Player Of The Week

Tre' Coggins, Cal State Fullerton
Jr. • 6-2 • Guard
San Juan Capistrano, Calif. • Air Force

Back-to-back 25-point games led to the selection of Cal State Fullerton junior Tre' Coggins as Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

The 6-3 guard registered his career-high in consecutive victories over Southern Utah (80-66) and Nevada (75-66), helping the Titans improve to 4-1 on the season and equal their best start since 2007-08.

Coggins shot 45.7 percent (16-of-35) from the field overall and an impressive 52.9 percent (9-for-17) from three-point range for the week.

In the win at Southern Utah, CSF's second road win this season, Coggins amassed his 25 points on 7-of-14 shooting and knocked down a quintet of three balls, as well as draining six of his nine free throw attempts. He also helped the Titans with seven rebounds and a steal.

The victory over Nevada was keyed by another four three-pointers from Coggins, who scored eight of the team's first 10 points in the second half to stake the Titans to a lead they would never relinquish.

Coggins padded his stat line against the Wolf Pack with four rebounds, two assists and two steals in 30 minutes.

Winning Continues: Cal Poly extended its winning streak to four straight with Saturday's 85-55 decision over Antelope Valley. The Mustangs seek their first five-game winning streak since the

2012-13 season when they host IPFW on Thursday.

Offense Found: Prior to the season, head coach Joe Callero promised the Mustangs would focus on becoming a more uptempo team. So far, they have. Cal Poly has exceeded the 70-point mark in all six games. In 2014-15, the team scored 70 or more seven times for the entire season.

Non-Conference Success: The Mustangs have defeated their last eight consecutive non-conference opponents at home, dating back to the 2013-14 season.

Bennett Boards: Senior Brian Bennett is three rebounds away from moving into No. 14 all-time at Cal Poly and surpassing Stuart Thomas (465, 1989-91). He also scored a season-high 14 points in 19 reserve minutes against Antelope Valley.

Rolling: Cal State Fullerton knocked off Southern Utah and Nevada last week to expand its winning streak to four straight. The Titans encounter a busy week with three games, beginning with

Cal State Dominguez Hills on Tuesday. CSF's longest winning streak in recent memory included a six-gamer and a seven-gamer during the 2011-12 season.

Defense Gets It Done: The Titans have held their last three opponents to under 40 percent shooting and an average of 62.3 points per game. San Diego, Southern Utah and Nevada have shot a combined 37.0 percent (64-of-173) against the Titans.

Coggins Leads: Redshirt junior Tre' Coggins is the conference scoring leader at 19.0 points per game. The guard has topped the 20-point mark three times and has scored in double figures in all five games.

Ahmad's Arsenal: Freshman Khalil Ahmad contributed a career-high 22 points in CSF's win at Southern Utah.

Youth Is Served: Head Coach Reggie Theus mainly has trotted out a seven-player rotation, including three sophomores and one freshman. Those four players – Jason Richardson, Micheal Warren, Tavron Dawson and Zacary Douglas – have accounted for 334 of CSUN's 473 points, or 71 percent of the team's offense.

Tre-Hale Inches Closer To Top 10: Senior Tre-Hale Edmerson, with at least one steal in five straight games, is now up to 119 career steals. That puts him just three short of tying Davin White (2003-05) and Brian Heinle (1997-2001) for No. 10 all-time at CSUN.

Balance: Three players are averaging in double figures, led by senior Nick Faust at 13.8 points per game. Seven players in the LBSU rotation have averaged at least six points per contest.

Spencer Steps Up: Senior A.J. Spencer turned in season-highs of 16 points, four three-pointers and six rebounds in Friday's road loss to Oklahoma State. He also played a season-best 31 minutes against the Cowboys.
