22 attempts.

Parks also delivered in CSUN's 82-72 victory over Cal State Fullerton with 12 points, five assists and two rebounds in 31 minutes off the bench.

This Week In The Big West

• The field is set for the 2015 Big West Men's Basketball Tournament, the 40th annual event, which runs March 12-14 at Honda Center. Teams enter the final week of regular season play jockeying for seeding position. CSUN is the lone school locked into a seed. The Matadors will be the No. 8 seed when quarterfinal action at Honda Center begins on Thursday, March 12.

• First place UC Davis (22-4, 12-2) is just the third team in Big West history to go from last place to first place in a span of two seasons. The Aggies, who have earned at least a share of the regular season title, could become the first team in conference history to earn the OUTRIGHT crown after finishing last the previous season.

• After finishing 9-22 last season, UC Davis has enjoyed a +13 improvement in the win column. That ties for the fourth-best improvement in Big West history. The all-time greatest turnaround in league annals is +16.

• Hawai'i needs one more win to record its second straight 20-win season.

• CSUN senior Stephan Hicks is closing in on becoming just the seventh player in Big West history to tally 2,000 career points. He is only 42 points away from reaching the milestone.

Déjà Vu?: Cal Poly has lost three straight headed into Saturday's regular season finale at UC Santa Barbara. The Mustangs experienced a similar slump at the end of last season, having dropped three

straight to close out the regular season seat, only to win three in a row and become the first No. 7 seed in Big West Tournament history to be crowned champion.

Captain Shipley: Sophomore Ridge Shipley is averaging 15.1 points over the last eight games since reentering the starting lineup. He posted his third 20-point game this season with a team-high 20 against UC Irvine.

Better Guard Him: Much of Shipley's scoring damage has come from beyond the three-point line. He has made at least three treys in seven of the last eight games, and is shooting 40.0 percent (24-of-60) from distance during that span.

Consistency: The Mustangs have remained among the NCAA's top five in fewest turnovers allowed all season long, and enter this week No. 2 at 9.0 per game. They only trail Wisconsin (7.5) among best protectors of the ball.

Stranded: For the first time since 2002, Cal State Fullerton will not be participating in the Big West Tournament. The Titans were eliminated from tournament contention after losing to CSUN and Long

Beach State last week. CSF has made more tournament appearances (36) than any other school.

Harris Moves Up: Senior guard Alex Harris returned from injury last week to score 25 points in two games, lifting his career total to 1,166. That moved him into 12th place all-time at Cal State Fullerton, ahead of Gary Davis (1982-85) at 1,165.

Tough Outcome: The Titans displayed one of their best offensive games of the year in Thursday's 82-72 loss to CSUN. They shot 49.1 (28-of-57) percent from the field and tied a season high with 17 assists.

Back To Harris: Harris will finish his Titan career in the top 10 for steals. He is currently No. 10 with 127, and with seven more over the next two games would pass Henry Turner, Chris St. Clair and Bruce Bowen on the list.

Riverside. Having scored no more than 74 points in any previous conference games, the Matadors turned in back-to-back 80-point showings to lock down the tournament's No. 8 seed.

Hicks Zeroes In On 2,000: Senior Stephan Hicks inched closer to becoming just the seventh player in Big West history to score 2,000 career points. He enters this week with 1,958, and has a minimum of two games remaining to reach the milestone.

In The Meantime...: Hicks, who is No. 10 on the all-time Big West scoring list, should climb past Cal State Fullerton's Bobby Brown (1,961, 2003-07) and Long Beach State's Michael Wiley (1,962, 1977-80) for the eighth slot.

Maxwell Keeps It Coming: With 24 points and 13 rebounds against Cal State Fullerton, senior forward Stephen Maxwell logged his 41st career double-double.

Two More To Ten: The 49ers seek to reach the 10-win mark in Big West play for the fifth straight season, but must defeat CSUN at home and UC Riverside on the road to do so.

History Beckons: Senior Mike Caffey needs just 17 more rebounds over the remainder of the season to join Ed Ratleff as the only two players in 49er history with career numbers of 1,500 points, 500 rebounds and 400 assists. UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams joined an exclusive Big West club as just the fifth player to collect 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. He eclipsed 1,000 rebounds on Jan. 15 versus CSUN. With 1,062 boards, Williams ranks third in conference history and trails only Cal State Fullerton's Tony Neal (1,115, 1981-85) and Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson (1,208, 2008-12). Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4.

ESPN TABS HAWKINS ONE OF NATION'S 25 BEST

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, seeking to become Big West scoring champion for the second time in his career, recently was named by ESPN's John Gasaway as one of the nation's 25 players. The 6-3 guard leads the Big West and ranks No. 12 nationally in scoring with 20.2 points per game. He is also the nation's most prolific shooter, ranking No. 1 in three-point field goal percentage (.507).

UC DAVIS JOINS EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Coming off of a 9-22 season, UC Davis has set the program's Division I record for most victories (22). In doing so, the Aggies also became just the third team in Big West history to win single-digit games one year and 20 the next. Fresno State (7-20 in 1976-77, 21-6 in 1977-78) and Utah State (4-23 in 1981-82, 20-9 in 1982-83) are the others.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
