At this morning's Corporate and Industry Networking Breakfast, **Mitsubishi Hitachi Power Systems President and Chief Executive Officer and CMU alumnus Paul Browning** announced the release of the 2018 [Carnegie Mellon Power Sector Carbon Index](#).

During his lunchtime keynote, **David Danielson, managing director for Science at the Bill Gates-backed Breakthrough Energy Ventures (BEV)** mentioned his coalition of investors from across the world created a billion-dollar fund that will support BEV in its ventures to support cleantech investments. These projects will reduce at least half a gigaton of greenhouse gases during every year of BEV's operation.

Day 2's agenda also featured the CMU Scott Institute Faculty SEED Funding Showcase, the CMU Energy + Cleantech Investor Forum and Startup Fair, four brilliant panels, two notable speakers, an energy-themed monologue competition, plus CMU Sustainability Weekend's opening showcase.
