## Player Of The Week

**Kendall Smith, CSUN**  
Jr. • 6-3 • Guard  
Antioch, Calif. • UNLV

CSUN junior Kendall Smith's Matador debut led to a pair of victories and his selection as the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

The UNLV transfer suited up for the first time in a Matador uniform after sitting out a year due to NCAA transfer rules, and responded by averaging 17.5 points in victories over Portland State and Bethesda University.

In Smith's debut, the 6-3 guard scored 13 points with three rebounds, two assists and a steal to help CSUN outduel the Vikings in a 77-71 triumph on Thursday. It represented CSUN's first non-conference road win in two years.

Smith had an all-around impressive game in Sunday's 79-49 rout of Bethesda, posting 22 points, two rebounds, four assists and three steals. He shot 7-of-16 from the field and knocked down a pair of three-pointers.

Both Smith's 22 points and three steals were Division I career-highs.

**The Struggle Is Real:** Cal Poly has started 0-3 on a season-long six-game road trip. In the three losses to Saint Mary's, USC and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the Mustangs allowed 91.3 points per game.

**Total Turnaround:** The conference's top defensive club in each of the last five seasons, Cal Poly ranks last in the Big West in scoring defense (74.7 ppg) through 11 games. The Mustangs are 5-0 when holding opponents under 70 points. In contrast, they have allowed foes to average 85.2 points in their six losses.

**Bennett Coming On:** With just one double figure scoring effort in his first eight games, senior Brian Bennett has recovered to hit double-digits in points in three straight contests. He is averaging 12.0 points and shooting 60.7 (17-of-28) percent over that span.

**Tickling The Twine:** The Mustangs rank No. 3 in the Big West in three-point percentage (.383). They have shot 43.6 percent (17-of-39) from distance over the last two games.

**Reeling:** The momentum from a 6-1 start has evaporated as Cal State Fullerton is mired in a four-game losing streak. The Titans lost a pair of games to Oregon State and Portland at the Far West

Classic last weekend.

**Needed Break:** CSF gets a 10-day break before returning to action on Dec. 29 at Portland State. The Titans will be going for their fourth non-conference road win.

**Key Cog:** Junior Tre' Coggins has hit at least two threes in all 11 games this season. The 6-2 guard ranks No. 2 in the Big West in total threes made (34) and threes made per game (3.1).

**Boarder's Delight:** Sophomore forward Jamar Akoh yanked down a career-high 18 rebounds in CSF's 65-60 loss to Portland on Saturday. It was the second-highest single-game total in the Big West this season, behind only teammate Kennedy Esume's 19 caroms at Loyola Marymount on Nov. 13.

**Winning Time:** CSUN posted back-to-back wins for the first time this season after defeating Portland State and Bethesda College last week. In knocking off the Vikings, the Matadors recorded their first

non-conference road win in two years, the last one a 67-66 triumph on Dec. 20, 2013 at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.

**Steal Mongering:** The Matadors have notched their two highest single-game steal totals in the last two games – 10 against Portland State and 11 versus Bethesda.

**Bench Barometer:** A starter in the first eight games and off the bench in the last three, sophomore Tavרון Dawson is excelling as a reserve. He has posted two double-doubles in that stretch, including career-highs of 21 points and 13 rebounds against Bethesda.

**Hale-Edmerson Reaches Top 10:** Senior Tre Hale-Edmerson took over the No. 10 slot in the CSUN career record book for steals with two against Bethesda, giving him 123. Josh Greene is next on the list at No. 9 with 128.
