## Player Of The Week

**Alex Harris • Cal State Fullerton**  
Sr. • 6-1 • Guard  
Richmond, Calif./Northeastern

Senior Alex Harris helped Cal State Fullerton to its first road win of the year as he captured his first Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honor.

Harris averaged a team-leading 17.0 points, 6.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds per game to help the Titans split a pair of road games. He shot 42.9% (12-of-28) from the field.

The 6-1 guard poured in game-highs of 22 points and five assists in CSF's 65-55 win at Nevada on Saturday, snapping a six-game road losing streak this season. It was the fourth time this year that he eclipsed the 20-point mark, and the ninth time overall that he has recorded double-digit points. Harris also chipped in seven rebounds, five assists and a pair of steals in the win over the Wolf Pack.

In a Thursday loss at Sacramento State, Harris posted 12 points, three rebounds, seven assists and two steals.

**Streak Broken:** Cal Poly snapped a 15-game non-conference road losing streak with a 78-71 triumph at San Francisco on Monday. Prior to that, the Mustangs last toppled a non-conference

opponent on the road on Nov. 26, 2012 in a 70-68 upset of then-No. 11 UCLA.

**Shot Makers:** The Mustangs helped themselves in the victory over San Francisco by making a season-high 50.9% (27-of-53) on field goal attempts and tying their highest scoring output of the year with 78 points.

**Nwaba Consistent:** Junior David Nwaba notched a game-high 19 points in the win over USF, giving the wing his seventh straight game in double figures. The 19 points tied a season high.

**Road Trip Continues:** Cal Poly continues a seven-game roadtrip on Wednesday, opening up the 48th annual Cable Car Classic against Northeastern, before facing No. 8 Gonzaga in the Battle in Seattle at Key Arena Saturday.

**Road "W" Welcome:** Cal State Fullerton, which had gone 0-6 on the road this season and had lost eight straight true away matchups dating back to the 2013-14 season, knocked off Nevada

65-55 at Lawlor Events Center on Saturday. The 55 points scored was the second-fewest by a Titan foe this season.

**Harris Creeps Closer To 1,000:** Senior guard Alex Harris poured in 22 points versus Nevada, marking the third time in the last five games he has eclipsed the 20-point barrier. With 915 career points, Harris moved closer to becoming the 23rd player in Titan history to accumulate 1,000.

**Valuing The Ball:** The first road win of the year coincided with Fullerton's lowest turnover total (9) all season.

**Returning Home:** The Titans prepare for their longest homestand of the season – four straight games – beginning Thursday against Cal State Dominguez Hills and continuing Monday against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. CSF is 1-1 at Titan Gym this season.

**Cobwebs:** CSUN returns to action after an 11-day hiatus to take finals, squaring off against Oregon in Eugene on Wednesday. The Matadors have lost eight straight non-conference road games

dating back to last year. CSUN's last non-league road win was against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Dec. 20, 2013.

**Hicks On Cusp Of History:** Senior Stephan Hicks, who is averaging a conference fourth-best 17.7 points per game, has scored 1,625 career points, tops among active Big West players. He is now within clear range of the school's all-time leader – Brian Heinle, who scored 1,641 points from 1997-2001. Hicks could break the record in CSUN's next game – at Oregon on Wednesday.

**More Records Talk:** Senior Stephen Maxwell also is eyeing a CSUN career record. With 789 career rebounds, Maxwell needs 19 more to break Jerry Joseph's more than 40-year-old record of 807. Joseph played at CSUN from 1967-70. Maxwell has four games of 10 or more rebounds this season, including a season-high 13 versus UALR on Nov. 23.

**Oh So Close:** Having already dispatched Kansas State and Xavier this season, Long Beach State came within a whisker of producing its third quality non-conference victory, but ultimately fell to then-No.

16 San Diego State by a 60-59 score on Dec. 10. The 49ers return from a nine-day layoff to play at No. 9 Texas Saturday.

**Caffey For Three:** Four three-pointers from Mike Caffey in the San Diego State game gave him a season mark of 24, fourth-best in the Big West, and increased his career total to 139. The guard now is tied for No. 8 in LBSU history with Tony Darden (2001-03) on the threes made list.

**The Gauntlet:** Beginning with last week's battle against No. 16 San Diego State, the 49ers are in the midst of playing four of five games against ranked opponents – all on the road. They play No. 9 Texas, No. 20/23 St. John's and No. 4 Louisville, with a game against unranked Syracuse thrown in for good measure.

**Much Improved:** LBSU is No. 2 in the Big West in three-point field goal percentage (.392), a huge improvement over last year's eighth place ranking (.312).

**Important Stretch:** With the Aggies off to a 7-1 start, they embark on an crucial four-game roadtrip that will take them into the new year. The team heads first to the Rocky Mountains to face Air Force and then Northern Colorado,

before trekking to the Evergreen State for encounters with Washington State and Seattle University.

**Lucky Seven:** Fueling much of the Aggie success is its efficiency from distance. UC Davis ranks first in the Big West and No. 22 nationally in three-point field goal percentage at 41.0% (66-of-161). The Aggies have hit no fewer than seven treys in all seven of their victories. Coincidentally, they've made exactly seven on five separate occasions.

**Adenrele Improving:** After missing the entire 2013-14 season with a knee injury, junior J.T. Adenrele has been hiking back up the comeback trail. He turned in his best offensive effort of the year the last time out, scoring a season-high 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting in a win over Eastern Illinois.

Williams also unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of being the school's all-time rebounds leader when he yanked down 12 against Seattle University on Dec. 4. Entering this week with 926 career rebounds, the senior center turns his attention toward the top five and Pacific's Ron Cornelius, who sits at No. 5 on the list with 973 (1978-81). Long Beach State's T.J. Robinson holds the Big West record for most career rebounds with 1,208 from 2008-12.

### WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

### QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
