## BIG WEST AT A GLANCE

**'EATERS TAKE FIRST DANCE:** In its 38th season as a member of Division I, UC Irvine is finally going dancing. The Anteaters, which joined the Pacific Coast Athletic Association (later named the Big West Conference) on July 1, 1977 and the Division I ranks, have never competed in the NCAA Tournament. But that all changed last Saturday night when third-seeded UCI defeated fifth-seeded Hawai'i in the championship game of the Big West Tournament to earn the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA's. UCI had come up short in the conference tournament finals in four previous trips – 1988, 1994, 2008 and 2013.

**JOINING THE PARTY:** UCI becomes the seventh current Big West member to have experienced the NCAA Tournament. Cal Poly, Cal State Fullerton, CSUN, Long Beach State and UC Santa Barbara all have represented the Big West in the NCAA's recently. Hawai'i, which joined the conference in 2012, also competed in the national tournament as a member of the Western Athletic Conference as recently as 2002.

**UC DAVIS MAKES FIRST POSTSEASON TRIP:** Big West regular season champion UC Davis is making its first postseason appearance, playing Stanford in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) on Tuesday. The Aggies, which own Division I school records in wins both overall (25) and conference (14), and finished with a blemished 14-0 home court record, also lead the NCAA in win differential (+16) from last season.

**UC SANTA BARBARA KEEPS PLAYING:** UC Santa Barbara accepted an invitation to compete in the College Basketball Invitational. The Gauchos need one win to secure a 20-win campaign for the fifth time in the last nine seasons under head coach Bob Williams.

## NCAA Tourney Tidbits

• The Big West is seeking a victory in the NCAA Tournament for the second straight year. In 2014, Cal Poly knocked off Texas Southern in a First Four game after becoming the first No. 7 seed to win the Big West Tournament. The Mustangs lost to top-seeded Wichita State in the Second Round.

• UC Irvine is the first Big West team to be tabbed a No. 13 seed since former member Pacific earned that spot in the bracket in 2006. The number has not been friendly to the league historically. Big West representatives are 0-5 in opening round games on that seed line – New Mexico State (1994), Long Beach State (1995), Pacific (1997, 2006), and Utah State (1998).

• This is the first meeting between a Big West school and Louisville in the NCAA Tournament. The last time a Big West team competed in Seattle, the 1991 UNLV team won the West Regional and advanced to the Final Four.

**No Repeat:** Cal Poly was unable to repeat as Big West Tournament champion after becoming the first No. 7 seed to raise the trophy in 2014. The Mustangs fell to UC Santa Barbara, 54-50,

in this year's quarterfinals. They ended the season on a five-game losing streak.

**Bennett Finishes Strong:** Junior Brian Bennett notched 20 points on 9 of 12 shooting in the Big West quarterfinal against UCSB. It was his third 20-point game of the season. The forward ended the year scoring in double figures in six of the last seven games.

**Blockwich:** Junior forward Joel Awich posted a team-leading 38 blocked shots, tying him for fifth in Cal Poly single-season history. His 82 career blocks is No. 3 in school annals.

**Among The Best:** Cal Poly ranks No. 2 nationally in fewest turnovers per game (8.8), alongside NCAA Tourney powerhouses Wisconsin, Notre Dame, Wichita State and Virginia.

**Missed Tourney:** For the first time since 2002, Cal State Fullerton is not a participant in the Big West Tournament.

The Titans finished 1-15 in Big West play for their first last place finish since the 2001-02 season. CSF has made more tournament appearances (36) than any other current conference member.

**Harris Moves Up:** Senior guard Alex Harris posted back-to-back 15-point performances against UC Irvine and Hawai'i to lift his career total to 1,196, placing him No. 12 on the scoring list in the school record book. Harris managed to accomplish that in just three seasons as a Titan.

**Tough Finish:** The Titans ended the season on a nine-game losing streak, its longest since the 2001-02 dropped 10 in a row.

**More On Harris:** Harris completed his Titan career with 130 steals, tying him for No. 9 in school history with Henry Turner (1985-88).

**Streak:** CSF has hit at least one trey in 572 straight games.

**Caffey Rewrites History:** Senior Mike Caffey finished his career as one of the all-time great 49ers. The 6-0 point guard is the program's No. 6 all-time scorer (1,649), and he ranks No. 3 in assists (457) and No. 5 steals (178). In addition, he finished a mere rebound shy of being just the second player in school history to record 1,500 points, 500 rebounds and 400 assists at LBSU.

**Double-Double Machine:** Senior David Samuels concluded the season on a solid note with four straight double-doubles, including 19 points and 10 rebounds in the Big West quarterfinals against Hawai'i.

### BIG AL IN EXCLUSIVE CLUB, NO. 2 ON BOARDS LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams joined an exclusive Big West club as just the fifth player to collect 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. He eclipsed 1,000 rebounds on Jan. 15 versus CSUN. With 1,115 boards, Williams tied Cal State Fullerton's Tony Neal (1981-85) for No. 2 in the conference career record book, trailing only Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson (1,208, 2008-12) for the record. Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4.

### HICKS FINISHES CAREER NO. 1 IN FREE THROWS MADE

CSUN senior Stephan Hicks became the Big West's all-time leader in career free throws made on Jan. 24 against Long Beach State when he made a pair with 33 seconds remaining in the second half. Hicks eclipsed Long Beach State's Lucious Harris (1989-93) and his record of 549 that had stood for nearly 20 years. Hicks finished the season making 59 of his last 62 charity stripe tosses to conclude his career with 603 makes. He came up just short of the career record for free throw attempts, also owned by Harris with 755. Hicks attempted 742 free throws during his four seasons as a Matador.

### ESPN TABS HAWKINS ONE OF NATION'S 25 BEST

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, the Big West scoring champion for the second time in three years, was named by ESPN's John Gasaway as one of the nation's 25 players. The 6-3 guard leads the Big West and ranks No. 9 nationally in scoring with 20.4 points per game. He is also the nation's most prolific shooter, ranking No. 1 in three-point field goal percentage (.490).

### UC DAVIS JOINS EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Coming off of a 9-22 season, UC Davis has set the program's Division I record for most victories (25). In doing so, the Aggies also became just the third team in Big West history to win single-digit games one year and 20 the next. Fresno State (7-20 in 1976-77, 21-6 in 1977-78) and Utah State (4-23 in 1981-82, 20-9 in 1982-83) are the others.

### WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player for the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

### QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

## ***Corey Hawkins, Jim Les Earn Top Honors From Regular Season Champ UC Davis*** **Big West Announces 2014-15 Men's Basketball Award Winners**

**IRVINE, CA** – Big West regular season champion UC Davis claimed two coveted awards to highlight the announcement of the 2014-15 men's basketball all-conference team as voted on by the nine head coaches. Aggie senior **Corey Hawkins** claimed Big West Player of the Year honors with **Jim Les** collecting Coach of the Year accolades. **Gabe Vincent** of UC Santa Barbara took home Freshman of the Year hardware while UC Riverside junior **Jaylen Bland** rounded out the marquee list as Newcomer of the Year.

Hawkins is the first UC Davis recipient of Big West Player of the Year honors. The 6-3 guard averaged 20.6 points per game to become the conference's scoring champion for the second time in the last three seasons. Ranking No. 7 nationally in scoring, Hawkins has produced a league-best 14 games of 20 points or more, including two performances of 33 points against Idaho (Dec. 6) and 30 versus UC Irvine (Mar. 7). The Goodyear, Ariz. native also tops the nation in three-point field goal percentage, hitting at a 49.7 percent (73-of-147) clip. Hawkins, who earned Big West Newcomer of the Year honors in 2013 after transferring from Arizona State, also sits on the conference leaderboard in rebounding (13th - 5.1 rpg), field goal percentage (5th - .498), free throw percentage (5th - .829), assists (7th - 3.5 apg), steals (7th - 1.3 spg) and three-pointers per game (2nd - 2.9 pg). In conference games only, Hawkins averaged 20.8 points as a primary cog in helping UC Davis win its first Big West regular season title. He ranks No. 2 on the Aggie career scoring list with 1,623 points in just three seasons. Hawkins also collected two Big West Player of the Week honors this season to give him four career nods.

Les orchestrated one of the most successful turnarounds in conference history to secure his first Coach of the Year honor at UC Davis. Taking a program which finished 9-22 overall and missed the Big West Tournament last season, Les defied the prognosticators who tabbed the Aggies to finish seventh in the preseason media poll. Les guided UC Davis to a final regular season mark of 24-5 and the program's inaugural Big West championship with a 14-2 record. The 15-win turnaround ranks as the second-highest in conference history, just one short of tying the all-time record. In addition, UC Davis became the first school in the Big West's 46-year history to finish last one season and win the outright championship the next. The Aggies finished their home slate with an unblemished 14-0 record, and set Division I records for most overall and conference victories. Les takes the Aggies into the Big West Tournament as the No. 1 seed in search of the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament as a Division I member.

Vincent becomes the first Gaucha in 22 years to garner Freshman of the Year honors. He is the fourth UC Santa Barbara player – and first since Kyle Milling in 1993 – to be recognized as the league's top freshman. The 6-3 guard ranks fourth on the squad in scoring at 10.2 points per game, and is one of the conference's most accurate three-point shooters. Ranking No. 9 in the Big West in three-point field goal percentage (.413), he drained 52 threes, and his 2.1 per game average is sixth-best among conference players. The Stockton, Calif. native ranks No. 2 on the UCSB single-season list for most threes made by a freshman, and needs just seven more to establish the record. A starter in 18 of 25 games played, Vincent scored in double figures 13 times. He registered a career-high 25 points and tied his career best with five treys in a win at Hawai'i on Mar. 4.

Bland, who once played at Murray State and later College of the Canyons, paid immediate dividends as he became the first Highlander to notch the Newcomer award. He ranked No. 7 in the Big West in scoring (15.8 ppg), and led the circuit with 94 three-pointers, 21 more than the next highest player in the rankings. Bland enters the Big West Tournament needing seven threes to break the program record of 100. The 6-3 guard also is one of the Big West's top defensive players, ranking No. 5 in steals (1.43 pg). His 43 steals is two short of breaking the Highlander Division I single-season record. The Saginaw, Mich. native scored 20 or more points on seven occasions, led by a career-high 29 against regular season champion UC Davis on Jan. 15. He has hit at least one three in 27 consecutive games.

The All-Big West First Team features a pair of three-time selections – Long Beach State senior **Mike Caffey** and UC Santa Barbara senior **Alan Williams**. In addition, Hawkins from UC Davis made his second appearance on the first unit. Making their debuts on the all-league first team are UC Santa Barbara junior **Michael Bryson**, UC Irvine senior **Will Davis II** and UC Riverside junior **Taylor Johns**.

Of the 20 players who received first team, second team or honorable mention recognition, 11 have at least one year of eligibility remaining.

## Big West Announces Men's Hoops All-Specialty Awards

IRVINE, CA – The 2015 Big West Men's Basketball All-Specialty Awards announcement featured representatives from three different schools. UC Davis junior **Josh Fox** claimed the Best Sixth Player award, while Hawai'i junior **Roderick Bobbitt** secured Defensive Player of the Year accolades. A repeat selection earned the Best Hustle award in UC Santa Barbara senior **Zalmico Harmon**.

The conference's nine head coaches voted on the awards, but were not allowed to cast votes for their own players. This is the 15th straight year that the Big West has selected an All-Specialty Team.

Fox is the first UC Davis recipient of the Best Sixth Player award. After transferring into the Aggie program from City College of San Francisco, Fox became a major contributor to the program's first Big West championship. Playing in all 29 games, Fox averaged a team third-best 9.4 points. He ranked second in rebounding (4.6 rpg). Fox also hit 60.2 percent (106-of-176) of his field goal attempts. The Daly City, Calif. native scored a season-high 23 points on 11-of-14 shooting in an early season triumph over Utah State, and registered 20 points in just 24 minutes against Cal State Fullerton on Jan. 17. The 6-6 forward recorded 14 points and six rebounds when the Aggies clinched the regular season title against UC Riverside on Mar. 5.

Bobbitt etched his name in the Big West record book in becoming the first player from Hawai'i to earn an All-Specialty Award of any kind. In garnering the Defensive Player of the Year award, the 6-3 guard led the conference and the nation with 95 steals, while he ranked third in the country with 3.0 steals per game. The steal total places Bobbitt at No. 4 in Big West single-season history, and he is on the cusp of being just the fourth player to amass 100 steals in a season. Hailing from Oakland, Calif., Bobbitt set the UH single-game record with 10 steals against Hawai'i-Hilo, finishing the night with 12 points and 10 assists as well to secure just the second triple-double in school history. The 10 thefts tied for second on the all-time Big West single-game list. Bobbitt recorded at least three steals in 16 contests, and notched eight in a game twice during conference play against CSUN and Long Beach State.

Harmon continued a trend of repeat recipients of the Best Hustle award. Going back to UC Santa Barbara's Chris Devine (2008-09), and followed by Joe Harden of UC Davis (2010-11) and UC Irvine's Adam Folker (2012-13), Harmon caught the eye of the conference coaches for the second straight season. The 6-0 point guard, known as the team's energizer, ranks second in the Big West with a 2.51 assist-to-turnover ratio and is tied for fourth in assists (3.7 apg). Harmon also had the fourth-most steals on the team with 18. The Washington D.C. native is a prime reason that UCSB is 15-0 this season when limiting opponents to 60 points or less.
