Player Of The Week

Joel Awich, Cal Poly
Sr. • 6-7 • Forward
St. Paul, Minn. • Tartan HS

Named the Most Valuable Player of the Maui Invitational Regional Round, Cal Poly senior Joel Awich received the nod as Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

The 6-7 forward led the Mustangs to a 3-0 record last week, including neutral court victories over Austin Peay (73-64) and UMBC (78-65) in the Maui Invitational. He averaged a team-leading 18.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 58.3 percent (21-for-36) from the field and 64.3 percent (9-for-14).

Awich equaled his career high with 19 points against Austin Peay to go along with six rebounds and a blocked shot. Against UMBC, he produced 18 points, nine rebounds, two assists and a block. Awich shot 7-for-11 from the field against both the Governors and Retrievers, and hit a combined seven treys in the wins.

In a 71-62 triumph over Cal State Monterey Bay, Awich notched 17 points, six rebounds and a steal, adding a pair of three-pointers as part of a 7-for-14 shooting performance.

Through four games, Awich is shooting a torrid 11-for-22 from three-point territory and is tied for third in the Big West in made three-point field goals.

Successful Trip: Cal Poly returned from last weekend's roadtrip as champions of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational Regional Round after toppling Austin Peay and UMBC. The Mustangs return home for

the next three games, beginning with Antelope Valley on Saturday.

Offense Found: Prior to the season, head coach Joe Callero promised the Mustangs would focus on becoming a more uptempo team. So far, they have. Cal Poly has exceeded the 70-point mark in all five games. In 2014-15, the team scored 70 or more seven times for *the entire season*.

From Distance: Cal Poly has had a couple of impressive performances from three-point range, including 15 makes against UMBC. The Mustangs shot a sizzling percentage of .556 in hitting those 15 threes.

Sheading The Freshman Moniker: True freshman Jaylen Shead, after an 0-for-5 performance in his collegiate debut, has hit 13 of 16 field goal attempts in the last four games.

Back-To-Back: Cal State Fullerton dispatched its second consecutive WCC opponent with Saturday's 12-point victory over San Diego. The Titans scored 20 points off of 19 Torero turnovers, and

committed just nine miscues themselves.

Home Opener Extraordinaire: The triumph over San Diego represented the 12th straight season that the Titans won their home opener.

Effective Minutes: Freshman Khalil Ahmad has scored in double figures in two of his first three collegiate games, including 11 points on 3-of-3 three-point shooting against San Diego.

Terrific Transfers: The two Division I transfers for the Titans, Tre' Coggins (Air Force) and Malcolm Brooks (Pepperdine) have been as good as advertised. The duo has tallied 87 of the team's 218 points, or 40 percent of the total offense. Coggins ranks seventh in the Big West in scoring (15.0 ppg) while Brooks is tied for 10th (14.0).

Good Showing: Long Beach State went 1-2 at the Gilman Charleston Classic, but knocked off a Big East opponent in Seton Hall and went down to the wire against Big 12 foe Oklahoma State before

losing by five points. The 49ers travel to Oklahoma State for a Friday rematch.

Great Start: The win over Seton Hall gave LBSU its first 3-0 start since the 1993-94 campaign.

Faust First Impression: Maryland transfer Nick Faust has had a positive impact on the 49ers through five games. The senior has scored in double figures in all five and had a team-high 16 points in the Seton Hall win. Over the last three games, he also is shooting 10-for-20 (50%) from three-point range. He has canned two or more treys on four occasions, including a 4-for-7 effort against Seton Hall.

Monson Watch: The Seton Hall victory tied LBSU head coach Dan Monson with Utah State's Rod Tueller for No. 14 in Big West history on the career wins list with 138. Next up on the chart is San Jose State's Bill Berry, who occupies the No. 13 slot with 142 victories.
