Offensive Player Of The Week

Norberto Ochoa • UC Riverside

UC Riverside senior Norberto Ochoa (Riverside, Calif./Poly HS) garnered Big West Men's Soccer Offensive Player of the Week honors as he recorded just the second hat trick in the school's Division I history.

Ochoa scored goals in the 38th, 56th and 59th minutes to give the Highlanders a 3-0 triumph against San Francisco. He not only compiled his first collegiate goal, but added two more for good measure as the effort vaulted him in a tie for the Big West lead. Teammate Michael Salazar recorded the only other hat trick in UCR's D-I history, doing so on August 29, 2014 against Pacific.

For his efforts, Ochoa was named to the College Soccer News National Team of the Week.

Ochoa then served as an effective decoy against No. 8 UCLA, and the forward helped the Highlanders pull off the 2-1 upset. It was UCR's first-ever win over the Bruins, and their second-ever against a ranked, non-conference opponent.

Making the first two starts of his collegiate career, UC Riverside sophomore Vincent Morales (Bellflower, Calif./Mayfair HS) allowed just one goal in over 185 minutes to secure Big West Men's Soccer Defensive Player of the Week recognition.

Morales recorded his first career shutout in a 3-0 blanking of San Francisco. He then helped the Highlanders knock off No. 8-ranked UCLA, 2-1, as UCR recorded just its second-ever win over a nationally ranked non-conference foe.

The keeper tallied five saves in each of the two contests, and posted a .909 save percentage for the week.

Tough Loss: UC Davis put up a fight but ultimately fell, 2-1, to California in its lone action last week. The Aggies have been held to one goal or less in four of their first five matches to start the season.

Scoring Column Rediscovered: Senior Matt Wiesenfarth, who ranks second among active Big West players with 14 career goals, notched his first score of the season against the Bears. It was his first score since netting the game-winner against Sacramento State on Nov. 9, 2013. The forward missed a majority of last season with an injury.

Spread Offense: All five UC Davis goals this season have been scored by a different Aggie. Lucas Mohageg, Matt Wiesenfarth, Kristian Heptner, Ryan Gross and Matt Baringer have all cashed in.

Gross The Constant: Senior Ryan Gross has started all 67 career matches for the Aggies, and has logged nearly 6,000 career minutes in the process. His 5,997 minutes rank fourth in the school's Division 1 record book, and three shy of becoming the fourth player to top 6,000 career minutes at the Division I level.

total of 10 yellow and two red cards were issued.

Breslin Enters Top 10 In Saves: Senior goalkeeper Michael Breslin made five saves against San Diego and another six versus San Diego State to give him a league-leading 21 for the season and 252 for his career. The 252 puts Breslin just inside the Big West career top 10, surpassing Fresno State's Mark Dougherty (1986-89) for the No. 10 spot.

Net Finder: The Anteaters have struggled to find the back of the net this season, scoring a conference-low two goals through five games. They also have taken just 46 shots, one more than both Cal Poly and CSUN, which have taken the fewest with 45.

BRESLIN MOVES UP IN RECORD BOOK

UC Irvine goalkeeper Michael Breslin enters his senior season entrenched in the Big West career top 10. He ranks ninth in career shutouts (23) and minutes played (6,155) fourth in wins (36), and is tied for seventh in total matches in goal (66). Breslin also stands to make a dent in all-time saves. With 231 saves, Breslin needs just 20 more to tie Fresno State's Mark Dougherty (1986-89) for 10th place. Breslin, who stopped a career-high 93 shots last season, is in line to become just the fifth netminder in Big West history to surpass the career 300-save mark.

MINTER TARGETED FOR MAC HERMANN TROPHY WATCH LIST

Cal Poly senior Chase Minter was tabbed as one of 30 contenders for the 2015 Missouri Athletic Club's (MAC) Hermann Trophy, the most prestigious award for college soccer's national player of the year. Minter's placement on the 30-player "Watch List" comes on the heels of a 2014 campaign in which he was selected Big West Midfielder of the Year and was named to the NSCAA All-Far West Region First Team.

The Heath, Texas native is the third Mustang player to appear on the Hermann Trophy watch list, following Mackenzie Pridham in 2013 and Patrick Sigler in 2009. Minter tallied 19 points on seven goals and five assists last season. He ranked third in the Big West in points, while tying for third in both goals and assists. Minter also took a conference sixth-best 53 shots.

The Big West has had at least one player on the Hermann Trophy watch list in 10 of the last 11 years. Near the end of the collegiate regular season, NCAA Division I coaches whose programs are current NSCAA College Services members will trim the list down to 15 players. From that pool, three finalists will be chosen for the award. The winner will be announced Friday, Jan. 8, 2016, at the trophy presentation banquet at the Missouri Athletic Club in St. Louis.
