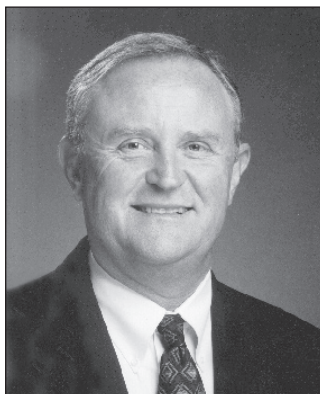

## Dennis Farrell ♦♦♦ Commissioner



28th Season

The 2007-08 academic year marks the 16th year in Dennis Farrell's tenure as commissioner of the Big West Conference, but twenty-eighth season on staff. He is the fourth full-time commissioner in the 39-year history of the Big West, following Jess Hill (1972-78), Lew Cryer (1978-88) and Jim Haney (1988-92).

Prior to assuming the role of commissioner on July 1, 1992, Farrell served the conference in various capacities as an assistant/associate commissioner since joining the conference in 1980. During his Big West tenure, Farrell has acted as the primary rule interpreter, championship administrator, schedule coordinator and director of the league's successful postseason basketball tournament.

Farrell has been active in representing the Big West on both the national and regional level. From 1994 to 1997 he served on the important NCAA Council and from 1991 to 1997 he sat on the NCAA Two-Year College Relations Committee (including serving as its chair from 1992 to 1995). He currently serves as the Division I-AAA Vice President of the Collegiate Commissioners Association and is chair of the NCAA Baseball Issues Committee. Farrell also is presently a member of the Los Angeles Sports Council which is active in securing, marketing and administering major athletic events for the Southern California area.

Before joining the Big West, Farrell was the sports information director for nearly three years at Saddleback Community College in Mission Viejo, Calif. A 1974 graduate of San Diego State University, Farrell worked for the Daily Californian newspaper in El Cajon and radio station KDEO while attending college. From 1975 to 1977, he was employed as sports editor of the Saddleback Valley News in Mission Viejo. He also worked in the sports department of the Orange County edition of the Los Angeles Times.

Farrell and his wife, Charlene, reside in Coto de Caza with their sons, Timothy and Michael.

### Rob Halvaks

Rob Halvaks is in his 16th season with the conference office. Halvaks is responsible for office and financial administration, is the tournament director for the Big West Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament, and has sports management responsibilities for men's and women's basketball and baseball. Halvaks is a member of the NCAA Division I Championships/Competition Cabinet and is chair of the NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel. He is also the conference's staff liaison to the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation.

Halvaks is a faculty member in the University of San Francisco's Sport Management Graduate Program.

Prior to joining the Big West staff, Halvaks served as the associate executive director of the Orange County Sports Association (1989-1992), which annually produced the Disneyland Pigskin Classic and the Freedom Bowl at Anaheim Stadium. Halvaks was a member of the athletics department staff at UC Irvine from 1979 to 1989, serving in a variety of positions, including sports information director, business manager and senior associate athletics director.

A 1975 graduate of the University of Michigan with a Bachelor's in Communications, Halvaks earned a 1979 Master's in Sports Administration from Ohio University. He served a year (1978) as assistant sports information director at Georgia Tech.

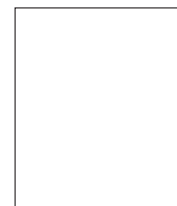

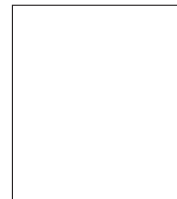

**UC Santa Barbara Aims to Defend National Crown:** UC Santa Barbara will possess a different bulls-eye on its back this season as the Gauchos enter 2007 as the defending NCAA Champions. UCSB, who became the first unseeded team since Connecticut in 2000 to claim the national crown, looks to become the first repeat champion since Indiana won the titles in 2003 and 2004. Coincidentally, the 2004 Hoosier club beat the Gauchos in penalty kicks in the national title match. UC Santa Barbara, which is ranked #1 in the NSCAA and *Soccer Times* preseason polls, is well equipped for a title defense as it returns six starters and 21 letterwinners to go along with a seven-man recruiting class ranked #13 by *College Soccer News*.

**UC Santa Barbara Favored in Preseason Coaches Poll:** The league's seven head coaches tabbed UC Santa Barbara as the favorite to claim the Big West crown. The Gauchos received six of seven first place votes on the way to the top spot. Cal State Northridge, the only other school besides UCSB to win the Big West crown since soccer was reinstated in 2001, was second, while Cal State Fullerton rounded out the top three. The depth and unpredictability of the conference is evident in the fact that slots 3-6 in the poll were separated by just five points.

**UC Davis Enters Big West Race:** The 2007-08 season also marks the first year of competition for UC Davis as a member of the Big West. The Aggies are coming off a season in which they recorded a 9-7-2 record, including a 7-3-2 mark against Big West clubs. UC Davis went 2-2-2 against the top three finishers in the conference last season (UC Santa Barbara, UC Irvine, Cal State Northridge) and enter the season bolstered by the return of seven starters and 17 letterwinners.

**Big West a Big Name Nationally:** In addition to having the reigning national champion, the Big West can also claim three preseason All-Americans and two slots on the Watch List for the prestigious Hermann Trophy. UC Santa Barbara's Andy Iro and Eric Avila were named preseason first team All-America by *College Soccer News*, while UC Irvine's Matt Murphy was named to the third team by the same publication. Murphy joins former teammate Brad Evans as the only UCI players ever to be named to any preseason All-America list. Iro and Avila were also named to the Hermann Trophy Watch List, an award recognizing the top collegiate soccer player in the

United States. They are one of two pairs of teammates on the 25-man Watch List.

**Cal Poly Gets a New Home:** Cal Poly will truly have a home field advantage this season as the Mustangs begin their first year in the newly-completed, \$19.4 million Spanos Stadium. The stadium, which seats 11,775, is the new home for the Mustangs' men's and women's soccer and football squads. Cal Poly, which played in the Sports Complex on campus last season, opened up the new digs in style with a 3-1 win over defending Pac-10 champion California in an exhibition match.

**New Faces Everywhere:** Plenty of new faces will be on the sidelines this year as the Big West welcomes back just 10 of the 24 players on the All-Big West first and second teams and three of the seven award winners from a year ago. The returning conference all-stars are Cal State Fullerton's Michael Farfan, Gabriel Farfan and Amir Shafii, Cal State Northridge's Sean Franklin and Sunghyun Kim, UC Irvine's Murphy, UC Riverside's Andrew Villalobos and UC Santa Barbara's Bongomin Otii, Avila and Iro. The award winners hitting the pitch in 2007 are Murphy (Midfielder of the Year), Iro (Defensive Player of the Year) and Michael Farfan (Freshman of the Year). The one school that won't have many new faces is UC Riverside as 10 of the Highlanders' 11 starters from 2006 return this season.

**Big West on Primetime:** The Big West will be the focus of college soccer in primetime October 3 as the UC Irvine/UC Santa Barbara matchup will air on Fox Soccer Channel at 8 p.m. (PDT). A year ago, the Gauchos and Anteaters split the season series with both clubs winning on their home field. UCI was arguably the best team in the nation not claim an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament after going 13-4-3 and finishing second in the Big West with a 6-3-1 record. The 13 wins was a school record.

**Kuntz On Verge of Milestone:** UC Irvine head coach George Kuntz is just one win away from his 100th as the head coach of the UCI program. Kuntz, entering his 13th season, is the longest tenured coach in the league and has the most overall wins (159) of any active Big West coach.

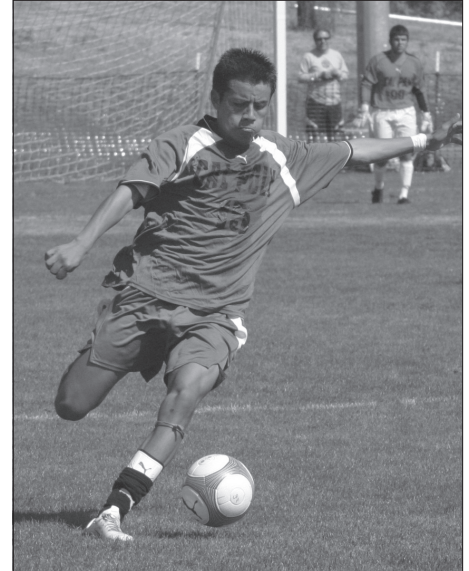

• Cal Poly enters year two of the **Paul Holochoer** reign with a lot of optimism as the Mustangs return nine starters and 16 letterwinners from a club that went 7-8-4 overall and finished fourth in conference play with a record of 3-5-2. Cal Poly also begins its first year of play in the newly-completed \$19.4 million, 11,775-seat Spanos Stadium.

• The Mustangs' offense struggled down the stretch a year ago, scoring just once in their final five matches. Holochoer will be looking for even more production out of the likes of sophomore **Jose Garcia** (4g, 2a), junior **Julian Alvarez** (2g, 6a) and junior **Jeff Meyer Jr.** (3 g, 1a). With six players returning that scored two or more goals last season and a talented group of newcomers, the Cal Poly offense looks to be ready to take off.

• Despite a rough finish, Cal Poly's defense was solid in its first season under Holochoer, allowing just 20 goals in 19 matches. The Mustangs lose first team All-Big West selection Eric Ward, but the bulk of the backline returns to the pitch in 2007. Defensive stalwarts such as senior **K.J. Lenehan** and sophomores **Brian Jones** and **Jeremy Cleveland** give the Mustangs a trio of solid defenders capable of fending off offensive attacks.

• **Eric Branagan-Franco** returns in goal to give the Mustangs an excellent wall between the pipes. Branagan-Franco recorded a 0.83 goals against average, 62 saves, posted a .805 save percentage and collected seven shutouts a year ago. He allowed just 15 goals in his 18 appearances, 17 of those as the starting keeper.

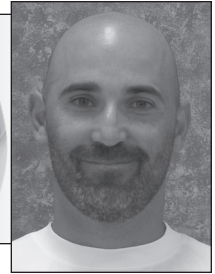

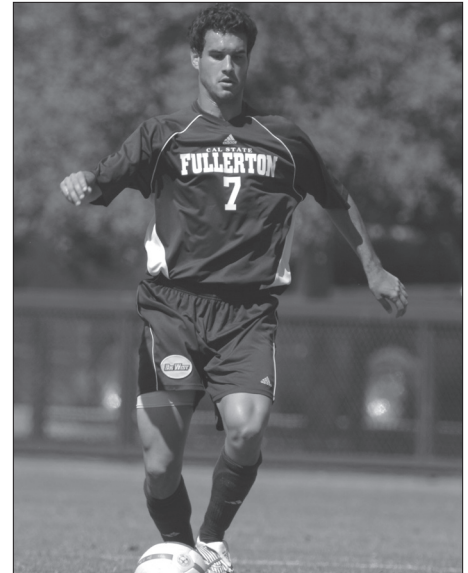

• **Bob Ammann** enters year two as the head man of the Cal State Fullerton club after recording a record of 7-11-1 overall and 3-7-0 in Big West play. Ammann welcomes back a talented young club that played in five matches that went to overtime a year ago as well as 11 matches that were decided by one goal or less.

• Leading the charge for the Titans in 2007 is 2006 Big West Freshman of the Year **Michael Farfan**. The sophomore, who was named first team All-Big West, is a dynamic playmaker in the midfield as evidenced by his five goals and four assists for 14 points a year ago. Two of his five tallies were game-winners and he also went a perfect 2-for-2 in penalty kicks.

• CSF improved its offensive output from 2005 as the Titans found the back of the net 29 times in 2006 as opposed to 21 the season before. 59% of the goal scoring returns to the pitch led by Farfan and seniors **Amir Shafii** (4 goals) and **Skylar Thuresson** (3 goals).

• As their head coach would attest, defense and goalkeeping will be the key to Cal State Fullerton's 2007 season. The Titans allowed 36 goals last season and was one of two Big West clubs to register a negative goal differential. Between the pipes, the duties were spilt between senior **Brent Douglas** and junior **Kevin Puder**. Douglas registered five wins, one shutout, a 1.73 goals against average, 50 saves and a .694 save percentage in 13 matches with 12 starts. Puder won two matches, recorded a 2.03 goals against average, 32 saves and a .696 save percentage in eight matches with seven starts.

• Cal State Northridge enters 2007 looking to bounce back from a disappointing season by Matador standards. CSUN went 8-6-5 overall with a 5-2-3 record in conference play, snapping its string of consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances at four and recording the least amount of overall and Big West victories since 2001. The Matadors' five ties was just one off the single-season Big West record set by UC Irvine in 2001.

• Once again, Cal State Northridge will play a highly competitive schedule outside of the perennially tough Big West Conference. The Matadors play Michigan and Memphis on a neutral site, host New Mexico and 2006 NCAA runner-up UCLA and travel to College Park, Md., for a bout against national power Maryland.

• CSUN has proven over the years it can play toe-to-toe with anyone in the nation thanks to a superb defense. Senior defenders **Sean Franklin** and **Matt Tracy** return to anchor a defense that allowed a league-low 18 goals in 19 games. The man in goal is junior **Kevin Guppy**, an honorable mention All-Big West pick a year ago. He was third in the conference in goals against average (0.90) and save percentage (.775) and tied for third in saves (62). Guppy also collected three shutouts to go along with his eight wins.

• Goal scoring was a deceiving stat for the Matadors in 2006. They were third in the Big West with 31 goals, but nine of those came in two matches. Subtract the nine tallies and CSUN managed just 22 goals in 17 matches, including 11 contests where it scored one goal or less. Leading the way for the returnees is second team All-Conference selection sophomore **Sunghyun Kim**, who tied for the team lead in goals (6) and led the way in points (14). Kim will have plenty of help alongside him with the return of senior **Fergie Agwu** (3 g, 5 a) and junior **Michael Clegg** (3g, 2 a). Franklin (1 g, 4 a), sophomore **Adrian Lopez** (6 a) and highly touted freshman **Camilo Rojas** are very capable offensive options as well.

• UC Davis enters its first year as a member of the Big West after completing its four-year reclassification period to the Division I level. The Aggies are coming off a campaign which saw them go 9-7-2 overall with an impressive 7-3-2 mark against teams in the Big West. Seven starters and 17 letterwinners return to the fold with visions of a Big West championship and the first-ever NCAA Division I postseason appearance in the crosshairs.

• Head coach **Dwayne Shaffer's** offense is led by a prolific duo in junior **Quincy Amarikwa** and sophomore **Paul Marcoux**. Amarikwa led the club a year ago in goals (9) and points (19), while Marcoux was second in scoring with six goals and 13 points. The departure of Mariano Arrua and his team-best six assists certainly leaves a void in the midfield, but the Aggies boast six returnees who tallied two or more helpers in 2006 led by junior **Dan Campbell** (0 g, 4 a) and senior **Nicholas Lind** (1 g, 3 a).

• UC Davis was a solid defensive club that allowed 24 goals in 18 matches for an average of 1.3 per game. Besides being a frequent contributor to the offense, senior **Paul Cain** (3 g, 2 a) has been a reliable asset on the backline, starting 55 straight matches for the Aggies. Juniors **Jordan Vanderpoorten** and **Jake Mogelson** combine with Cain to form a backline capable of repelling opposing offenses.

• Goalkeeping is the major question for Coach Shaffer's club heading into 2007. Gone is Charles Warne, who started all 18 matches and compiled a 1.19 goals against average. The lone returnee with playing experience from a year ago is senior **Brian Wickers**, who played in five matches and made three saves. Wickers will have stiff competition from incoming freshmen **Ryan McCowan** and **R.J. Smith**.

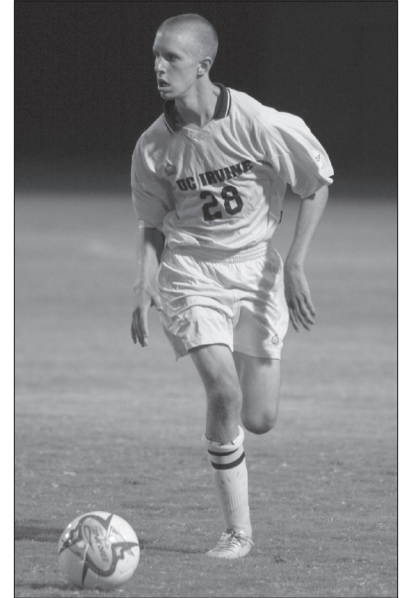
• UC Irvine aims to replicate the success it enjoyed last season when it went 13-4-3 and 6-3-1 in the Big West. The 13 victories set a single-season school record, while the six conference wins was just one off the school mark. The Anteaters face an uphill battle to replicate that success as they return just five starters, 14 letterwinners and one of their eight 2006 All-Conference selections to the pitch in 2007.

• UCI must find a way to replace the offensive exploits of Brad Evans and Anthony Hamilton. Evans is the Anteaters' all-time goals king and is tied for the top spot in points, while Hamilton recorded back-to-back 20-point seasons to close out his collegiate career.

• Junior midfielder **Matt Murphy** will be the player head coach George Kuntz relies on to lead the UCI attack. The 2006 Midfielder of the Year and first team All-Big West selection had a coming out party last season as he ranked second in the Big West in goals (10) and points (25) and tied for sixth in assists (5). With graduation robbing the Anteaters of five of their six top point-producers, finding someone else to emerge as a goal scoring threat will add diversity to the UCI attack.

• Graduation also took its toll on the defense as stout defenders such as Cameron Dunn, Doug Franco and Sergio Rivera will no longer don the blue and gold. The Anteaters will be expecting senior **Brandon Foster**, junior **Kevin Sias** and sophomore **Kevin Santora** to help fill the void created by the departures.

• The biggest loss on the defense side was first team All-Big West goalkeeper Kenny Schoeni, who was named Big West Co-Goalkeeper of the Year during his lone season in the conference. Senior **Eric Reingen**, junior **Greg Larson** and freshman **Pat Barton** will vie for the starting nod between the pipes. Larson was the lone player among the trio to see any time last season, playing in three matches with one start.

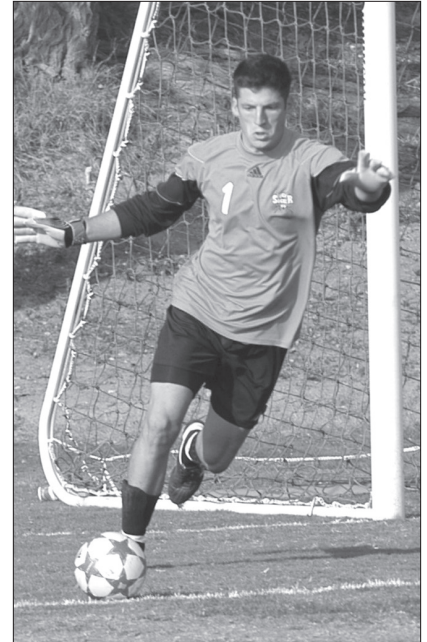

• UC Riverside looks to bounce back in 2007 after a rough season a year ago. The Highlanders went 5-13-1 overall with a 2-7-1 record in conference play. The 13 losses marked the most defeats for UCR in a season since its inaugural Big West campaign in 2001. UCR looks to improve in 2007 behind the return of a league-high 10 starters and 20 letterwinners.

• The youth of the Highlander roster is evidenced by the fact that 14 of their 25 players are either freshmen or sophomores. Despite their youth, UCR posted two impressive victories last season, a 3-2 win over NCAA Tournament participant San Diego State and a 1-0 win over defending national champion UC Santa Barbara. The win over the Gauchos was the first in the history of the program.

• With the return of virtually its entire starting lineup, UC Riverside hopes to improve its goal output from a year ago. Senior midfielder **Brandon Plummer** tied defenseman **Nathan Paterson** for the lead in goals with four. Senior forward **Andrew Villalobos** (2g, 5a) and sophomore forward **Michael Galland** (2g, 2a) aim to improve their offensive outputs to give UCR more options on the attack.

• **Charles Alamo** bounced back in a big way in 2006 after missing all but three matches in 2005 due to injury. The senior started all 19 matches for the Highlanders, posting a 1.93 goals against average, 80 saves and shutting out three opponents. He was also in net for all 1,769 minutes and 14 seconds of the 2007 UCR season.

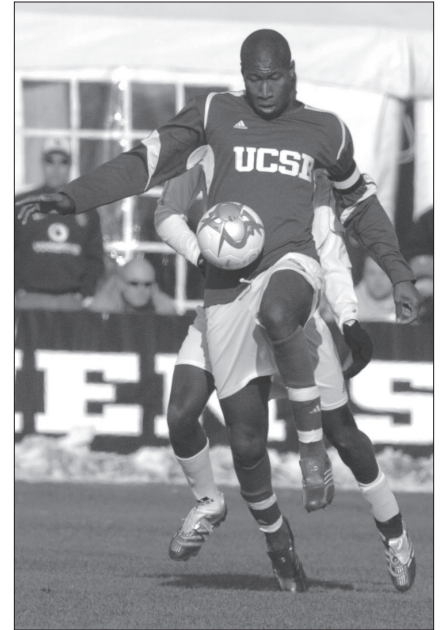

• UC Santa Barbara enters 2007 as the defending NCAA champion after a tournament run in 2006 that was as impressive as it was improbable. The Gauchos are well equipped for another Big West title and deep tourney run with the return of seven starters and 15 letterwinners to go along with a nationally acclaimed recruiting class.

• While the losses of offensive stars like Bryan Byrne and Tyler Rosenlund hurt, UCSB returns plenty of talent on the offensive end. Highlighting the returnees is All-America junior midfielder **Eric Avila** (8g, 5a) and the 2006 College Cup Most Outstanding Offensive Player junior **Nick Perera** (7g, 4a). Sophomore **Bongomin Otii** (6g, 1a) burst onto the scene a year ago with five goals in his first five games, while senior **Andrew Proctor** (1g, 3a), junior **Chris Pontius** (1 g, 2 a) and transfer **Ciaran O'Brien** (6g, 4a) give the Gauchos plenty of offensive firepower.

• Defensively, the discussion begins with senior **Andy Iro**, one of the best defenders in the nation. He is the only GaUCHO to collect All-America honors in each of his first three seasons, is a two-time Big West Defensive Player of the Year and was the 2006 College Cup Most Outstanding Defensive Player. He has also been named to the Hermann Trophy Watch List in back-to-back seasons. UCSB also has stout defenders in seniors **Greg Curry** and **Brennan Tennelle** and junior **Alfonso Motagalvan**. Keep an eye on sophomore **Jon Curry** and freshman **Michael Boxall** on the backline as well.

• For the first time in head coach Tim Vom Steeg's career, he will not have an established goalkeeper between the pipes. The loss of first team All-Big West and All-College Cup selection Kyle Reynish leaves redshirt freshman **Bryant Rueckner** and sophomore **Jason Badger** competing with incoming freshman **Kristopher Minton** for the job in goal. It will likely be a fierce competition as neither of the two returnees played a minute in goal last season.

## 2006 SEASON RECAP

### UC Santa Barbara Defeats #8 Seed UCLA for 2006 Men's Soccer National Championship

Despite playing less than 24 hours after defeating second-seeded Wake Forest on penalty kicks, UC Santa Barbara defeated #8 seed UCLA, 2-1, for the 2006 men's soccer national championship.

The Gauchos showed no early signs of fatigue as they controlled play from the start. **Nick Perera** scored his third goal of the tournament in the third minute for a quick 1-0 advantage. **Eric Avila** added his third goal in the 60th minute for a 2-0 and the Gauchos turned to their defense and the steady play of 2006 Big West Co-Goalkeeper of the Year **Kyle Reynish** to keep the advantage.

UCLA scored in the 79th minute to cut the lead to 2-1, but the Gauchos tightened up behind the play of **Andy Iro**, Reynish and a heads up clear off the goal line by Alfonso Motagalvan to claim the championship.

UCSB's title is the first in its men's soccer history and just the second national championship in school history. The 1979 men's water polo squad is the only other team in Gaucho history to claim a national crown. The Gauchos also became the first unseeded team since the 2000 Connecticut Huskies to win the NCAA crown and just the fourth west coast team since 1990 to claim the championship.

Perera was honored as the Most Outstanding Offensive Player, while Iro claimed Most Outstanding Defensive Player honors. Both players were joined on the All-Tournament Team by **Tyler Rosenlund**, **Bryan Byrne**, Reynish and Avila.

UC Irvine was not extended a bid to the NCAA Tournament despite a second place finish in the competitive Big West Conference. The Anteaters went 13-4-3 overall, establishing a program record for victories, and 6-3-1 in conference play. Senior forward **Brad Evans** became the all-time goals king at the school (31) and is tied for the top spot in points (73). UCI also took home a lot of individual hardware as Evans was named the Player of the Year, **Matt Murphy** the Midfielder of the Year, **Kenny Schoeni** the Co-Goalkeeper of the Year and **George Kuntz** the Coach of the Year. The Anteaters also tied for the top spot in All-Big West selections with eight.

Cal State Northridge had a down season by Matador standards as CSUN finished the year in third place with an 8-6-5 record overall and a 5-2-3 mark in conference play. The third place showing marked the lowest conference finish for the Matadors since a fourth place standing in 2001. The five ties also was one off the conference single-season record set by UC Irvine in 2001 and just the second time in conference history a team has finished with five draws. CSUN also placed eight players on the All-Big West teams, tying for the most in the conference. They were led by **Sean Franklin** who claimed the second first team All-Conference nod of his career.
