

Postgame Quotes Saturday, November 7, 2015 First Round Game (N3) UC Davis 2, (S2) CSUN 1 (OT)

UC Davis Head Coach Dwayne Shaffer

(On Matt Wiesenfarth's game-winning goal): "It's awesome. Weezy has had an incredible career. He's been a great addition to our program. I think he's been one of the best attacking players in the Big West over his career, and for him to be able to not only get the game-winning goal, but also the assist on Connor's goal earlier in the game. It was really good to see."

(On Connor Willis-Hong's goal): "I felt like if we could put him in the midfield with Northridge getting a little fatigued, that it might work, and it just so happened that it worked out perfectly. I just said 'Connor, make a difference, make a play.' That was our big motto for the week...somebody make a play."

(On CSUN's equalizing goal): "At the end of regulation, we were all a little bit upset about it. However, it happened, so I told the guys on the bench to shake it off. We're in overtime, and let's win it. We came down here to win. We know what our season is down to. We're one-and-done, so we're going for it."

(On next opponent UC Santa Barbara): "It's a difficult travel for anybody, especially for us because it's a seven-hour bus ride. They're such a good team. Tim's done a tremendous job with Santa Barbara. But if there's one place in all of college soccer that any college soccer player would want to play, it's at Santa Barbara. Hopefully there's going to be a big crowd, and the excitement of playing under the lights, it's a great opportunity for anybody to go down there and play."

UC Davis Senior Forward Matt Wiesenfarth

(On his game-winning goal): "Their backline was pretty far up the field and they were pretty spread out. This field is really wide. I knew that if their left back tried to play a pass to the center back, if I baited it enough, I might be able to pick it off. It worked out luckily."

(On CSUN's equalizing goal): "It was definitely a little bit disheartening when they scored, but I knew they we were playing well the whole game. We came into this game with a little different attacking mindset, putting more emphasis on the width, and I think that was working out a lot. I'd knew we'd get chances in overtime, and it would just be about putting them away."

CSUN Head Coach Terry Davila

(On the game): "Davis is a very resilient team. Very organized in the back row, very good on the counterattack. We created some chances that we knew we would, but we didn't execute as much as I would have liked in the offensive third. I thought Matt Wiesenfarth had an excellent game, and he was the difference in the game."

(On Papi Diouf's goal): "Papi has a lot of character, and he has a tremendous heart. His future is bright. You can't teach spirit. You can't teach emotion. Just pure love and passion for the game, and the guy has it. I'll go to war with that guy anytime, anyplace, anywhere. He's got a heart of gold, and I like to surround myself with people like that."
