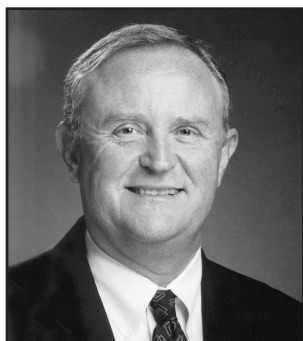

Dennis Farrell

Commissioner

30th season

The 2009-10 academic year marks the 18th year in Dennis Farrell's tenure as commissioner of the Big West Conference, but 30th season on staff. He is the fourth full-time commissioner in the 39-year history of the Big West, following Jess Hill (1972-78), Lew Cryer (1978-88) and Jim Haney (1988-92).

Prior to assuming the role of commissioner on July 1, 1992, Farrell served the conference in various capacities as an assistant/associate commissioner since joining the conference in 1980. During his Big West tenure, Farrell has acted as the primary rule interpreter, championship administrator, schedule coordinator and director of the league's successful postseason basketball tournament.

Farrell has actively represented the Big West on the national and regional level. From 1994 to 1997 he served on the important NCAA Council and from 1991 to 1997 he sat on the NCAA Two-Year College Relations Committee (including serving as its chair from 1992 to 1995). He currently serves as the Division I-AAA Vice President of the Collegiate Commissioners Association and is chair of the NCAA Baseball Issues Committee. Farrell also is presently a member of the Los Angeles Sports Council which is active in securing, marketing and administering major athletic events for the Southern California area.

Before joining the Big West, Farrell was the sports information director for nearly three years at Saddleback Community College in Mission Viejo, Calif. A 1974 graduate of San Diego State University, Farrell worked for the Daily Californian newspaper in El Cajon and radio station KDEO while attending college. From 1975 to 1977, he was employed as sports editor of the Saddleback Valley News in Mission Viejo. He also worked in the sports department of the Orange County edition of the Los Angeles Times.

Farrell and his wife, Charlene, reside in Coto de Caza and have two sons, Timothy and Michael.



Rob Halvaks

Senior Associate Commissioner

18th season

Rob Halvaks is in his 18th season with the conference office. Halvaks is responsible for office and financial administration, is the tournament director for the Big West Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament, and has sports management responsibilities for men's and women's basketball and baseball. Halvaks is the chair of the NCAA Division I Administration Cabinet and also chairs of the NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel. He is the conference's staff liaison to the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation.

Halvaks is a faculty member in the University of San Francisco's Sport Management Graduate Program.

Prior to joining the Big West staff, Halvaks served as the associate executive director of the Orange County Sports Association (1989-92), which annually produced the Disneyland Pigskin Classic and the Freedom Bowl at Anaheim Stadium. Halvaks was a member of the athletics department staff at UC Irvine from 1979 to 1989, serving in a variety of positions, including sports information director, business manager and senior associate athletics director.

A 1975 graduate of the University of Michigan with a Bachelor's in Communications, Halvaks earned a 1979 Master's in Sports Administration from Ohio University. He served a year (1978) as assistant sports information director at Georgia Tech.

Jody McRoberts

Associate Commissioner

27th season

Jody McRoberts is in her 27th year as a member of the Big West office staff. McRoberts was elevated to associate commissioner in the summer of 2002. She serves as the conference's senior woman administrator, scheduling coordinator for the association's round robin sports, and editor of the conference manual and media publications.

McRoberts functions as the league's meeting planner, is the league's primary administrator for men's and women's soccer and softball, and handles the conference awards program.

On the national front, she has served on the NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Committee.

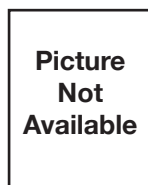

COACHES PREDICT UC SANTA BARBARA TO WIN 2009 TITLE

The nine Big West coaches tabbed UC Santa Barbara the frontrunner to win the 2009 Big West regular season championship. The Gauchos received five first-place votes and 75 points to earn the favorite's role. UCSB returns eight starters and 21 letterwinners from last year's squad which reached the NCAA Tournament and won the Big West Tournament title. Long Beach State, the 2008 regular season champion, was chosen second with 67 points and two first-place votes. Cal Poly was selected third with one first-place votes and 65 points. Pacific captured the other first-place nod and finished fourth in the poll. Cal State Northridge, Cal State Fullerton, UC Irvine, UC Davis and UC Riverside finished five through ninth, respectively.

STUMPF LOOKING FOR LANDMARK WIN NO. 100

UC Santa Barbara head coach Paul Stumpf is sitting one away from career win No. 100. In his 11th season at the helm of the Gauchos, Stumpf owns a record of 99-76-24 (.558). Stumpf would become only the third coach to reach 100 victories while coaching in the Big West. Cal Poly's Alex Crozier leads all league coaches with 148 victories and Pacific's Keith Coleman is second with 126.

INGRASSIA THIRD IN ALL-TIME WINNING PERCENTAGE

Mauricio Ingrassia has steered the Long Beach State women's program into one of the top sides on the west coast. The 49ers reached their first NCAA Tournament last year and finished 14-5-4 overall. Ingrassia has averaged nearly 12 wins in his five seasons at LBSU, carrying a career record of 59-31-11 entering the 2009 season. His .639 winning percentage ranks third all-time among Big West head coaches.

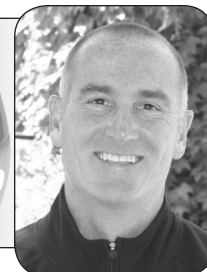

Two Schools Represent Big West In NCAA Tournament

The Big West continued to climb the hierarchy ladder of top women's soccer conferences in the country as two teams qualified for the NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament for the second time in league history. UC Santa Barbara and Long Beach State were selected for the 64-team field after outstanding seasons that were integral to making the Big West the No. 10-ranked conference in the NCAA Ratings Percentage Index (RPI).

The Big West first sent two teams to the NCAA postseason in 2005 when Cal State Fullerton and UC Riverside participated. The Titans ended up advancing to the Sweet 16 that year.

Long Beach State won a school record-tying 14 games and captured the conference regular season championship with an unbeaten 7-0-1 record. After three straight seasons of losing in the Big West Tournament semifinals on the road, the 49ers found home field to their advantage as they defeated Pacific in this year's semifinals to advance to their first championship game.

However, upstart UC Santa Barbara, which came into the season after a tough 6-10-4 showing in 2007, utilized a bunch of young talent to upset the 49ers in the tournament championship game. The two teams played to a 1-1 tie in regulation and two overtimes, and the Gauchos prevailed 6-5 in penalty kicks. UCSB also used the penalty kick route to defeat Cal Poly in the semifinals, winning 5-4 in the shootout. UCSB earned the Big West automatic bid to the NCAA Championship by virtue of being conference tournament champion.

This was the first year the Big West Tournament was not contested at a single site. The highest seeded team hosted each semifinal and the championship game.

The 49ers received an at-large berth from the selection committee to secure their first trip to the NCAA postseason party. LBSU drew San Diego in the first round and lost a close 1-0 battle. The 49ers were one of seven schools making their first appearance from the field.

Meanwhile, UCSB made its eighth NCAA appearance overall but first since 1991. The Gauchos met Stanford in the first round and fell 2-0 in the first meeting between the two teams since 1994.
