Tipoff Time

Big West Tournament Magic

The 2018 Big West Men's Basketball Tournament presented by MemorialCare produced a different champion for the eighth straight year at Honda Center. Cal State Fullerton joined the list, becoming the first No. 4 seed since Long Beach State in 1993 to win the tournament. The list of champions since the tournament moved to Honda Center in 2011 is below.

Titans Win Third Tourney Title

Cal State Fullerton plowed through No. 5 Long Beach State, No. 1 UC Davis and No. 3 UC Irvine to capture the Big West Tournament title – the program's third all-time. Previous title seasons came in 1978 and 2008. The Titans now have defeated UCI twice (2008, 2018) in the only two all-Orange County championship games. CSF made its fifth title game appearance (1978, 1982, 1985, 2008, 2018) and improved to 3-2 in those games.

20-Win Milestone

Cal State Fullerton's 3-0 foray through the Big West Tournament improved the team to 20-11 overall, marking the first time since 2011-12 that the program had a 20-win campaign. The 2011-12 team won 21 games. The program's Division I single-season record for wins is 24, set by the 2007-08 team.

Getting Defensive

CSF ranked sixth among nine teams during the 16-game Big West schedule in scoring defense, allowing 71.1 points per game. The Titans squeaked by Long Beach State in the Big West Tournament quarterfinals, 76-74, then put on arguably their two best defensive performances of the season. CSF held UC Davis and UC Irvine to 52 and 55 points in the semifinals and finals, respectively. The Titans held the Aggies to 36.5% (19-of-52) shooting and the Anteaters to 31.1% (19-of-61) efficiency.

About That Offense

Cal State Fullerton is 14-0 this season when shooting 50 percent or better. The Titans have hit that mark in seven of their last 12 games. CSF leads the Big West in field goal percentage (.470) in overall games, and that figure increased to 49.0% in conference play.

Allman, Jr. Leads By Example

CSF junior Kyle Allman, Jr. earned MVP honors of the Big West Tournament after averaging 19.3 points and 5.0 rebounds over three games. He tops the Big West in scoring at 19.4 points per game, and seeks to become CSF's second straight Big West scoring champion and the sixth all-time.

PRIOR TO TIPOFF

NO. 15 CAL STATE FULLERTON VS. NO. 2 PURDUE - truTV (PXP: Ian Eagle • ANALYST: Jim Spanarkel)

- This is the first meeting between Cal State Fullerton and Purdue.
- The Titans feature a pair of career 1,000 point scorers in juniors Kyle Allman, Jr. and Khalil Ahmad. Both reached the milestone during the season and became the 24th and 25th members of the CSF program to do so. Ahmad is No. 17 on the career scoring list with 1,140 points, while Allman, Jr. is No. 19 with 1,081.
- Allman, Jr. leads the Big West with 16 games of 20 points or more. Ahmad has 10 such games to his credit.
- Allman, Jr. and Ahmad scored 105 of the team's 202 points in the Big West Tournament, including 49 of 71 in the Big West Tournament championship game against UC Irvine.
- The 52 points the Titans allowed to UC Davis was an opponent season-low by a Division I opponent this season.
- CSF sophomore Jackson Rowe averaged 13.3 points and 8.0 rebounds in the Big West Tournament to earn all-tournament honors along with teammates Allman, Jr. (MVP) and Ahmad.

NO. 7 UC DAVIS AT NO. 2 UTAH - ESPN3 (PXP: Steve Quis • ANALYST: Ben Braun)

- UC Davis is appearing in the postseason for the third time in four years – NIT (2015), NCAA (2017) – and has three 20-win seasons over that four-year span.
- The Aggies feature the first dual Big West Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year in junior guard TJ Shorts II.
- UC Davis seeks its 10th road win of the season.
- Junior guard Siler Schneider, with 1,109 career points, is No. 19 in the Aggie record book.

BIG WEST COACHING

Long Beach State's Dan Monson is the dean of Big West head coaches, in his 11th season on the sideline at the Walter Pyramid. He ranks eighth all-time in conference history with 185 wins. His 114 conference victories places him sixth all-time on the coaching leaderboard. Only five Big West head coaches have accumulated 200 or more wins during their tenure with the conference – Bob Thomason (Pacific, 436), Jerry Tarkanian (Long Beach State & UNLV, 405), Bob Williams (UC Santa Barbara, 313), Neil McCarthy (New Mexico State, 248) and Jerry Pimm (UC Santa Barbara, 222).

PASTERNAK JOINS BIG WEST COACHING FRATERNITY

The newest head coach in the Big West is UC Santa Barbara's Joe Pasternack. He is the 13th head coach in school history and just the third in the last 35 years. His previous stop was as Associate Head Coach under Sean Miller at the University of Arizona. He also served as head coach at the University of New Orleans for four seasons. Pasternack takes over a squad that returns four starters and 11 letterwinners, but uncharacteristically struggled last year with a 6-22 record.

WELCOME BACK STAT LEADERS

Returning players who were ranked in the top-10 of several Big West statistical categories are on the following lists.

Three of the top 10 scorers from 2016-17 are back, including UC Santa Barbara's **Gabe Vincent**, who ranked fifth in the Big West in scoring (14.8 ppg). **Chima Moneke** (6th, 14.6) and CSUN's **Tavrian Dawson** (9th, 14.1) also return to the fold.

The top four rebounders and seven of the top 10 return. Leading that group is Moneke, who ranked No. 1 in the Big West last year (9.5 rpg). UC Irvine's **Jonathan Galloway** (2nd, 7.6), Cal State Fullerton's **Jackson Rowe** (3rd, 7.2) and Dawson (6.9) also are back. Also returning is UC Santa Barbara's **Alex Hart** (6th, 6.2), UC Irvine's **Tommy Rutherford** (9th, 5.3) and UC Riverside's **Chance Murray** (5.2).

Three of the top 10 assist leaders return, led by Hawaii's Brocke Stepteau, who was seventh (3.0 apg) last year. Rainbow Warrior teammate Sheriff Drammeh (8th, 2.8) is also back, as is UCR's Dikymbe Martin (9th, 2.6).

Two of the top steals leaders come back in UCR teammates Martin (4th, 1.4 spg) and Murray (7th, 1.3).

Six of the top 10 blocked shots leaders are back, including four of the top five. Moneke (1.4 bpg) was the league leader in 2016-17. Galloway, the reigning Big West Defensive Player of the Year, was third overall (1.1).

Media Tabs UC Irvine As Preseason Favorite

UC Irvine received 14 first-place votes and 216 points from the Big West men's basketball media as the preseason favorite to win the title during the 2017-18 season. The Anteaters, which return 10 letterwinners but do not have a senior on the roster, edged UC Davis with seven first-place votes and 189 points. Cal State Fullerton was picked to finish third with 158 points and one first-place vote, while Long Beach State was fourth with 153 points and a first-place vote. Hawai'i also received two first-place nods for fifth place at 146 points. UC Santa Barbara received the last first-place vote and had 94 points for sixth place. CSUN was chosen seventh with 73 points, edging out UC Riverside and Cal Poly, which were selected eighth and ninth with 71 and 70 points, respectively.

Moneke Leads Preseason All-League Team

The only returning member of the 2016-17 All-Big West First Team, UC Davis senior **Chima Moneke** headlined the six-player preseason media all-conference team. Joining Moneke on the list was CSUN senior **Tavriion Dawson**, UC Santa Barbara senior **Gabe Vincent**, Cal State Fullerton sophomore **Jackson Rowe**, and Long Beach State teammates senior **Gabe Levin** and junior **Temidayo Yussuf**.

Moneke Earns Preseason Honors

UC Davis forward Chima Moneke is on the national radar for recognition as he enters his senior season. Moneke was recently named to the CollegeInsider.com preseason Watch List for both the Lute Olson Award and Lou Henson Award. The Lute Olson Award recognizes the nation's top Division I player who has played at least two seasons. Moneke is featured on a list of 40 players from conferences including the Power 5. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player.

ALLMAN, JR., HEIDEGGER NAMED NABC ALL-DISTRICT 9

Cal State Fullerton guard Kyle Allman, Jr. joined UC Santa Barbara sophomore Max Heidegger on the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Second Team. Allman, Jr. has tallied 602 points this season to rank No. 9 on the CSF single-season scoring list. Heidegger's 612 points places him in elite company at UCSB, at No. 5 in single-season scoring history. Allman, Jr. has made a living at the free throw line this year. His 179 free throw makes is No. 4 all-time at CSF, while his 239 attempts ranks No. 2. In addition, the 239 free throw attempts ties him for No. 10 on the Big West single-season charts.

WELCOME 1,000 CLUB

Entering the 2017-18 season, only one player had earned the distinction of scoring 1,000 career points, and that belonged to UC Santa Barbara senior Gabe Vincent. The guard had 1,044 career points entering the season opener. Vincent concluded his career on Friday in the Big West Tournament semifinals with 1,441 points, which ranks No. 10 in UCSB history. Five other players have earned their ticket into the club this season, including Cal State Fullerton teammates Khalil Ahmad and Kyle Allman, Jr., along with UC Davis guard Siler Schneider. All three individuals are playing in the postseason.

LEVIN SETS RECORDS

Long Beach State senior Gabe Levin set Big West single-game records for free throws made (24) and free throws attempted (28) in the 105-104 double overtime loss to UC Davis on Feb. 3. He obliterated both records. Johnny Rogers of UC Irvine held the previous free throw makes record of 18, set on Feb. 15, 1986 against UNLV. The old free throws attempted record of 22 was jointly shared by Hawaii's Christian Standhardinger (vs. Chaminade on Dec. 14, 2013) and Cal State Fullerton's Leon Wood (vs. Texas-Arlington on Dec. 19, 1981).

Levin finished that game with 45 points, tying the school record initially established by Ed Ratleff (vs. Saint Mary's, 12/10/70) and tying for No. 5 in Big West single-game history. Levin's scoring output represents the most by a Big West player since Cal State Fullerton's Bobby Brown had 46 against Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 16, 2006.

LEVIN HITS MILESTONES

Gabe Levin's 18 points at Hawaii on Feb. 22 gave him 1,014 for his career, making him the 24th player in Long Beach State history – and just the second transfer – to reach the milestone. His four rebounds in a Feb. 24 loss at Cal State Fullerton gave him 501 boards for his career, making him just the 12th player at LBSU to score 1,000 points and grab 500 rebounds.

UC SANTA BARBARA NOW AT NO. 14 IN COLLEGEINSIDER.COM POLL

After rising to a season-best No. 11 ranking in the Feb. 12 edition of the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major poll, UC Santa Barbara enters the Big West Tournament at No. 19. They have been ranked in the top-25 for 12 straight weeks. However, several other conference schools have been recognized in the poll this season. UC Davis and UC Riverside have cracked the top-25 at different junctures. Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, UC Irvine and Hawaii all have received votes at some point. The Aggies, winners of five in a row and the regular season champions, reentered the top-25 this week at No. 25. Previous UC Davis ranking was No. 24 on Dec. 18.

UC Santa Barbara finished 23-9 in Joe Pasternack's first year as head coach. The 23 victories tied the single-season school record, as the 2007-08 team also went 23-9. The success came one year after UCSB established a school record for losses with 22. The program's +17 improvement in the win column topped the nation this season, and also set a Big West record for best improvement from one season to the next. The previous record was +16. In addition, UCSB became just the fourth school in Big West history to go from single-digit wins one year to a 20-win season the next.

TJ Shorts First Dual Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year in Big West History

Big West Men's Basketball All-Conference Team Revealed

IRVINE, CA – Big West regular season champion UC Davis captured three of the four primary awards to highlight the announcement of the 2017-18 men's basketball all-conference team, voted on by the nine head coaches. **TJ Shorts** is the first individual in Big West history to earn both the Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year award in the same season. **Jim Les**, the architect of the UC Davis championship season, claimed Coach of the Year accolades. Meanwhile, CSUN local product **Terrell Gomez** notched the Freshman of the Year award.

Shorts II secured the second Player of the Year award in UC Davis lore behind Corey Hawkins in 2014-15. He also became the third Aggie – Hawkins (2013) and Chima Moneke (2017) – to receive Newcomer of the Year recognition in the eight-year history of the award.

The 5-foot-10 junior guard was a catalyst in the regular season championship for the Aggie program. In overall games, Shorts II ranked seventh among conference players in scoring (15.2 ppg), fifth in field goal percentage (.538), second in assists (4.3 apg) and first in steals (2.0 spg). He also placed third in assist-to-turnover ratio at +1.8. Shorts II stepped up his performances towards the latter part of the season to help the Aggies finish 12-4 in Big West play. Over the final eight games, Shorts II averaged 21.0 points on 56.6% (56-of-99) shooting and hit two game-winning shots – a running three-pointer that downed Long Beach State on Feb. 3 and a coast-to-coast layup that nipped UC Riverside at the end on Feb. 24.

A native of Tustin, Calif., Shorts II recorded first UC Davis triple-double in nearly a decade with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory at Cal Poly on Feb. 15. The Saddleback College transfer poured in 10 20-point games, including a career-high 31 points in the triple overtime, 105-104 win at LBSU. He had six 20-point efforts in the last eight games as the Aggies made their run to the title.

Les became the 12th individual in Big West history to earn multiple Coach of the Year plaques. He claimed his first honor in 2014-15 when the Aggies notched a school-record 25 wins and won their first Big West title. With just one returning starter from last year's NCAA Tournament squad, the 2017-18 Aggie edition went 21-9 overall under Les. In his seventh season at the helm of the Aggies, Les led them to 20-plus wins for the third time in four seasons. The Aggies owned one of the nation's longest home court win streaks – 19 games – after starting out 8-0 this season on Hamilton Court. Over the last eight contests, in which UC Davis posted a 6-2 record, three of those wins came in incredible fashion as the Aggies defeated Long Beach State in double overtime, Cal Poly in triple overtime and UC Irvine in double overtime. The 90-84 win over UCI in the regular season finale – in a winner-take-all atmosphere – came in front of a Bren Events Center sellout crowd of 5,000. Les has now coached two Big West Players of the Year and three Big West Newcomers of the Year.

Gomez, a 5-foot-8 guard, became the third CSUN representative of Freshman of the Year accolades, following Ian Boylan (2002) and Stephan Hicks (2012). He is the leading freshman scorer in the conference at 11.7 points per game. Gomez posted 18 double-digit scoring games, including three of 20 points or more. The Los Angeles, Calif. native hit at least one three-pointer in 29 of 30 games, and his 65 threes on the year ranked No. 2 in the Big West. Gomez also knocked down the long range shot with efficiency, ranking No. 1 in the Big West three-point field goal percentage (.461). He sported his first career double-double against Big West champion UC Davis with 10 points and 10 assists.

The All-Big West First Team features six new faces – Shorts II, UC Santa Barbara teammates **Max Heidegger** and **Leland King II**, Cal State Fullerton junior **Kyle Allman, Jr.**, Long Beach State senior **Gabe Levin** and UC Irvine sophomore **Tommy Rutherford**. Four of the six first-team performers are eligible to return next season.

UC Irvine, Hawai'i Claim All-Specialty Awards

IRVINE, CA – UC Irvine junior **Jonathan Galloway**'s repeat selection as the league's Best Defensive Player highlighted the announcement of the 2018 Big West Men's Basketball All-Specialty awards. Hawai'i teammates **Jack Purchase** and **Sheriff Drammeh** also earned top praise as recipients of the Best Sixth Player and Best Hustle Player honors, respectively.

The conference's nine head coaches voted on the awards – the 18th straight year that the Big West has had held these honors.

Galloway continued UC Irvine's grip on the Best Defensive Player award, as an Anteater representative has held the hardware five times in the last six years. Galloway became just the second player in Big West history to repeat as top defender, joining Pacific's Joe Ford in 2009 and 2010. Former UCI standout Mamadou Ndiaye earned the award twice in 2014 and 2016. Will Davis II was UCI's initial honoree in 2013.

The 6-foot-10 forward finished the regular season ranked third in blocked shots (1.4 bpg) in overall games, helping UCI to a No. 1 team ranking with over four swats per game. A key cog in UCI's No. 1-rated defense, which allowed opponents to average just 61.9 points per game in Big West play, Galloway is the conference's No. 2 rebounder at 7.7 per game. The Brentwood, Calif. native is the Big West's active career leader in rebounds (658) and blocked shots (108). His nine double-figure rebounding games is third-best among conference players. Galloway also had a team third-best 16 steals.

Purchase is the first Hawai'i representative of the Best Sixth Player award. The 6-foot-9 junior forward came off the bench 22 times in 29 games while averaging 7.9 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game. Purchase hit a team-best 50 three-pointers and ranked No. 7 in the Big West in three-pointers made per game (1.7). His also had 15 steals and 16 blocked shots – the latter stat placing him second on the squad. Purchase drained two or more treys in 15 games, including a season-high six in a victory over Howard on Dec. 29. The Melbourne, Australia native also delivered 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting, seven rebounds and three steals in a home win over Big West regular season champion UC Davis on Jan. 20.

Drammeh joined Purchase as another first-time UH representative of a major award – Best Hustle Player. Known for his intensity and frenetic pace on the floor, Drammeh is UH's No. 2 scorer (10.8 ppg) while averaging 3.4 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.1 steals per game. The 6-foot-3 guard posted two or more steals in 10 games, and he grabbed at least three rebounds in 20 contests. Hailing from Stockholm, Sweden, Drammeh also has the reputation of being the best in the Big West – and among the best in the country – at drawing charges.
