Player Of The Week

Vince Fernandez • UC Riverside
Jr. • 6-4 • DH

UC Riverside junior Vince Fernandez played a role in half of his team's total run production as the Big West Baseball Field Player of the Week.

Helping the Highlanders to a 3-2 record, Fernandez combined to score or drive in 17 of UCR's 34 runs scored over the five games.

The outfielder extended his hitting streak to 14 games, starting the week going 2-for-4 with a double and pair of runs scored in a 6-5 win at Arizona. After walking three times and adding another hit in a 4-3 loss to the Wildcats, Fernandez proceeded to score four times and cash in 10 in a conference-opening series victory over UC Davis.

Fernandez provided the big blow in game two of the series, smashing a three-run walk-off home run for an 8-5 victory. He finished with two runs and five RBI against the Aggies.

In the series finale, he went 2-for-6 with two runs scored and four RBI in a 13-12 slugfest loss. In all, he hit .318 (7-for-22) with seven runs scored and 10 RBI. Fernandez hit 6 for 12 with runner on base, 4 for 7 with runners in scoring position and 3 for 3 with a runner on third and two outs.

Pitcher Of The Week

Long Beach State senior Tanner Brown held UC Santa Barbara to two hits over eight innings for his longest outing of his season, earning Big West Baseball Pitcher of the Week accolades.

The right-hander faced just two batters over the minimum in the 2-0 victory over the 11th-ranked Gauchos. Brown needed just 91 pitches to eat up the eight innings, throwing 62 strikes. He did not walk a batter and struck out five as the No. 17 Dirtbags salvaged the final game of the series.

Brown faced some trouble in the fourth inning with a runner on third and one out, but proceeded to whiff the No. 3 and 4 hitters to escape damage. He improved to 4-1 on the year.

BIG WEST TID BITS

- Cal Poly is currently leading the Big West on offense with a .282 batting average, while Cal State Fullerton continues to dominate on the mound with a league-best 2.46 ERA, which ranks the Titans eighth in the nation. The Titans have also been stellar on defense with the nation's seventh-best mark of .982, but Long Beach State has them beat with a .983 mark that places the Dirtbags fourth in the country.

- Following the first week of Big West play, preseason favorite Cal State Fullerton sits atop the leaderboard with a perfect 3-0 mark after downing CSUN, who entered the week with the most nonconference wins. No. 12 UC Santa Barbara is tied for second with Hawai'i and UC Riverside with a 2-1 mark. The Gauchos won the battle of the ranked teams as they took 2-of-3 from then-ranked No. 17 Long Beach State. UC Irvine, Long Beach State and UC Davis are knotted in fifth with a 1-2 mark and CSUN sits eighth. Cal Poly will begin conference play this week hosting league-leading CSF after dropping a nonconference series to San Jose State last week.

- The Cal State Fullerton Titans have been tabbed the team to beat in 2016 as they begin their quest to defend the Big West Conference title, according to the nine conference coaches that voted on the 2016 Big West baseball preseason poll. The Titans earned four first-place votes en route to a total of 71 points while UC Irvine, who received one first-place vote, holds the second spot with 65 points. Long Beach State secured the third slot after earning three first-place votes for a total of 62 points and the Gauchos of UC Santa Barbara picked up the final first-place vote and tallied 60 points to finish fourth.

With 44 total points, CSUN clinched the fifth spot and Cal Poly, who captured its first-ever title in 2014, landed sixth with 43 points. Hawai'i ranked seventh with 27 points and was followed by UC Riverside (17) and UC Davis (16).

- Last fall *Collegiate Baseball* announced its annual evaluation of the NCAA Division I recruiting classes and Cal State Fullerton and UC Santa Barbara landed on the elite list. The Titans secured the 24th spot while the Gauchos grabbed the 36th slot. Other Big West teams recognized as having notable recruiting classes were UC Riverside, UC Irvine, Cal Poly and Long Beach State. The CBN's ranking uses only players who joined their respective programs for the 2015-16 school year and excludes all signees who decided to sign a professional contract.

- A selection of Big West baseball games will be carried on ESPN3 this season with all games originating from Southern California member institutions Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, UC Irvine and UC Riverside. Every Big West team will make an appearance on the televised baseball schedule.

Through the Big West's new mobile production facility, each game will be produced by the Conference utilizing full ESPN production standards, including graphics, replay and on-air crew. It is the first fully operational mobile production unit of its kind that expands upon what ESPN Emerging Technology has already done at the institutional level.

Every game on ESPN's platforms is available through WatchESPN, accessible online at WatchESPN.com, on smartphones and tablets via the WatchESPN app, through ESPN on Xbox LIVE to Gold members, on Apple TV and Roku to fans who receive their video subscription from an affiliated provider.
