PRIOR TO TIPOFF

UC SANTA BARBARA VS. UC DAVIS (UCSB leads 1-0 in BWT) – UCSB brings an eight-game winning streak into the quarterfinals. The Gauchos are tied with Hawai'i for longest win streak by a Big West team this season. The two teams were ranked one-two in scoring defense during conference play.

HAWAII VS. CAL STATE FULLERTON (1st BWT meeting) – The trio of Stefan Jankovic, Aaron Valdes and Roderick Bobbitt average 43.3 of UH's conference-best 77.8 points per game.

UC IRVINE VS. CAL POLY (CP leads 2-1 in BWT) – Cal Poly was the first No. 7 seed to win the Big West Tournament in 2014, and the Mustangs are back in that slot. The Anteaters are attempting to become the first conference team since UC Santa Barbara in 2010 and 2011 to win back-to-back tourney championships.

LONG BEACH STATE vs. UC RIVERSIDE (LBSU leads 1-0 in BWT) – The only game of the four quarterfinals in which the two teams split the regular season. LBSU has won nine of its last 10, while UCR has lost seven of eight.

Player Of The Week

Nick Faust, Long Beach State

Sr. • 6-6 • Guard

Baltimore, Md. • Maryland

Long Beach State senior Nick Faust played key roles in a pair of two-point victories to earn Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

It marked the third time that Faust has won the award this season.

Faust averaged 24.5 points and 7.0 rebounds to lead the Beach past Cal State Fullerton (75-73) and regular season co-champion Hawai'i (74-72). He shot 46.9 (15 of 32) percent from the field and 78.9 (15 of 19) percent at the free throw line.

The 6-6 guard notched 30 points and added eight rebounds, two steals and block in the win over the Titans. He made 9 of 19 from the field, including three three-pointers. It was his second 30-point effort of the season.

In the win over the 'Bows, Faust led the Beach in scoring a second time with 19 points and six rebounds on Senior Day. LBSU won for the ninth time in the last 10 games. Faust led the team in scoring for the 19th time this season. He hit a key basket with 1:18 remaining to tie the game at 72-72.

Join The Club: Senior David Nwaba became the 23rd player in Mustang history to tally 1,000 career points, doing so emphatically as he scored a career-high 25 to go with 10 rebounds against UC Irvine.

Nwaba Note: Nwaba leads the Big West with 172 free throw attempts this season.

Cold Front: Cal Poly made just 8 of 50 three-point attempts (16.0%) combined in their two games last week.

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Back In The Field: Cal State Fullerton is back in the Big West Tournament after a one-year hiatus. The Titans are seeking to snap a four-game tournament losing streak, having not advanced out of the first round since defeating CSUN in 2010.

Frosh Leader: In addition to setting the CSF single-season freshman scoring record, currently at 424 points, Khalil Ahmad is the conference's top scoring frosh at 14.6 points per game, seventh-best in the Big West.

Akoh's Flow: Sophomore Jamar Akoh tallied his third double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in last week's loss to Long Beach State. He has five games with 10 or more rebounds, and ranks No. 6 in the Big West on the boards at 6.4 per game.

Remember That Titans: CSF's first round tournament opponent, top-seeded Hawai'i, trailed the Titans by four points with 26 seconds to play on Jan. 16, but sent the game into overtime and outscored CSF 14-7 in the extra period.

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One For The Ages: CSUN lost a triple overtime thriller to UC Davis, 87-83, in the final game of the season on Saturday night. The Matadors last had played a triple OT game on Feb. 13, 2010 when they lost to Cal State Fullerton by one point.

Free Throw Strength: Through the regular season, CSUN finished as the team with the most free throws made (527), second-most attempted (735) and top free throw percentage (.717) of any Big West squad. The Matadors attempted 24 or more free throw in each of their final eight contests.

Hale-Edmerson Ends Brilliant Career: Senior Tre Hale-Edmerson finished a exceptional career at CSUN with 813 points, 727 rebounds, 303 assists, 188 blocked shots and 137 steals. Hale-Edmerson's 188 swats places him No. 6 in the Big West record book.

Smith's Impact: Kendall Smith, who missed nine games due to NCAA transfer rules, led the team with 15.3 points per game. He finished with seven 20-point games.

Three-Point Record On Notice: With 258 three-pointers made, Long Beach State is on the verge of establishing a single-season record. The 2006-07 squad currently owns the record of 273. LBSU, which has hit double-digit threes eight times this season, has not done so since Jan. 23 at UC Riverside.

Faust In The Top 10: Senior Nick Faust is tied with Jibril Hodges (2004-05) for No. 198 10 on the LBSU single-season chart for made three-pointers with 74. Next up on the list are Casper Ware and Donovan Morris at 75, and Tony Darden with 79.

Record Breaking Mamadou: Junior Mamadou Ndiaye became UCI's all-time blocked shots leader with one swat against UC Riverside. It was his 209th career rejection, supplanting former teammate Will Davis II from the top spot.

Mamadou Part II: Ndiaye is currently the Big West's career field goal percentage leader. The 7-6 center has made 323 for 479 (.674) in 81 career games. He's ahead of former Anteater Kevin Magee (1980-82) at .656.

He Can Do More Than Score: Junior Luke Nelson is UCI's leading scorer at 13.3 points per game – No. 10 in the Big West – but he's also been distributing the ball at a high rate. Over the last six games, the 6-3 guard has racked up 37 assists against just nine turnovers. His 131 helpers this season is the fourth-highest total in the Big West.

WILLIAMS REACHES 300 WINS

Bob Williams reached the landmark 300th career win on Feb. 18 at UC Riverside, becoming just the third head coach in Big West history to do so. In his 18th year at UC Santa Barbara, Williams has compiled a 305-236 record, including five 20-win seasons. The only other two coaches to attain 300 wins have actually gone over the 400 mark – Pacific's Bob Thomason (436) and Jerry Tarkanian, who collected 405 victories between Long Beach State and UNLV. Williams is the longest tenured Division I head coach west of the Mississippi River.
