Player Of The Week

Taylor Johns • UC Riverside
Jr. • 6-7 • Forward

San Francisco, Calif./Sacred Heart Cathedral Prep

UC Riverside junior Taylor Johns earned his first career Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honor with back-to-back 20-point performances in a pair of wins.

Johns is the first Highlander to garner the Player of the Week award since Phil Martin on Jan. 16, 2012.

A 6-7 forward, Johns scored 15 of his game-high 21 points in the second half to help the Highlanders erase an 11-point deficit on the road against CSU Bakersfield. Johns converted his final bucket with 12 seconds left on the clock for the winning points as UCR eked out a 59-58 victory. He made 9-of-13 floor attempts to go along with seven rebounds, two steals and three blocked shots. UCR had trailed for 19 minutes and 48 seconds in the second period before Johns' heroics sealed the win.

Johns also posted 20 points on 8-of-10 shooting to spearhead an 88-62 rout of Portland State, which previously had notched road victories against USC and CSUN earlier in the year. His shooting performance helped UCR finish at 64.8% for the game, the third-best field goal percentage in program history. He added five rebounds, a steal and a block to his final stat line.

For the week, Johns shot 73.9% (17-of-23) from the field while averaging 20.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks. He ranks sixth in the Big West in scoring, second in rebounding and second in blocked shots.

Long Trip Ahead: Cal Poly embarks upon a season-high seven-game roadtrip, and does not return to the Mott Athletic Center until Jan. 10 against UC Santa Barbara. The Mustangs play three

games in a five-day stretch, beginning with a matchup Saturday at Fresno State.

Nation's Leader: The Mustangs continue to lead the nation in fewest turnovers per game (6.0), almost three less than the No. 2 school in the NCAA rankings. Cal Poly has had five or less miscues in four of its first six games.

Bennett's Line: Junior forward Brian Bennett had an impressive game against Menlo College, scoring 15 points on 7-of-7 shooting with eight rebounds and a blocked shot in 24 minutes. Bennett ranks third in the Big West in field goal percentage at 63.3% (31-of-49).

D-Fense: Cal Poly held Menlo College to just 35 points in Saturday's 37-point victory. It was the lowest scoring total by a Cal Poly opponent in the Joe Callero era.

Back At It: Cal State Fullerton dropped back-to-back contests against UCLA and Pepperdine last week to fall to 3-6 on the season. The Titans look to rebound with a pair of road games against

Sacramento State and Nevada this week.

Harris Heats Up: Senior guard Alex Harris has produced two 20-point efforts in the last three games as he seeks to become the eighth current Big West player to reach 1,000 for his career. He's currently at 881. Harris collected 26 points against Pepperdine on Saturday after equalling that mark against Florida International on Nov. 29.

At The Line: The Titans shot a season-best 77.3% (17-of-22) from the charity stripe against Pepperdine last week. They have shot over 20 attempts in seven of their first nine contests.

Double-Double: Senior Steve McClellan's 12 points and 10 rebounds versus the Waves represented the first double-double by a Titan this year, and was the fourth of his career.

Wiped Clean: CSUN's losing streak reached a season-high five straight games after setbacks earlier last week to South Dakota and Pepperdine, but in their third game in five days, the Matadors

reversed their fortunes with a 12-point win over Vanguard on Saturday. CSUN is off this week for final exams.

Hicks On Cusp Of History: Senior Stephan Hicks, who averaged 22.0 points over three games last week, increased his career total to 1,625 points, tops among active Big West players. He is now within clear range of the school's all-time leader – Brian Heinle, who scored 1,641 points from 1997-2001. Hicks could break the record in CSUN's next game – Dec. 17 at Oregon.

More Records Talk: Senior Stephen Maxwell also is eyeing a CSUN career record. With 789 career rebounds, Maxwell needs 19 more to break Jerry Joseph's more than 40-year-old record of 807. Joseph played at CSUN from 1967-70. Maxwell has four games of 10 or more rebounds this season, including a season-high 13 versus UALR on Nov. 23.

The 49ers are 5-5 with signature wins over Kansas State and Xavier. They continue a season-long six-game roadtrip at San Diego State on Wednesday.

Successful Return Home: Sophomore Branford Jones, a native of Missouri City, Texas, returned to his home state to pour in a season and team-high 15 points against Stephen F. Austin last Friday. It was the first time in four games this season that Jones scored in double figures while the 49ers lost.

Caffey Climbs: Senior guard Mike Caffey is 16 points shy from eclipsing Francois Wise for No. 11 on the LBSU career scoring list. Wise scored 1,305 points for the 49ers from 1976-80.

range, committed just seven turnovers, and limited the Redhawks to 32.1% shooting.

Breath Of Fresh Air: Even more impressive for the Gauchos in their victory over Seattle was they only had three free throws for the game, the fewest attempted in any victory since four against Idaho in 2002. Lack of free throw attempts usually spells trouble for UCSB. In UCSB's four losses this season, opponents have taken a combined 54 more (127-73) free throw attempts than the Gauchos.

Big Al Breaks Record: The nation's rebounding leader at 13.3 per game, senior Alan Williams broke the school record for career rebounds with 12 against Seattle. That brought his total to 910, allowing him to surpass Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the rebounding king mantle. With eight more boards in Monday's loss to SMU, Williams is now No. 6 in Big West career annals with 918.
