Tipoff Time

Big West Enters Tournament Week

The Big West continues the early non-conference portion of the schedule with a bevy of Thanksgiving tournaments this week.

Cal Poly is competing in the 40th annual and final GCI Great Alaska Shootout and opens with College of Charleston on Thanksgiving Day.

Cal State Fullerton hosts all 12 games of the Wooden Legacy at Titan Gym. The Titans open with SEC foe Georgia on Turkey Day.

Long Beach State will play first and eat later as the Beach begins Thanksgiving festivities with an 8:30 a.m. (PT) wake up call against Missouri in the Advocare Invitational.

UC Irvine takes part in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational against Rider on Thursday.

Also in action this week is CSUN at the Cancun Challenge and UC Santa Barbara in the Progressive Legends Classic. UC Davis plays its annual rivalry game against Sacramento State in the state-of-the-art Golden 1 Center in Sacramento.

Home Sweet Home

Big West teams are an impressive 9-1 at home so far. Unfortunately, 16 out of the 21 games on this week's schedule are slated for neutral or road courts. Cal State Fullerton plays three games at home, Hawai'i hosts Nevada and UC Santa Barbara welcomes Prairie View A&M.

Hawai'i Seeks 4-0 Start

The only remaining unbeaten Big West squad is Hawai'i. The Rainbow Warriors are 3-0, and see their first action in 11 days when they host Nevada on Friday. UH is aiming to start out 4-0 for the second time in three seasons under head coach Eran Ganot.

Moneke Earns Preseason Honors

UC Davis forward Chima Moneke is on the national radar for recognition as he enters his senior season. Moneke was recently named to the CollegeInsider. com preseason Watch List for both the Lute Olson Award and Lou Henson Award. The Lute Olson Award recognizes the nation's top Division I player who has played at least two seasons. Moneke is featured on a list of 40 players from conferences including the Power 5. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player.

Player of the Week

Chima Moneke, UC Davis Senior • Forward • Canberra, Australia

Averaging a double-double over three games, UC Davis senior Chima Moneke earned his second career Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week

Moneke posted conference-leading numbers of 24.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in a 2-1 opening week for the Aggies. He helped UC Davis to road wins over Northern Colorado and Pacific.

The 6-6 forward erupted for a career-high 28 points in the 74-59 season-opening victory at Northern Colorado. He hit his first career three-pointer in that game en route to 10 of 21 shooting. Moneke added eight rebounds and a block while also shooting an effective 7 of 9 from the free throw line.

In the 62-58 win over Pacific – the program's first in Stockton since the 1939-40 season - Moneke provided his 15th career double-double with a gamehigh 26 points and 10 rebounds. He made 8 of 17 floor shots, including two more three-pointers, and was again solid at the stripe with 8 of 10 accuracy.

Moneke posted his 16th career double-double with a team-high 18 points and game-high 12 boards at Utah Valley. He tied his career best with four assists.

PASTERNACK JOINS BIG WEST COACHING FRATERNITY

The newest head coach in the Big West is UC Santa Barbara's Joe Pasternack. He is the 13th head coach in school history and just the third in the last 35 years. His previous stop was as Associate Head Coach under Sean Miller at the University of Arizona. He also served as head coach at the University of New Orleans for four seasons. Pasternack takes over a squad that returns four starters and 11 letterwinners, but uncharacteristically struggled last year with a 6-22 record.

WELCOME BACK STAT LEADERS

Returning players who were ranked in the top-10 of several Big West statistical categories are on the following lists.

Three of the top 10 scorers from 2016-17 are back, including UC Santa Barbara's Gabe Vincent, who ranked fifth in the Big West in scoring (14.8 ppg). Chima Moneke (6th, 14.6) and CSUN's Tavrion Dawson (9th, 14.1) also return to the fold.

The top four rebounders and seven of the top 10 return. Leading that group is Moneke, who ranked No. 1 in the Big West last year (9.5 rpg). UC Irvine's Jonathan Galloway (2nd, 7.6), Cal State Fullerton's Jackson Rowe (3rd, 7.2) and Dawson (6.9) also are back. Also returning is UC Santa Barbara's Alex Hart (6th, 6.2), UC Irvine's Tommy Rutherford (9th, 5.3) and UC Riverside's Chance Murray (5.2).

Three of the top 10 assist leaders return, led by Hawaii's Brocke Stepteau, who was seventh (3.0 apg) last year. Rainbow Warrior teammate Sheriff Drammeh (8th, 2.8) is also back, as is UCR's Dikymbe Martin (9th, 2.6).

Two of the top steals leaders come back in UCR teammates Martin (4th, 1.4 spg) and Murray (7th, 1.3).

Six of the top 10 blocked shots leaders are back, including four of the top five. Moneke (1.4 bpg) was the league leader in 2016-17. Galloway, the reigning Big West Defensive Player of the Year, was third overall (1.1).

Media Tabs UC Irvine As Preseason Favorite

UC Irvine received 14 first-place votes and 216 points from the Big West men's basketball media as the preseason favorite to win the title during the 2017-18 season. The Anteaters, which return 10 letterwinners but do not have a senior on the roster, edged UC Davis with seven first-place votes and 189 points. Cal State Fullerton was picked to finish third with 158 points and one first-place vote, while Long Beach State was fourth with 153 points and a first-place vote. Hawai'i also received two first-place nods for fifth place at 146 points. UC Santa Barbara received the last first-place vote and had 94 points for sixth place. CSUN was chosen seventh with 73 points, edging out UC Riverside and Cal Poly, which were selected eighth and ninth with 71 and 70 points, respectively.
