Player Of The Week

Roderick Bobbitt, Hawai'i
Sr. • 6-3 • Guard
Oakland, Calif. • Indian Hills CC

Hawai'i senior Roderick Bobbitt delivered two all-around solid performances in the Outrigger Resorts Rainbow Classic that led to his selection as Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

The 6-3 guard averaged 16.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 9.0 assists and 4.5 steals in a pair of Rainbow Warrior victories over Montana State (87-76) and Coastal Carolina (74-63), helping first-year UH head coach Eran Ganot to a 2-0 start.

Bobbitt posted a double-double in the season opener with 10 points and 14 assists against the Bobcats. The 14 helpers broke the tournament record of 13. In addition, he had five rebounds, five steals and a block to give UH versatile contributions.

In the win over the Chanticleers, Bobbitt scored 23 points on 7-of-10 shooting and knocked down four three-pointers. He came up three points short of his career high, but again delivered in a variety of ways with five more boards, four assists and four steals.

For the week, Bobbitt shot 52.6 percent (10-of-19) from the field and 54.5 percent (6-of-11) from distance as Hawai'i advanced to the championship game of the Rainbow Classic.

Making A Case: Cal Poly started out the season 0-2, but both losses came on the road to UNLV by two points and UCLA by five. The Mustangs averaged 77.5 points over the two contests, and,

after failing to reach 80 points in any game last season, they put up 83 versus the Bruins.

Count 'Em Five: For the first time under seventh-year head coach Joe Callero, five Mustangs are averaging in double figures. Reese Morgan (16.0 ppg), Joel Awich (12.5), Taylor Sutlive (12.5), David Nwaba (11.5) and Luke Meikle (11.0) have all fed into Callero's promise to be a more uptempo team this year.

For Three: Cal Poly drained 13 three-pointers (on 27 attempts) against UCLA, including six from Morgan as he scored a team-high 20 points.

The Meikle Touch: Meikle, a transfer from Gonzaga, poured in a career-high 18 points on 6-of-14 shooting against UCLA. He also made a pair of three-pointers.

Win Column: Cal State Fullerton picked up a come-from-behind one-point win at Pacific on Tuesday, halting a nine-game road losing streak that dated back to last season. It also represented the first time CSF had defeated the Tigers since 2012.

Coggins Makes Impact: Junior Tre' Coggins, an Air Force transfer, has proved to be a welcome addition to the Titan lineup as he collected a team-high 21 points against Pacific, shooting 7-of-14 from the field and knocking down four treys.

Board Machine: Senior Kennedy Esume corraled a career-high 19 rebounds in the season-opening 79-74 loss at Loyola Marymount. His previous career-best was nine boards.

Home Sweet Home: The Titans have won 11 straight home openers and hope to extend the streak on Saturday against San Diego. CSF has not lost a home opener since Nov. 29, 2003, a 78-71 setback in overtime to Sacramento State. Under head coach Dedrique Taylor, the Titans have beaten Santa Clara and San Jose State in home debuts.

In Review: The Matadors returned from the Northern Illinois Showcase with a 1-2 record after picking up an impressive 72-67 win over Wright State and sustaining a close 76-72 loss to South

Dakota among last week's competition.

New Faces Shine: Head coach Reggie Theus played seven individuals at the NIU Showcase, and four saw their first action as Matadors. Freshman guard Jason Richardson impressed in his debut, averaging a team-best 16.7 points while dropping 22 on South Dakota. Sophomores Tavron Dawson (14.3 ppg) and Micheal Warren (13.3) also contributed solidly for the young squad.

Respite: Playing a rugged schedule to start the season, with six of their first seven games on the road, the Matadors welcome the opportunity to play their home opener Wednesday against Vanguard.

Record Book Watch: Senior Landon Drew is 24 assists shy of becoming the third CSUN player to reach 400 in a career.

Foreshadowing?: Long Beach State opened the season with back-to-back victories over BYU-Hawai'i and BYU, marking the first time since the 2011-12 season that the 49ers have began 2-0.

That year, LBSU reached the NCAA Tournament.

De-Fense, De-Fense: The 49ers scrapped to hold a potent BYU team to 65 points and forced the Cougars into 24 turnovers, their highest number of miscues since 29 against Pepperdine during the 2007-08 season. LBSU also capitalized with 23 points off of those 24 turnovers.

Blackwell Stands Out: Freshman guard Noah Blackwell has had a productive start to his 49er career, averaging 12 points in the two wins and shooting 61.5 percent overall (8-of-13) and 75.0 percent (6-of-8) from three. Blackwell scored a team-high 11 points in the BYU victory.

Monson Watch: LBSU head coach Dan Monson is No. 15 in Big West history with 137 career wins. He is now just one victory shy of the No. 14 spot (Rod Tueller, Utah State, 138), while San Jose State's Bill Berry (142) occupies the No. 13 slot.

Streak Snapped: UC Davis saw its 14-game home court winning streak end at the hands of North Dakota State, which overcame a late nine-point deficit to topple the Aggies in overtime in the season opener. However, the

Aggies rebounded with a 13-point home win over Portland. The loss to North Dakota State snapped a four-game win streak in overtime contests.

Sly As A Fox: Senior Josh Fox shot 51.7 percent (15-of-29) over the first two games, keeping pace with his league-best field goal percentage from the 2014-15 season. Fox averaged a double-double of 15.5 points and 10.0 rebounds to help UC Davis to a split of its first two contests.
