Big West Tid Bits

• The Big West Conference is sending a pair of teams to the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship as the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Committee announced the 64-team field. Long Beach State, who earned the conference's automatic bid to the postseason after posting a perfect 16-0 mark to claim its 13th title, is joined by Hawai'i, who is an at-large selection.

The 49ers (24-4), making their 27th appearance in the NCAA Tournament after capturing their first Big West crown in three years, have a short trip to Los Angeles for the first & second rounds as part of the Louisville Regional. Joining the 49ers at Pauley Pavilion are host and 12th-seed UCLA (25-6), West Coast Conference at-large selection San Diego (19-11) and Northeast Conference champion LIU Brooklyn (20-11). For the third consecutive NCAA appearance, Long Beach State opens the tournament against the Toreros Friday, December 5 at 5:30 p.m.

Making their 33rd appearance in the postseason are the Rainbow Wahine of Hawai'i (19-6), who are headed to Seattle, Wash., for first & second round action, along with host and No. 3-seeded Washington (29-2), Duke (22-7) and New Hampshire (20-11). For their first round matchup, the Rainbow Wahine drew the Blue Devils, who are an at-large team from the Atlantic Coast Conference. The two teams take to the court Friday, Dec. 5 at 5:00 p.m. (Pacific) with the winner advancing to the second round to face the victor of the Pac-12 at-large pick Huskies and the America East Champion Wildcats.

• In his 30th season at the helm of the Long Beach State women's volleyball program, head coach Brian Gimmillaro guided the 49ers (26-4) to their first Big West Conference championship since 2011, 13th overall, with an unblemished 16-0 league mark. Hawai'i dominance came to an end as its 19-year conference title streak (Big West & WAC) was snapped after posting an 13-3 mark to place second in the league. CSUN and UC Davis found themselves knotted in third with a 10-6 mark and were followed by UC Irvine at 9-7. UC Santa Barbara sits sixth, while Cal Poly (4-12), Cal State Fullerton (2-14) and UC Riverside (0-16) rounded out the nine-team field.

• The 2014 Big West Conference champion, Long Beach State, continued its dominance in the conference's annual awards, sweeping the top three honors. Janelle Hundson was tabbed Big West Player of the Year and teammate Ashley Murray earning Big West Freshman of the Year honors. Rounding out the 49er trio was Brian Gimmillaro, who picked up the Big West Coach of the Year award.

• Casey Hinger of the CSUN women's volleyball team has been named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award, given annually to the sport's top senior both on and off the court. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.
