PRIOR TO TIPOFF

HAWAII vs. CALIFORNIA (NCAA, TBS) – Hawai'i is back in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Rainbow Warriors have tied the school record with 27 wins, the most by a Big West school since Pacific went 27-4 in 2004-05.

LONG BEACH STATE AT WASHINGTON (NIT, ESPN2) – Long Beach State has reached the 20-win plateau for the third time under head coach Dan Monson, and has won 11 of its last 13 games. The Beach has established a school single-season record for three-pointers made with 279.

UC IRVINE AT NORTH DAKOTA (CIT) – UC Irvine is in a postseason tournament for the fourth straight year, and the second time in the CIT. The Anteaters need one more win to set the record for victories in a season. UCI junior 7-6 center Mamadou Ndiaye is No. 3 in Big West history for blocked shots.

Season Ends: Cal Poly fell in the quarterfinals of the Big West Tournament to finish the season 10-20. The Mustangs lost their final five games, including the quarterfinal game to UC Irvine, 84-64.

Better Than The Record Showed: Despite Cal Poly's 4-12 conference record, eight of its 16 conference games were decided by five points or less. The Mustangs were 2-6 in those games.

Sharp Shooter: Senior Reese Morgan made 74 of his 85 baskets from three-point range this season. Morgan finished his career with 154 three-point makes, tied for ninth-most in Cal Poly history.

In The Record Books: Senior Joel Awich concluded his Mustang career with 111 blocked shots, No. 3 in the record book.

Protect That Ball: Cal Poly topped the conference in fewest turnovers per game (10.3).

Titans Fall: Cal State Fullerton lost in the Big West Tournament first round for the fifth straight time, and has not advanced in the tourney since 2010. The 75-44 setback to Hawai'i was CSF's largest margin of defeat this season.

Frosh Leader: In addition to setting the CSF single-season freshman scoring record, currently at 429 points, Khalil Ahmad is the conference's top scoring frosh at 14.3 points per game, seventh-best in the Big West.

Coggins Etches His Name In History: Junior guard Tre' Coggins made 75 three-pointers, good to tie him for ninth in the Titan single-season record book alongside Joe Small (1990-91) and Mark Hill (1988-89).

Coggins Again: Coggins posted the fourth-best single-season free throw percentage (.853) in CSF history, making 87 of his 102 attempts.

Equality: The Titans won five home and five road games.

One For The Ages: CSUN lost a triple overtime thriller to UC Davis, 87-83, in the final game of the season on Saturday night. The Matadors last had played a triple OT game on Feb. 13, 2010 when they lost to Cal State Fullerton by one point.

Free Throw Strength: Through the regular season, CSUN finished as the team with the most free throws made (527), second-most attempted (735) and top free throw percentage (.717) of any Big West squad. The Matadors attempted 24 or more free throw in each of their final eight contests.

Hale-Edmerson Ends Brilliant Career: Senior Tre Hale-Edmerson finished a exceptional career at CSUN with 813 points, 727 rebounds, 303 assists, 188 blocked shots and 137 steals. Hale-Edmerson's 188 swats places him No. 6 in the Big West record book.

Smith's Impact: Kendall Smith, who missed nine games due to NCAA transfer rules, led the team with 15.3 points per game. He finished with seven 20-point games.

Headed To NIT: Long Beach State is the first Big West squad to receive an at-large selection to the National Invitation Tournament since the selection process changed in 2005-06. It is LBSU's eighth trip to the NIT. The program is 2-7 in the NIT all-time.

Monson's Magic: Head coach Dan Monson has guided the Beach to their third 20-win season during his nine-year tenure. He takes a team that has won 11 of its last 13 contests into Tuesday's NIT contest at Washington.

Faust On Doorstep Of Top 10: Senior Nick Faust scored 53 points in three Big West Tournament games to increase his season total to 583, which ranks 12th in single-season history at LBSU. He is only eight points from entering the top-10.

Bibbins With The Spark: Sophomore Justin Bibbins, one of the top playmakers in the Big West, has developed into one of the Beach's most potent offensive threats. Stefan Jankovic, Eran Ganot Earn Top Honors From Regular Season Co-Champion Hawai'i **Big West Announces Men's Basketball All-Conference Team**

IRVINE, CA – After capturing a share of the regular season title, Hawai'i collected two of the premier individual awards to highlight the announcement of the 2015-16 Big West men's basketball all-conference team. Junior **Stefan Jankovic** earned Big West Player of the Year honors with **Eran Ganot** notching Coach of the Year accolades. **Nick Faust** of Long Beach State collected the Newcomer of the Year award while Cal State Fullerton guard **Khalil Ahmad** garnered Freshman of the Year recognition, as voted on by the nine head coaches.

Jankovic is the first Rainbow Warrior student-athlete named as Player of the Year. The 6-11 forward averaged 15.7 points, 6.8 rebounds and 1.3 blocked shots per game. He ranked third in the conference in field goal percentage (.559). Jankovic, a two-time winner of Big West Player of the Week honors, topped the 20-point mark eight times and scored a career-high 34 points on Feb. 18 at CSUN. Jankovic accumulated a league-high tying five double-doubles. In conference play, Jankovic's numbers climbed to 16.9 points and 7.3 rebounds per game, ranking him No. 2 in both categories.

Ganot becomes just the fourth head coach to earn Big West Coach of the Year honors in his rookie season, joining UC Santa Barbara's Bob Williams (1998-99), San Jose State's Bill Berry (1979-80) and Fresno State's Boyd Grant (1977-78) on that list. He guided the Rainbow Warriors to a 24-5 overall record and a first-place tie for the Big West title at 13-3, the program's first league crown since winning the WAC in 2001-02. Ganot's 24 wins are tied for the most by a first-year Big West head coach, alongside coaching legends Jerry Tarkanian and Lute Olson from Long Beach State.

Faust, a transfer from Maryland, is the first student-athlete from the Beach to be honored as Newcomer of the Year. The 6-6 guard averaged 18.4 points to lead all scorers during conference play, and was second in overall games (17.1 ppg). Faust posted nine games of 20 points or more, including a career-high 34 points versus UC Santa Barbara on Jan. 28 and 30 against Cal State Fullerton on Mar. 2. Faust also ranks among the conference leaders in steals (No. 3 - 1.5 spg) and three-point field goals made (No. 4 - 2.4 3pg). The native of Baltimore, Md. secured Big West Player of the Week honors on two occasions.

Ahmad is the third Cal State Fullerton student-athlete, and first since Bobby Brown in 2003-04, to be bestowed with the Freshman of the Year honor. The 6-4 guard broke Brown's single-season freshman scoring record of 369, and has scored 424 points for the Titans. Ahmad ranks No. 7 in Big West scoring at 14.6 points per game. The Corona, Calif. native has scored in double figures in 22 of 29 games, including six contests of 20 or more as the conference's top scoring freshman.

The All-Big West First Team features one multiple selection – UC Santa Barbara senior **Michael Bryson** makes his second straight appearance. The remaining five members make their initial appearances – UC Irvine junior teammates **Luke Nelson** and **Mamadou Ndiaye**, Hawai'i mates Jankovic and senior **Roderick Bobbitt**, and Faust from Long Beach State.

Of the 20 players who received first team, second team or honorable mention recognition, 13 have at least one year of eligibility remaining.

Eight Big West Conference teams head to Anaheim to compete for the 2016 Big West Basketball Tournament championship and the conference's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament. The action begins on Thursday, March 10 at Honda Center.

Big West Announces Men's Basketball All-Specialty Awards

IRVINE, CA – Three juniors were represented on the 2016 Big West Men's Basketball All-Specialty award announcement. Long Beach State guard/forward **Travis Hammonds** notched Best Sixth Player accolades, UC Irvine center **Mamadou Ndiaye** claimed the Best Defensive Player award, and UC Davis guard **Darius Graham** earned the honor of Best Hustle Player.

The conference's nine head coaches voted on the awards for the 16th straight season.

Hammonds is the first student-athlete from Long Beach State to secure the Best Sixth Player honor. Hailing from Columbia, S.C., Hammonds is the squad's fourth-leading scorer (9.8 ppg) and third-best rebounder (4.9 rpg). He is tied for second among Beach players with 46 three-point baskets, and ranks No. 10 in the Big West in threes made per game (1.6). Hammonds erupted for a single-game school record-tying eight three-pointers, finishing with a career-high 27 points against Oregon on Dec. 18. Appearing in 28 games, he hit two or more threes in 14 contests, and scored in double-digits in six of his final nine conference outings.

For the second time in his three-year UC Irvine career, Mamadou Ndiaye earned the Best Defensive Player tag. He also claimed the honor as a freshman in 2014. It is the third time in the last four years that an Anteater student-athlete has received the award. Ndiaye, a 7-6 center, led the Big West in total blocked shots (78) and blocked shots per game (2.4). He became the fourth player in Big West history to collect 200 career blocks, and surpassed former teammate Will Davis II for the all-time school mark with his 209th rejection against UC Riverside on Mar. 5. A native of Dakar, Senegal, Ndiaye recorded at least one swat in 30 of 32 contests, including a season-high eight at Cal Poly on Feb. 3.

Graham became the second UC Davis student-athlete to earn the Best Hustle Award, and the first since Joe Harden captured the hardware back-to-back in 2010 and 2011. The team's floor leader as the starting point guard, Graham was the only Aggie to start all 29 regular season games. He is tied for second in scoring (10.0 ppg), and leads in assists (79), three-pointers made (47) and minutes played (972). In his last outing, an 87-83 triple overtime victory at CSUN, Graham played 47 minutes and contributed 18 points, four assists and three steals. A Sacramento, Calif. native, Graham's 47 threes eclipses the 32 he combined for in the previous two seasons.
