Fountain Partnership Ltd has a working partnership with an Ukrainian marketing agency.
Fountain Partnership has a supplier who is based in Ukraine. The supplier is focused on providing digital marketing services, MarTech SaaS, EduTech, and B2C solutions. Ukraine is classified as a conflict-affected country based on World Banks 2023 classification.
Fountain Partnership started working with this supplier in June 2022, and since then have commissioned work totalling 0.57% of the company's total annual revenue.
As per the OECD, conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or international law.
Fountain Partnership established a first communication with their Ukrainian to understand their situation, check initial diligence on how they work, and to set up a good working relationship, feedback structures and trust based collaboration. Fountain, since then, has assigned one person who conducts regular checks with the supplier and conducts the quality assurance before the work is submitted to clients. Fountain Partnership informs their clients that they are working with people in Ukraine.
N/A
Fountain does not engage in this partnership for profit, but to support those fleeing war. Their supplier is now working closely with agencies like Fountain Partnership in other parts of Europe as an outsourcing partner. This helps people who have suddenly become refugees to continue to have income and stability of employment - which in turn supports their mental health and wellbeing, and prospects for returning to normal life when the conflict ends. The company understands that the majority of the supplier's employees are now working remotely from safe countries. Fountain is proud that they have been able to help their partner retaining employment opportunities and continuing to pay salaries in spite of the war.

Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Fountain Partnership does not have a formal screening policy for their clients in controversial industries. The company informally assess each new client and project on case-by-case basis. The founders discuss potential controversial clients based on the requested work and the clients' services. Fountain Partnership refuses to work in projects that they believe could contribute to negative social and environmental impacts.
