Player Of The Week

Nick Faust, Long Beach State
Sr. • 6-6 • Guard
Baltimore, Md. • Maryland

Long Beach State senior Nick Faust averaged over 20 points per game and shot better than 50 percent from the field in a busy four-game stretch, capturing Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week accolades.

The 6-6 guard posted three 20-point games while shooting 51.7 percent (30-for-58) overall, including a torrid 54.8 percent (17-for-31) from three-point range in a 2-2 week for the Beach.

Faust led the Beach in points (87), points per game (21.8), threes made (17) and steals (9) to help LBSU split the four games in a six-day period.

Faust started the week with 20 points on 7-of-14 shooting against San Diego State, hitting 4-of-7 from distance. He added seven rebounds and three steals against the Aztecs.

In an 83-77 road victory against Colorado State, Faust erupted for 27 points, five rebounds, four assists and five steals. He knocked down five three-pointers en route to an 8-for-14 shooting performance from the field.

Faust chipped in 16 points in a 67-53 home win against New Mexico State, draining a trio of treys. He nearly led a road upset of UCLA, pouring in a team-high 24 points with seven rebounds in a narrow 83-76 loss.

Bulldogs Bounced: Cal Poly recorded its first home victory over Fresno State since Feb. 4, 1971, taking a 77-65 decision over the Bulldogs before 2,861 on Saturday. The Mustangs won for the 16th time in their last 19 non-conference games at home.

Offensive Uptick Continues: Cal Poly surpassed the 70-point mark for the eighth time in eight games this season. The Mustangs scored 70 or more points just seven times in 29 games last season.

Taking Offense: The Mustangs rank third in the Big West in scoring offense at 76.5 points per game. In contrast, Cal Poly finished last in the league in scoring offense in each of the last two seasons.

Close Calls: Cal Poly's three losses have come by a combined nine points.

On Tap: The Mustangs embark on a season-long six-game roadtrip beginning on Dec. 14 against Saint Mary's.

Superlatives: In defeating Seattle on Friday, Cal State Fullerton won its sixth game in a row, the program's longest winning streak since a six-gamer during the 2011-12 season. The win also upped

the record to 6-1, marking the best start by a Titan squad since a 7-1 beginning to the 1986-87 season.

Brooks Shines On Roadie: Senior Malcolm Brooks posted back-to-back career-high 20-point performances on last week's roadtrip to play Seattle and Washington. He also made 14 of his 25 field goal attempts in the two games.

One Last Chance: Cal State Fullerton attempts to win its eighth straight home non-conference game when Loyola Marymount visits Titan Gym on Saturday. The Lions are 3-1 against Big West teams this season, including a season-opening 79-74 home win against the Titans on Nov. 13.

Easy Recipe: The Titans are 5-0 this season when limiting their opposition to less than 70 points. In contrast, CSF has allowed its two highest scoring outputs in its two defeats.

Take A Break: The Matadors lost their fifth straight game, a 65-61 setback at San Francisco on Monday, and have 10 days to regroup before resuming play on Dec. 17 at Portland State.

They're Due: The Matadors seek to snap a 15-game road non-conference losing streak in their next matchup at Portland State. CSUN's last non-conference road win occurred on Dec. 20, 2013 at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

Tre-Hale On The Doorstep: Senior Tre-Hale Edmerson, with at least one steal in seven straight games, is now up to 121 career steals. That puts him just one short of tying Davin White (2003-05) and Brian Heinle (1997-2001) for No. 10 all-time at CSUN.

Dawson's Double-Double: Coming off the bench for the first time this season, sophomore Tavron Dawson responded with his first career double-double of 19 points and 11 rebounds, both game-highs in the loss at San Francisco. He has seven or more boards in seven straight games.

Strong Week: Long Beach State completed four games in six days with a 2-2 record, earning solid wins over Colorado State and New Mexico State while nearly upsetting San Diego State and UCLA.

The Beach closes out its non-conference slate with four of the next five games on the road.

Perimeter Party: The Beach is shooting 45.5 (55-for-121) percent from three-point land over the last five games. The team has made 10 or more treys four times in that span. LBSU ranks No. 2 in the Big West in three-point accuracy (.402).

The Farther The Better: LBSU has three players sporting better shooting percentages on threes than twos – Nick Faust (.456-.406), Justin Bibbins (.375-.350) and Noah Blackwell (.457-.333). The trio has combined to hit 62 of LBSU's 90 made threes on the season.

Bibbins The Distributor: Sophomore point guard Justin Bibbins has dished out six or more assists in seven games. Over the last six contests, he has recorded 40 assists against just eight turnovers, a 5-to-1 ratio.

Fox In Favor: Senior Josh Fox is hitting shots at an impressive rate. In the last six contests, the forward has knocked down 37 of his 55 field goal attempts, or 67.3 percent. Fox has scored in double figures in all seven games, including 19 points against Saint Mary's on Saturday.

Better Ball Control: After a three-game stretch in which the Aggies committed 61 turnovers, the last three outings have yielded nearly half the number of miscues – 33 to be exact. UC Davis turned the ball over a season-low eight times in the Saint Mary's game.
