Invesco QQQ: A history of leadership and performance

Invesco QQQ is a #1 ranked exchange-traded fund (ETF) by Lipper that tracks the Nasdaq-100® Index.

Since 1999, QQQ has demonstrated impressive performance, diversification and cost savings to investors.

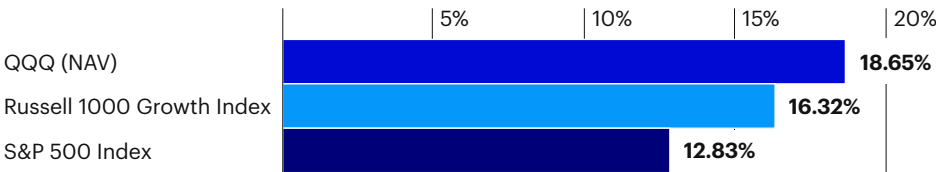

The Lipper one-year rank 65% (438 of 676), five-year rank 2% (9 of 601), 10-year rank 1% (4 of 477), 15-year rank 1% (1 of 361) as of June 30, 2024. **Lipper fund percentile rankings are based on total returns, excluding sales charges and including fees and expenses**, and are versus mutual funds, ETFs and funds of funds in the category tracked by Lipper.

The Morningstar one-year rank 50% (608 of 1162), three-year rank 8% (54 of 1092), five-year rank 3% (12 of 1019), 10-year rank 1% (4 of 794) as of June 30, 2024. **Morningstar rankings are based on total return, excluding sales charges and including fees and expenses** versus all funds in the Morningstar category. Open-end mutual funds and exchange-traded funds are considered a single population for comparison purposes. Had fees not been waived and/or expenses reimbursed currently or in the past, the ranking would have been lower. **Morningstar ratings are based on a risk-adjusted return measure that accounts for variation in a fund’s monthly performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance.**

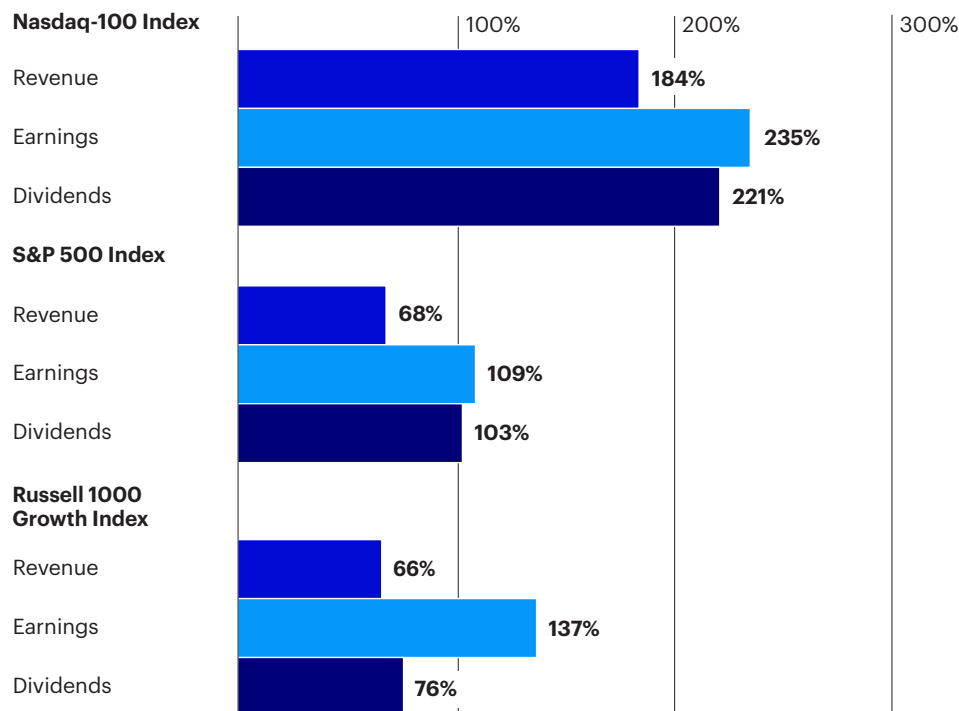

04 Cost savings

QQQ delivers large-cap growth exposure to relevant trends and industry disruptors.

- **Low fees.**¹ In a world changing by fee-based initiatives, QQQ's efficient structure provides a low expense ratio. Total expense ratio is 0.20% as of June 30, 2024.
- **The value of volume and liquidity.**² QQQ is the second most actively traded ETF in the US.³ The tradability of QQQ offers greater intraday liquidity, which may lead to cost savings and increased investment flexibility, allowing investors to buy and sell shares on an exchange.
- **Tax efficiency.**⁴ QQQ's in-kind structure helps mitigate the risk of capital gains distributions.
