Big West Tid Bits

• Long Beach State continues to dominate the Big West Conference this season with an unblemished 12-0 record. UC Davis owns the second spot with a 10-3 mark while Hawai'i is close behind in third with a 9-3 record. The 49ers can capture the conference crown and automatic qualifier into the NCAA Tournament this week with a pair of wins. A single victory over UC Davis would also guarantee the 49ers at least a share of the title with Hawai'i if they run the table.

• In the latest RPI there is a trio of Big West schools among the top with Long Beach State leading the way with a 23rd ranking. The Rainbow Wahine sit 30th and CSUN rounds out the trio with a 37th ranking.

• The field of 64 teams for the 2014 NCAA Volleyball Tournament will be unveiled on ESPNU at 5:30 p.m. (Pacific) on Sunday, Nov. 30. The first and second round host sites will also be announced during the selection show while the Regional and Final sites are predetermined. This year's Regional sites include Ames, Iowa, Louisville, Kent., Minneapolis, Minn. & Seattle, Wash., with the finals taking place at the Chesapeake Energy Arena in Oklahoma City, Okla., December 18 & 20.

• Casey Hinger of the CSUN women's volleyball team has been named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award, given annually to the sport's top senior both on and off the court.

The final 10 were chosen by a media committee from the list of 30 candidates announced in September. Nationwide fan voting begins immediately to help select the winner. Fans are encouraged to vote on the Senior CLASS Award website through December 8. Fan votes will be combined with media and Division I head coaches' votes to determine the winner. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

For the fourth time during the 2014 season, UC Davis junior Kaylin Squyres (Rocklin, Calif./Whitney HS) was worthy of Big West Women's Volleyball Player of the Week accolades as she led the Aggies offensively in a pair of wins.

Squyres averaged 5.71 kills, 3.29 digs and 0.71 blocks per set while hitting .268 (40-14-97) as UC Davis pinned losses on Cal State Fullerton (3-0) and UC Irvine (3-1).

She hit .424 with 16 kills on just two errors in 33 attempts in a sweep of the Titans. Squyres helped the Aggies to a four-set win over the Anteaters with 24 kills – missing her career high of 25 by one for the third time since setting it back on October 17. She added a team-leading 18 digs against UCI to secure her 18th double-double of the year, and her defensive effort helped UC Davis outperform the conference's statistical leader in that category (77 to 71).

Squyres allowed only one ace in 31 receptions as one of the team's primary passers. In addition, her 5.71 kills per set is the highest for any two-match stretch in her career.

Cal State Fullerton sophomore Paige Reed (Vallejo, Calif./St. Patrick-St. Vincent HS) established a career-high in digs to earn Big West Women's Volleyball Defensive Player of the Week accolades.

The 5-10 outside hitter collected 19 digs in Saturday's three-set win over UC Riverside. She notched 13 digs against UC Davis, and her 32 total digs over six sets gave Reed a 5.33 digs per set average.

Reid's previous career high for digs was 18. She has now recorded double-digit scoops in eight consecutive contests.

Recognized for the third time in the last five weeks, Long Beach State middle blocker Ashley Murray (Torrance, Calif./Bishop Montgomery HS) garnered Big West Women's Volleyball Freshman Player of the Week honors with her solid play on both sides of the net.

Murray hit a robust .423 and averaged 1.83 blocks per set to help the 49ers post sweeps over conference foes Cal Poly and UC Santa Barbara. LBSU won its 11th and 12th consecutive matches to remain unbeaten in the Big West at 12-0.

She tallied nine kills on .533 hitting and added four total blocks against the Mustangs. Murray chipped in five kills and seven blocks versus the Gauchos. In that match, she had four stuffs in the first set alone, including a solo put back that helped set the tone. LBSU's top net protector at 1.22 blocks per set, Murray helped her side limit UCSB to .131 hitting.

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Cal Poly Gears up For Final Home Contests: Cal Poly wrapped up the road portion of its schedule with a pair of losses, but hopefully the same won't be said in regards to their final home contests. The Mustangs play the first of their

two home matches Saturday, Nov. 22 against Hawai'i.

Mustang Leaders: Leading the Cal Poly offense is the freshmen duo of Caihla Petiprin and Raeann Greisen. Petiprin paces the squad with a .243 attack percentage and Greisen leads the way with a 3.56 kill average to rank fourth in the league. Junior Nicole Kessler dominates on defense with a conference second-best dig average of 4.30.

Diaper Dandies: Cal Poly's 2014 roster included nine players who had never played a collegiate match at the start of the year, making it one of the youngest programs in Division I. Cal Poly's percentage of freshmen players – 64 percent of its roster – leads the nation while the team's eight combined seasons of returning collegiate experience rank second in youthfulness to only Chicago State. So far this season the freshmen have combined for 1018.5 of Cal Poly's 1415.5 points (72%).
