Head Coach Laura Beeman

(On the keys to the win)

We had pretty good energy coming into the game and we had a good pace on offense. We had to stop their transition – they are a very good transitioning team. I think they're averaging close to 74 points per game right now. So we had to have good energy on both sides of the ball and I think that we did."
