



The key to "enable" business domains is by clarifying roles and responsibilities and ensuring knowledge and skills are in place.





By 2028, the data management markets will converge into "a single market" around data ecosystems enabled by data fabric and GenAl reducing technology complexity.



Data Ecosystems: Driven by Commoditization

- High commoditization shifts focus away from individual components.
- Data ecosystem adopters interact only with the outer business practices layer.
- Competitive landscape shifts to orchestration and optimization, not individual puzzle pieces.

You are in the driver's seat for Al-ready data. It doesn't replace "traditional" data management tasks, it adds to it.




Recommendations

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
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
