Player Of The Week

Corey Hawkins • UC Davis
Sr. • 6-3 • Guard
Goodyear, Ariz./Arizona State

UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins averaged 24.5 points in a pair of road wins to collect Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

Hawkins was singlehandedly responsible for 40 percent of the team's offense as the Aggies defeated Eastern Illinois (63-61) and Furman (58-55), marking the first time since March of 2013 that the school posted back-to-back road wins.

The 6-3 guard led the team with 28 points against Eastern Illinois and 21 versus Furman to help the Aggies start a season 3-0 for the first time since 1999-2000.

Hawkins shot 9-of-16 from the field, including 5-of-7 from three-point range against EIU. He scored the Aggies' final five points in the two-point win. Against Furman, Hawkins hit a clutch late free throw to give the Aggies a three-point lead and force a desperation three-pointer that would have sent the game into overtime.

For the week, Hawkins shot 56.7% (17-of-30) from the field and 64.3% (9-of-14) from distance while averaging 6.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.5 steals.

Home Improvement: The Mustangs improved to 15-6 all-time at the Division I level in home openers after defeating San Francisco State, 65-44, on Tuesday. Saturday's 18-point win against Delaware

represented Cal Poly's first against a team from the Colonial Athletic Association.

Shipleigh Records Career High: Sophomore guard Ridge Shipleigh poured in a career-high 21 points and hit five of the team's 12 three-pointers in the win against Delaware.

Mine, All Mine: Cal Poly continues to demonstrate that sharing the ball with others is not one of the team's personality traits. For the second time this season, the Mustangs committed just four turnovers in a game, doing so against Delaware, and have a total of 19 miscues through three games, an average of just 6.3 per contest.

Into The Win Column: Cal State Fullerton eked out a four-point win over San Jose State on Saturday, hitting 9-of-12 free throws down the stretch to move to 1-2 on the season. The Titans, which

play nine of their first 11 games on the road, take the court four times over the next five games starting at USC Tuesday.

Home Opener Extraordinaire: The Titans have now won their home opener for 11 straight seasons.

Harris In Double Figures Again: Senior Alex Harris produced the 10th 20-point game of his career in the win over San Jose State while extending his streak of consecutive double-figure games to 20. He is averaging 15.0 points to rank No. 8 in the Big West.

Morgan For Three: Senior transfer Moses Morgan has connected for at least a trio of treys in all three games. He shot 3-of-6 from three-point range to help the Titans hold off San Jose State. His 11 threes on the year is tied for second in the Big West.

Two For Three: The Matadors won two of three games last week, knocking off Montana State and Samford while losing a hard fought double-overtime decision to Arkansas-Little Rock.

Hicks Free Throw Watch: Senior Stephan Hicks, who got to the free throw line just nine times in the first two games, averaged nearly nine attempts over the next three. The guard/forward made 22-of-26 (84.6%) from the stripe last week. Hicks now has 466 free throw makes for his career, which is No. 6 in Big West history. He's 11 away from the fifth spot, occupied by UC Santa Barbara's Alex Harris (476, 2004-08).

Home Opening Dominance: CSUN won its home opener for the 12th consecutive season in defeating Montana State last week.

Shooting Stars: The Matadors shot a season-best 61.4% (27 of 44) in the win over Samford. It was their best shooting performance since hitting at a 62.0% (31 of 50) clip against UC Davis on Jan. 9, 2014.

#BigWin: The 49ers notched another signature win in the Dan Monson era when stifling defense and clutch free throw shooting led to a 69-60 win over the Big 12 Conference's Kansas State on Friday. Long

Beach State held the Wildcats to 32.8% shooting and made 9-of-10 free throws down the stretch in front of a sellout crowd of 4,256.

Add Another To The List: Long Beach State has defeated some well known programs from upper echelon conference during the Monson era. In addition to Kansas State, the 49ers have toppled Temple, UCLA, Iowa, Pittsburgh, Xavier, Auburn and USC.

Monson Wins Watch: Head coach Dan Monson has won 121 games at Long Beach State, needing one to tie and two to surpass Hall of Famer Jerry Tarkanian for the distinction of winningest coach in program history.

Caffey's Accuracy: A career 41 percent shooter from the field, senior Mike Caffey is No. 5 in the Big West through five games with a 58.6% (34-of-58) success rate, including 11-of-22 from three-point range.
