Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Clients in Controversial Industries

Topic	Company has clients in the fossil fuel industry
Summary of Issue	Modo Energy Limited sells a subscription service providing users with access to data and research on the energy storage market in Great Britain. Its offering includes historic, real-time, and projected data on the performance and revenues of energy storage assets (batteries), updates on changes in the energy market, and educational materials for those new to the industry. The company has reported having clients in the fossil fuel industry.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the company's last fiscal year, it earned 31% of its annual revenue from clients in the fossil fuel industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth.
Implemented Management Practices	 The company supports the transition to net zero energy systems, so it exists to help those companies in the energy industry (including its fossil fuel clients) to understand the business case outside of fossil fuels, Modo Energy Limited does not undertake any due diligence of its clients.

Issue Date	Ongoing
Topic	Modo Energy Limited has suppliers located in Ukraine
Summary of Issue	The company sells subscription services providing users with access to data and research on the energy storage market. Modo Energy Limited outsources software development services from Tier 1 suppliers based in Ukraine, a country listed as a conflict zone in the Global Conflict Tracker and List of Fragile and Conflict-affected Situations (2023).
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	35% of the company's expenses are related to this specific supplier located in Ukraine. The supplier based in Ukraine is now registered in Switzerland and has moved its headquarters to that location.
Impact on Stakeholders	Conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or international law. The security of the company's suppliers who work in such areas could also be at risk.
Implemented Management Practices	 Prior to engaging with the supplier, the company undertook a full technical and commercial tender, reviewing other similar suppliers, Before travel restrictions due to coronavirus and the subsequent conflict with Russia, members of the company's senior management regularly traveled to Kyiv to interface with the supplier's team, The supplier's employees are involved in the day-to-day work at Modo Energy, so there are multiple daily calls with various teams regarding operations and product development, and Modo Energy Limited also has regular conversations with the supplier's senior management team around resourcing, salaries, benefits, and well-being of their employees, The supplier has agreed to and signed the company's
	The supplier has agreed to and signed the company's Corporate and Social Responsibility Agreement, which



	confirms that they keep accurate financial records, have anti-corruption practices in place, and have policies to manage their social and economic impact on local stakeholders and communities.
