#1 Long Beach State 1, #4 UC Riverside 0 (OT)

UCI Head Coach Scott Juniper

(Opening statement) "That was one of the most memorable games I've been a part of and one of the most memorable teams I've been able to coach. Super excited to get back here and to take on Long Beach.

(On the win after dropping the regular season head-to-head) "The massive satisfaction has been being able to go through what we go through every day, the opponent is incidental. It happens to be a team we just lost to a few days ago but these guys know what it's about now and it's about the next opponent."

(On Grayson's playing time) "If Grayson's cleared to play, she's playing. She's one of our team captains and we trust her. She was cleared to play and she wanted to play. It's an easy decision for us."

(On overtime) "They were unbelievable. I lost count of how any times they put a big long throw into our box. When you start to get tired you aren't always perfect. What you saw today was 10-11 players who were throwing themselves in front of that ball. They were ready to do whatever it takes to stop the ball from crossing that line."

(On rematch with Long Beach) "We've played Long Beach a few times, we know them very well, they know us very well."

UCI Junior Gravson Galbraith

(On game-winning PK) "I've prepared all my life for that. Its just another PK. Earlier in the week we addressed it and tonight it was just place it and let's go."

UCI Junior Noel Baham

(On PKs) "After our first miss I don't think there was any doubt that our keeper would come through. Maddie [Newson] came up, they missed the next two and we finished it off, Grayson [Galbraith] finished it off."

(On determination) "It all started with the preseason poll that ranked us 77th that lit a fire. We put everything into training and we leave everything on the field. Its our first year at the Tournament so I think we're going together as sisters, I've never been a part of a team that's so close."

CSF Coach Demian Brown

(Opening statement) "Extremely impressed with my women, definite congrats to UCI for our two programs to battle the way that we have. We wish them all the best as they go forward. For our women, Jen [Stuart], Sarah [Fajnor], I just think over the last five years for our program to be in the conference tournament, represents the program for what we've been.
