Player Of The Week

Alan Williams • UC Santa Barbara
Sr. • 6-8 • Center
Phoenix, Ariz./North HS

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams averaged a double-double to claim his third Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award this season, and extended his conference career record to 11 citations.

The 6-8 center averaged 17.5 points and 11.5 rebounds to help the Gauchos split a pair of non-conference games.

In a 76-64 loss at Oregon State, Williams posted 16 points and 12 rebounds while connecting on 7-of-11 from the field.

Williams played a key role in UCSB's 64-57 win over Vermont as he notched 10 of his 19 points in the final five minutes, helping his team overcome a six-point deficit to defeat the Catamounts. He made 7-of-13 floor shots and sank all but one of his six free throw attempts.

He became the seventh player in school history to move past 1,500 career points and he's now 30 rebounds shy of 1,000. He is on the cusp of becoming the first player in UCSB history – and just the fifth in Big West annals – to compile 1,000 career caroms.

Williams also amassed his eighth and ninth double-doubles of the season.

Momentum: Cal Poly has won five of its last seven contests heading into the Big West opener Wednesday at Hawai'i. The Mustangs are seeking to win their third straight conference opener

after knocking off UC Riverside and Hawai'i in the previous two seasons.

The Turnover Skinny: Cal Poly remains No. 1 in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (8.4). The Mustangs have committed just 101 miscues through 12 games. In eight of those games, they have turned the ball over nine or less times.

Emboldened: Senior wing Michael Bolden provided a unexpected boost on offense in Cal Poly's 71-57 win at IPFW last week as he poured in a career-high 20 points, aided by five three-point makes. Bolden's previous high this season was eight points.

Nwaba Keeps It Going: Junior David Nwaba has scored in double figures in all 11 games he has appeared in.

On A Roll: Cal State Fullerton is riding a five-game winning streak, the program's longest since reeling off six consecutive victories during the 2011-12 season. The Titans finished 4-0 on their

homestand with wins against Cal State East Bay and Seattle.

Opening Time: The Titans are hunting for their fourth consecutive win in a Big West opener when they travel to UC Riverside on Thursday. CSF defeated the Highlanders at home, 78-73, in last year's Big West debut.

Harris Creeps Closer To 1,000: Unless he turns in a sub-par outing, well below his current 15.5 points per game average, senior guard Alex Harris should surpass the 1,000-point career mark against UCR. He enters the game 13 points shy of becoming the 23rd player in school history to achieve the milestone.

Starter Success: The starting lineup of Harris, Josh Gentry, Moses Morgan, Joe Boyd and Steve McClellan is now 5-1. CSF is just three wins shy of matching last year's total.

Much Needed "W": CSUN halted a four-game losing streak with a 78-62 triumph against Morgan State on Friday, with the 16-point margin of victory its largest of the season. The Matadors

posted 17 assists against a season-low five turnovers to help their cause.

Heavy Workload: Playing predominantly seven or eight individuals, the Matadors have leaned heavily on the senior tandem of Stephan Hicks and Stephen Maxwell. The duo has scored 499 of the team's 983 points, or 50.8 percent of the total offense. Hicks recorded his sixth 20-point game of the season with 22 against Morgan State, while Maxwell's 20 gave him his fifth such performance.

Seeking Déjà Vu: CSUN hopes to topple UC Davis in a Big West opener for the second straight year when the two teams clash on Wednesday.

Fresh Start: Long Beach State snapped a six-game losing streak, putting forth its second-highest point total of the season in an 81-46 victory over Fresno Pacific on Saturday. The 49ers open up Big

West play with television appearances at UC Irvine (Prime Ticket) and UC Davis (ESPNU) this week.

For Perspective: In playing the nation's toughest non-conference schedule, the 49ers either were tied with or held a lead in the second half against five teams ranked in the top 50 of the latest NCAA RPI – BYU (No. 29), Washington (37), San Diego State (44), Texas (21), St. John's (25).

Caffey Nears 400 Assists: Senior Mike Caffey is four assists shy of 400 for his career. Only six previous 49ers have hit that mark. Caffey also seeks to become just the fifth player in school history with 1,000 career points and 400 assists.

Big West Openers: The 49ers are 4-3 in Big West openers under head coach Dan Monson. They begin league play on Thursday against media preseason favorite UC Irvine, which has won four straight against LBSU.

BIG AL BOARDS

With 13 rebounds against Florida Gulf Coast, UC Santa Barbara's Alan Williams moved into fifth place all-time in the Big West record book with 983 career boards. The Phoenix, Ariz. native surpassed Pacific's Ron Cornelius (973, 1978-81) in breaking into the top-5. Williams now focuses his attention on becoming just the fifth player in Big West history to collect 1,000 career rebounds. Earlier this season, Williams unseated Eric McArthur (904, 1986-90) for the distinction of all-time school rebounding king when he gobbled up 12 caroms against Seattle University on Dec. 4. UNLV's Stacey Augmon and Utah State's Greg Grant are next up on the list for Williams. Augmon accumulated 1,005 rebounds from 1988-91 for the Rebels while Grant finished his Aggie career with 1,003.

WILLIAMS NAMED TO NAISMITH TROPHY WATCH LIST

UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams, the reigning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Year, is one of 50 players on the "Watch List" for the Naismith Trophy, given to the nation's top collegiate player. He is the first Gaucho to ever be named to the Naismith list.

The list will be whittled down to 30 midseason candidates in mid-February, and will be further condensed to 10 semifinalists the first week of March. Four finalists will be named later in March, with the winner being announced on Sunday, April 5, 2015.

The voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, base its criteria on player performance throughout the season.

QUARTET UP FOR LOU HENSON AWARD

Four Big West players – Long Beach State senior Mike Caffey, UC Davis senior Corey Hawkins, UC Irvine sophomore Mamadou Ndiaye and UC Santa Barbara senior Alan Williams – were selected as preseason candidates for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. When he left the game in 2005 he was sixth all-time in career Division I wins with 779.

Among the 40 candidates in contention for the award, the 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.
