Offensive Player Of The Week

Carlos Gonzalez • CSUN
Sr. • 6-1 • Midfielder/Forward
San Fernando, Calif. • Sylmar HS

CSUN senior Carlos Gonzalez (San Fernando, Calif./Sylmar HS) earned Big West Men's Soccer Offensive Player of the Week honors after depositing a hat trick in a commanding road victory at Saint Mary's.

With just two goals scored over the previous four matches, the Matadors found a goal hawk in Gonzalez, who netted CSUN's final three goals.

Two of those goals occurred 24 seconds apart, while the third came in the 88th minute. Gonzalez notched what would prove to be the game-winner with his first goal of the match, a header past the Gael goalkeeper at the 31:11 mark. He struck again on the next sequence, burying a shot at close range off a cross from Dean Wright.

The hat trick was the first by a Matador since Sagi Levi-Ari scored three in the Big West Tournament semifinals at UC Santa Barbara on Nov. 15, 2013. The goals were also the first for Gonzalez since his freshman campaign in 2012. He now leads the Matadors with three goals and six points for the season.

Defensive Player Of The Week

Trevor Morley • CSUN
Sr. • 6-2 • Defender
San Diego, Calif. • University City HS

Scoring the first two goals of his career and spearheading a strong defensive effort, CSUN senior Trevor Morley (San Diego, Calif./University City HS) garnered Big West Men's Soccer Defensive Player of the Week accolades.

Morley was a key cog in CSUN's overall defensive strength as the unit allowed just one goal in road victories over Saint Mary's (4-1) and Santa Clara (2-0). The lone goal by the Gaels was the first that CSUN has yielded in the run of play over its last 412 minutes of action.

While the Matadors controlled much of the action defensively, Morley got in on the act from an offensive standpoint. He tied the match against Saint Mary's at 1-1 with a penalty kick goal at the 25:54 mark, the first of his career.

Against Santa Clara, Morley notched the game-winning goal in the 66th minute with another successful trip to the penalty spot. CSUN recorded its 26th and 27th road or neutral victory since the start of the 2009 season with its triumphant foray to the Bay Area.

Bombardment: CSUN erupted offensively last week to snap out of a four-game goal scoring slump. After notching just two goals during that four-game swath, the Matadors blitzed Saint Mary's for four goals and added two more on Santa Clara.

There's The Baseline: The Matadors are 3-0 this season when scoring two or more goals. CSUN has won 15 straight games using that scoring barometer, dating back to the 2013 season. The last time CSUN scored at least two goals and lost was Sept. 22, 2013, a 4-2 setback to UCLA.

Assist Man: The active Big West career leader in assists, senior David Turcios picked up his first helper of the year in CSUN's 4-1 win at Saint Mary's on Friday. It was the 19th career assist for the senior, moving him to within three of breaking into the Big West top 10.

D-Fense, D-Fense: CSUN has allowed just two goals over its last four games, and are tied for the second-fewest goals allowed (9) by a Big West school so far this season.

Eruption: UC Davis exploded with six goals, including four in the second half, to blitz visiting Pacific by a 6-0 score on Sunday. The six goals tied the program's Division I record for most goals in a game dating back to a 6-0 shutout victory over IPFW on Sept. 14, 2007. The four goals in the second stanza also equalled a school Division I mark.

Record Talk: In the 6-0 rout of Pacific, the Aggies established a school Division I record for most points in a match (17), surpassing the previous mark of 15 set against IPFW.

For Perspective: The six goal outburst against Pacific equalled the Aggie scoring output through the first six contests.

Share The Wealth: Six different Aggies scored in the Pacific romp, led by Lucas Mohageg's third strike of the year, the first of the match and the eventual game-winner. Nine players have accounted for the team's 12 goals.

One More Thing: UC Davis picked up its first shutout of the year.

Reeling: The Anteaters saw their winless streak run to six straight games after an unsuccessful road trip to Oral Roberts and SMU. UC Irvine is 0-4-2 in those six games. It is the program's longest slide since going winless for a 10-game period (0-9-1) in 2012.

Breslin Poised To Move Up In Saves: Senior goalkeeper Michael Breslin was busy last weekend, making 14 saves and increasing his career total to 266. That total puts him at No. 10 in the Big West record book, just six saves shy of the No. 8 slot.

Goal Drought: After leading the Big West with 37 goals scored in 2014, the Anteaters have managed to find the back of the net just three times this season. The three goals scored ranks last in the league, five behind the next lowest scoring squads.

Home Sweet Home: UCI is 1-0-1 at home this season, and welcomes the chance to play Loyola Marymount there this Thursday after enduring a stretch of playing five of six on the road.

BRESLIN MOVES UP IN RECORD BOOK

UC Irvine goalkeeper Michael Breslin enters his senior season entrenched in the Big West career top 10. He ranks ninth in career shutouts (23) and minutes played (6,155) fourth in wins (36), and is tied for seventh in total matches in goal (66). Breslin also stands to make a dent in all-time saves. With 231 saves, Breslin needs just 20 more to tie Fresno State's Mark Dougherty (1986-89) for 10th place. Breslin, who stopped a career-high 93 shots last season, is in line to become just the fifth netminder in Big West history to surpass the career 300-save mark.

MINTER TARGETED FOR MAC HERMANN TROPHY WATCH LIST

Cal Poly senior Chase Minter was tabbed as one of 30 contenders for the 2015 Missouri Athletic Club's (MAC) Hermann Trophy, the most prestigious award for college soccer's national player of the year. Minter's placement on the 30-player "Watch List" comes on the heels of a 2014 campaign in which he was selected Big West Midfielder of the Year and was named to the NSCAA All-Far West Region First Team.

The Heath, Texas native is the third Mustang player to appear on the Hermann Trophy watch list, following Mackenzie Pridham in 2013 and Patrick Sigler in 2009. Minter tallied 19 points on seven goals and five assists last season. He ranked third in the Big West in points, while tying for third in both goals and assists. Minter also took a conference sixth-best 53 shots.

The Big West has had at least one player on the Hermann Trophy watch list in 10 of the last 11 years. Near the end of the collegiate regular season, NCAA Division I coaches whose programs are current NSCAA College Services members will trim the list down to 15 players. From that pool, three finalists will be chosen for the award. The winner will be announced Friday, Jan. 8, 2016, at the trophy presentation banquet at the Missouri Athletic Club in St. Louis.
