Big West Tid Bits

• The Big West Conference sent a pair of teams to the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship as the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Committee. Long Beach State earned the conference's automatic bid to the postseason after posting a perfect 16-0 mark to claim its 13th title and Hawai'i was an at-large selection.

The 49ers, making their 27th appearance in the NCAA Tournament after capturing their first Big West crown in three years, defeated San Diego, 3-0, in the first round of the tournament before falling to host UCLA in second round action.

Making their 33rd appearance in the postseason, the Rainbow Wahine swept Duke in the opening match and dropped a 3-1 second-round decision to host and No. 3-seeded Washington.

• In his 30th season at the helm of the Long Beach State women's volleyball program, head coach Brian Gimmillaro guided the 49ers (26-4) to their first Big West Conference championship since 2011, 13th overall, with an unblemished 16-0 league mark. Hawai'i dominance came to an end as its 19-year conference title streak (Big West & WAC) was snapped after posting an 13-3 mark to place second in the league. CSUN and UC Davis found themselves knotted in third with a 10-6 mark and were followed by UC Irvine at 9-7. UC Santa Barbara sits sixth, while Cal Poly (4-12), Cal State Fullerton (2-14) and UC Riverside (0-16) rounded out the nine-team field.

• The 2014 Big West Conference champion, Long Beach State, continued its dominance in the conference's annual awards, sweeping the top three honors. Jenelle Hudson was tabbed Big West Player of the Year and teammate Ashley Murray earning Big West Freshman of the Year honors. Rounding out the 49er trio was Brian Gimmillaro, who picked up the Big West Coach of the Year award.

• Five Big West Conference student-athletes were tabbed 2014 AVCA All-Region selections. Hawai'i's Olivia Magill nabbed a spot on the AVCA All-Pacific North Region Team, while CSUN's Casey Hinger and a trio of Long Beach State players were recognized on the All-Pacific South Region Team. Senior Chisom Okpala earned region honors and teammates Jenelle Hudson and Bre Mackie received honorable mention recognition.

• Casey Hinger of the CSUN women's volleyball team has been named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award, given annually to the sport's top senior both on and off the court.

All Good Things Must Come To An End: For the past 19 seasons the University of Hawai'i had captured its respective conference title (WAC & Big West), that is, until this season. Long Beach State produced a

perfect 16-0 record to claim its 13th title while snapping the Rainbow Wahine impressive streak in the process. Hawai'i finished second with a 13-3 mark and received an at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament.

A View From The Top: Junior Olivia Magill paced the Big West Conference in both hitting percentage and blocks. Her .405 attack percentage placed her 16th in the country while also sitting 29th with a 1.34 blocks per set mark. As a team, UH's league-high 3.00 block average ranks sixth in the nation.

Making A Mark: Olivia Magill's .405 hitting percentage is the highest clip in the Big West in 10 years when UC Irvine's Sami Cash notched a .442 mark in 2004. She is also only the second player to eclipse the .400 threshold in 10 years.
