Player Of The Week

Roderick Bobbitt, Hawai'i

Sr. • 6-3 • Guard

Oakland, Calif. • Indian Hills (Iowa) CC

Back-to-back 30-point efforts landed Hawai'i senior Roderick Bobbitt his second Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award this season.

The 6-3 guard earned a spot on the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic All-Tournament team as he helped the Rainbow Warriors match their best finish in the tournament with a third place showing.

Bobbitt opened the tourney with a relatively quiet scoring night of four points against Northern Iowa, but he dished out a game-high eight assists to go along with three rebounds and a steal in a 68-52 win.

Against No. 2/3 Oklahoma, Bobbitt poured in a career-high 32 points on 8-of-12 shooting, including 3-for-4 from three-point range and 13-for-16 at the free throw line. He added six assists, four rebounds and three steals as UH nearly upset the Sooners in an 84-81 loss.

Smith became just the third player in UH history to record back-to-back 30-point games as he erupted for 30 against Auburn in the third place game. He hit a career-high six three-pointers (in 7 attempts) as the 'Bows the 79-67 victory over the SEC opponent.

Resounding "W": Cal Poly halted a three-game losing streak with an impressive 15-point road victory over UTSA Tuesday. The Mustangs shot 47.1 percent, dished out a season-high 23

assists and committed just seven turnovers to move their record back to the .500 mark.

Morgan From Downtown: Senior guard Reese Morgan is shooting 56.3 (9-for-16) percent from distance over the last three games.

Score, Score, Score: The Mustangs have scored 70 or more points 11 times in 12 games and have surpassed the 80-point mark on four occasions. Cal Poly is averaging 76.6 points per game, the program's highest scoring average under seventh-year head coach Joe Callero.

Big Opportunity: Cal Poly closes out non-conference play with a matchup against No. 19/21 Texas A&M on Tuesday. It is just the second all-time meeting with an SEC opponent, the first a 69-64 loss at Vanderbilt on Nov. 29, 2001.

Reeling: The momentum from a 6-1 start has evaporated as Cal State Fullerton is mired in a four-game losing streak. The Titans hope to break out of the slump with a game at Portland State

on Tuesday, followed by their final home non-conference contest versus Cal State East Bay on Saturday.

Notable: CSF is tied with three other teams for the most road wins (3) of any Big West school this season.

Key Cog: Junior Tre' Coggins has hit at least two threes in all 11 games this season. The 6-2 guard ranks No. 2 in the Big West in total threes made (34) and threes made per game (3.1).

Last Time Out: Sophomore forward Jamar Akoh yanked down a career-high 18 rebounds in CSF's 65-60 loss to Portland in the Far West Classic. It was the second-highest single-game total in the Big West this season. Akoh eclipsed his previous season-bests by a landslide after corralling seven versus San Diego (Nov. 21) and Washington (Dec. 6).

on Tuesday before hosting Morgan State on Saturday.

Fundamental: The Matadors committed a season-low eight turnovers against San Diego. They had tied their then-previous season-low of 11 against Bethesda University for a total of just 19 miscues over the last two contests.

Moving On Up: Senior Tre Hale-Edmerson's six rebounds versus San Diego vaulted him into No. 8 in CSUN annals with 599. He is one rebound away from becoming just the seventh player in school history to amass 600 for a career.

Good Debut: Sophomore Jerron Wilbut made his CSUN debut against San Diego with an immediate impact. The 6-3 guard scored 15 points in 17 minutes, and took a team-high 15 shots. He also registered the second-most free throw attempts (7) of any Matador.

Strong Effort: Long Beach State dominated the points in the paint battle (36-22), but could overcome a parade of Arizona free throw attempts, getting outshot 32-15 at the line in an 85-70 loss to the

eighth-ranked Wildcats.

Faust Continues Solid Play: Senior Nick Faust has led the Beach after transferring in from Maryland. The 6-6 guard has scored in double figures in all 14 games, and ranks No. 3 in the Big West in scoring (16.1 ppg). Faust also has been consistently productive from long distance. He has recorded three or more treys in eight contests.

Bibbins Leads: Sophomore Justin Bibbins is tied for 14th in the nation with 82 assists. With seven dimes against Arizona, the point guard has compiled seven or more assists in seven games.

Further Proof: Bibbins has demonstrated he is one of the top distributors in the country, entering this week 14th in assist-to-turnover ratio. He has dished out 82 assists and committed just 21 turnovers. His four turnovers against Arizona was a season-high.
