The Road To Omaha...

Big West Conference

• The Big West sent two teams to the 64-team NCAA Baseball Championship for the 11th time in conference history. Big West Champion and at-large selection UC Santa Barbara, both of which were selected to host an NCAA Regional.

• With Cal State Fullerton advancing to the Super Regionals this year, the Big West has now sent at least one team to the Super Regionals 12 out of the last 13 years. The 2012 season was the lone year where the Big West was not represented at the Super Regionals.

• Seven teams posted a .500-or-better overall winning percentage this year for the first time since 1990 - Cal Poly, Cal State Fullerton, CSUN, Long Beach State, UC Davis, UC Irvine and UC Santa Barbara.

• The Big West posted a 151-114-2 (.569) record versus nonconference opponents during the regular season.

• Since 2000 the Big West Conference has posted a 123-89 (.580) record in the NCAA Tournament, which includes 17 Super Regional appearances, nine College World Series participants and one national champion (Cal State Fullerton, 2004).

• The Big West Conference has had two baseball National Championships, with both of them claimed by the Cal State Fullerton Titans (1995, 2004). The other two titles the Titans earned in 1979 and 1984 were when they were competing in the Southern California Baseball Association (SCBA). In all, the conference has sent four different teams to the College World Series - Cal State Fullerton, former member Fresno State (1988, 1991), Long Beach State and UC Irvine.

• Cal State Fullerton was the lone school in the 2015 College World Series from a conference that doesn't sponsor Division I-AA football. In 2004 the Big West Conference became the nation's only Division I-AA or Division I-AAA multi-sport conference to win a national championship in baseball with Cal State Fullerton's national title.

• This marks the second straight year the Big West Conference has had a representative in the College World Series with UC Irvine carrying the conference torch in 2014.

NCAA Tournament

• The Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and Southeastern Conference (SEC) led all conferences in the number of teams in the tournament field with seven apiece. The Pac-12 had six institutions, while the Big 10 had a league-record five selected.

• Each of the 16 regionals featured four teams who played a double-elimination format. The regionals were scheduled from Friday, May 29, to Monday, June 1 (if necessary). Selection of the eight super regional hosts were announced on www.ncaasports.com, Monday, June 1.

• There are 31 Division I conferences which received an automatic berth in the field of 64, along with 33 at-large selections. The 69th Men's College World Series began play Saturday, June 13, at TD Ameritrade Park Omaha in Omaha, Neb.

• The Big West has enjoyed a tradition of representation at the College World Series. In fact, at least one Big West school has reached Omaha 19 times. Fullerton brought home the Big West's first national title in 1995 and then brought home a second in 2004.

• The 2015 season marked the 37th year the Titans have competed in the NCAA Regionals - 29th as a Big West member. It is also the 24th consecutive year Cal State Fullerton has received a postseason berth, marking the third-longest active consecutive streak in the nation behind Miami (43 years) and Florida State (38 years).

• Cal State Fullerton, hosting an NCAA Regional for the 12th time in the program's history, swept the regional to face Louisville in one of eight Super Regional showdowns. The Titans opened regional play with a 9-3 win over the Pepperdine Waves before facing No. 2-seeded Arizona State in a game that needed 14 innings to crown a winner. Cal State Fullerton eventually won by a score of 3-2 and would down Pepperdine a second time in the regional finals, 10-1, to go 3-0 in its home regional. With the regional sweep, the Titans have now won 16 of their last 18 contests with the only two losses coming against No. 6 UC Santa Barbara (3-1) and No. 2 UCLA (5-4, 10 inn.). *Worth noting:* In 2004, Arizona State and Pepperdine came to Goodwin Field as the No. 2 and No. 4 seeds respectively in the Fullerton Regional. The Titans would go on to win the national title that year.

• Overall, the Titans have won 21 regional titles – including a national best 11 on the road (two each in Fresno and Baton Rouge and one each at USC, Austin, Starkville, Stillwater, South Bend, Tempe and San Diego).

• The Titans are now 99-41 (.707) all-time in the NCAA Regionals and 37-9 (.804) when hosting the regional.

• Of the eight schools (Texas, Florida State, Miami (Fla.), Oklahoma State, Clemson, Arizona State, Southern California, Cal State Fullerton) that have recorded 37-or-more Div. I baseball postseason appearances, the Titans are the only team to have never gone winless in Regional play.

• The Titans entered the College World Series battle-tested as two of the three Super Regional contests against Louisville needed extra innings to crown a victor, which happened to be the Titans on both occasions. Cal State Fullerton won game one, 3-2 in 10 innings, before falling to the Cardinals, 9-3, in game two. The rubber match went 11 innings before Big West Co-Player of the Year David Olmedo-Barrera blasted his second home run of the game to clinch a 4-3 victory, sending the Titans back to Omaha, Neb., for the College World Series. The Titans are now 5-1 all-time against The Cardinals.

• Cal State Fullerton has hosted nine super regionals for a 13-7 (.650) record over the span and advanced to the CWS six times, while going 5-4 on the road in super regional action.

• Cal State Fullerton had a treacherous task in front of them at the College World Series as it was up against two Southeastern Conference teams which won their respective divisions, Vanderbilt and LSU, and Big 12 Regular Season Champion TCU on its side of the College World Series bracket. Cal State Fullerton opened the tournament against defending national champion Vanderbilt, which pitted Big West Pitcher of the Year Thomas Eshelman against SEC Pitcher of the Year Carson Fullmer, for the first-ever meeting between the two teams. The Titans were leading 3-0 in the bottom of the sixth when the games was suspended due to rain. The game was resumed nearly 16 hours later with the Titans carrying a 3-1 lead into the ninth before the Commodores scored one run early in the ninth and then blasted a two-run walkoff home run.

The Titans then faced LSU in an elimination game. They took an early 3-0 lead but struggled at the plate as the game progressed. The pitching staff would eventually would give up five runs and Cal State Fullerton would be sent home by a score of 5-3.

• This year really was a tale of two seasons for the Cal State Fullerton Titans. Leading up to April 22 the Titans had been flirting with an above-.500 record after producing a 20-19 record following two months of play. Something clicked the following week and the Titans were nearly unstoppable, winning 19 of their final 23 contests with their four losses coming against Top 20 opponents - No. 6 UC Santa Barbara (3-1), No. 19 UC Irvine (5-4, 10 inn.), No. 2 UCLA (5-4, 10 inn.) and No. 4 Louisville (9-3). They also won all eight conference series, including three sweeps, to capture their 20th Big West crown and later found themselves back in the national polls.

• The Titans have won four National Titles (1979, 1984, 1995, 2004).

• Cal State Fullerton has had five College World Series Outstanding Players.

UC Santa Barbara

0-2 Lake Elsinore Regional

• The Gauchos, who finished second in the Big West Conference, made their second appearance in three years in the postseason and ninth overall.

• UC Santa Barbara hosted its first-ever NCAA Regional at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, home to the Class-A Advanced affiliate of the San Diego Padres Lake Elsinore Storm. Lake Elsinore Diamond, which has been noted as one of the top facilities in all of minor league baseball, has a capacity of about 6,000. Unfortunately, the Gauchos stumbled out of the gate, dropping a 4-3 contest against fourth-seeded San Diego State to open the regional. They suffered a 12-3 loss to USC the following day and were eliminated from the tournament. No. 3-seed Virginia went on to win the regional, defeating USC 14-10.

• The Gauchos conclude the year with a 40-17-1 record, setting a program record for most single-season wins against Division I opponents.

Big West Tid Bits

• Cal State Fullerton claimed its 20th Big West Conference title with a 19-5 mark and was followed by UC Santa Barbara (16-8) in second place. UC Irvine finished third at 15-9 while Cal Poly secured the fourth spot with a 14-10 record. Hawai'i posted its best conference finish since joining the Big West in 2013 with a fifth-place mark of 12-12. Long Beach State ends the season sixth at 11-13 and UC Davis grabbed the seventh slot with a 9-15 mark. CSUN (8-16) finished eighth and UC Riverside rounded out the nine-team field with a 4-20 record.

• The Big West Conference owns three of the Top 10 spots in the country in earned run average with UC Santa Barbara leading the trio with a 2.45 ERA, good enough for third place. CSUN ranks sixth with a 2.61 ERA and Cal State Fullerton tied for 10th at 2.89. Individually, Titan Thomas Eshelman paces the Big West Conference with the nation's 14th-best ERA of 1.58.

• UC Davis reached the century mark in stolen bases for the first time in DI school history with 103 which ranked 12th in the country. This is an impressive feat considering one would have to combine the Aggies' stolen base totals from the previous three seasons just to reach 100 (105). The last time a Big West team totaled over 100 stolen bases was back in 2010 when Cal State Fullerton recorded 112.

• Freshmen Chris Mathewson (7.0 IP, 8K, 1BB) and Darren McCaughan (2.0 IP, 3K) made Long Beach State history as they combined for the first no-hitter in program history on March 1 with a 4-0 win over Wichita State. Mathewson was dominant on the mound, retiring the first 11 batters he faced and then his final six before handing off to McCaughan in the eighth, who retired all six Shockers in order to preserve the no-hitter. The Shockers sent just 28 batters to the plate, which is one above the minimum.

The Duos' gem became the 17th no-hitter in Big West history and the first since May 24, 2015, when Cal State Fullerton's Justin Garza threw a no-no against CSUN.

• In 2015 Cal Poly produced 27 wins to bump Head Coach Larry Lee's victory total to 423 wins during his tenure in the Big West, moving him to sixth all-time in the conference annals. He surpassed UNLV's Fred Dallimore (1985-95), who registered 402 overall wins during his time in the Big West. The top names on the elite list are as follows:

• A total of 17 Big West regular season baseball contests aired across ESPN3 and ESPNU platforms this spring. All games originated from Southern California member institutions Cal State Fullerton, CSUN, Long Beach State, UC Irvine and UC Riverside, and every Big West school made an appearance on the schedule. In addition, ESPNU and FOX Prime Ticket also aired a select few contests throughout the year.

Every game on ESPN's platforms was available through WatchESPN, accessible online at WatchESPN.com, on smartphones and tablets via the WatchESPN app, on Xbox 360, Xbox One, Apple TV, Google Chromecast, Amazon Fire TV and Roku. Live streams of all the Watch ESPN Networks are available at no additional cost to fans who receive ESPN as part of their TV subscription.
