Player Of The Week

UC Santa Barbara sophomore Josh Adams drove in at least one run in four straight games to garner Big West Baseball Field Player of the Week accolades.

The designated hitter hit .417 (5-for-12) with five runs scored and six RBI to lead the Gauchos to a 3-1 record, including a series victory over USC. He finished 1-for-3 with a pair of walks and two RBI.

In a 5-2 triumph over USC in game two, Adams roped a 1-2 pitcher down the left-field line for a game-tying two-run double in the fourth inning. UCSB extended its winning streak to nine straight, matching the 2014 and 2004 teams for the longest win streak for the program since 1990 (11 games).

Adams also had an RBI in the series finale.

He started the week for a 3-for-3 performance against CSU Bakersfield in a 10-4 victory. Adams scored four times and drove in a run as he doubled twice and walked.

Pitcher Of The Week

Earning his second Big West Baseball Pitcher of the Week honor this season, CSUN sophomore Kenny Rosenberg threw his first career complete game.

The southpaw yielded just four hits and one run in his nine innings of work as the Matadors came away with a 2-1 victory at Portland. He did not walk a batter and struck out nine Pilots.

Rosenberg sat down 15 consecutive Portland batters during the game, and retired 22 of the final 25 batters he faced. Rosenberg has lasted at least six innings in five of his six starts this season, and has fanned 50 hitters over his last 36.2 innings on the mound.

BIG WEST TID BITS

- CSUN is hitting .299 to pace the Big West Conference, while Cal State Fullerton continues to dominate on the mound with a league-best 2.21 ERA, which ranks the Titans sixth in the nation. The Titans have also been stellar on defense with the nation's third-best mark of .984. Long Beach State isn't far behind in seventh place with a fielding percentage of .982 and is closely followed by CSUN in ninth place with a .981 mark.

- Long Beach State leapfrogged UC Santa Barbara in the polls this week with the Dirtbags sporting a 17th ranking and the Gauchos one spot behind in 18th place. Cal Poly and CSUN are in the receiving votes category.

- Conference play kicks off this week in exciting fashion as the two ranked Big West teams square off at Blair Field. Last week, the Dirtbags battled Cal State Fullerton, 2-1, in a nonconference-scoring series and will now host No. 18 UC Santa Barbara.

- The Cal State Fullerton Titans have been tabbed the team to beat in 2016 as they begin their quest to defend the Big West Conference title, according to the nine conference coaches that voted on the 2016 Big West baseball preseason poll. The Titans earned four first-place votes en route to a total of 71 points while UC Irvine, who received one first-place vote, holds the second spot with 65 points. Long Beach State secured the third slot after earning three first-place votes for a total of 62 points and the Gauchos of UC Santa Barbara picked up the final first-place vote and tallied 60 points to finish fourth.

With 44 total points, CSUN clinched the fifth spot and Cal Poly, who captured its first-ever title in 2014, landed sixth with 43 points. Hawai'i ranked seventh with 27 points and was followed by UC Riverside (17) and UC Davis (16).

- Last fall *Collegiate Baseball* announced its annual evaluation of the NCAA Division I recruiting classes and Cal State Fullerton and UC Santa Barbara landed on the elite list. The Titans secured the 24th spot while the Gauchos grabbed the 36th slot. Other Big West teams recognized as having notable recruiting classes were UC Riverside, UC Irvine, Cal Poly and Long Beach State. The CBN's ranking uses only players who joined their respective programs for the 2015-16 school year and excludes all signees who decided to sign a professional contract.

- A selection of Big West baseball games will be carried on ESPN3 this season with all games originating from Southern California member institutions Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, UC Irvine and UC Riverside. Every Big West team will make an appearance on the televised baseball schedule.

Through the Big West's new mobile production facility, each game will be produced by the Conference utilizing full ESPN production standards, including graphics, replay and on-air crew. It is the first fully operational mobile production unit of its kind that expands upon what ESPN Emerging Technology has already done at the institutional level.

Every game on ESPN's platforms is available through WatchESPN, accessible online at WatchESPN.com, on smartphones and tablets via the WatchESPN app, through ESPN on Xbox LIVE to Gold members, on Apple TV and Roku to fans who receive their video subscription from an affiliated provider.
