	Clients operating in the For-profit higher education industry represented 0.0724% of the company's FY2023 revenue. The company no longer serves this industry.
	Clients operating in the Pharmaceuticals industry represented 0.0724% of the company's FY2023 revenue.
	Clients operating in the Prison industry was through a one-off engagement in FY2023 representing 0.058% of the company's revenue. The company no longer serves this industry.
	Clients operating in the Recreational Marijuana industry represented 0.0052% of the company's current year revenue. The company no longer serves this industry.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.

### **Management Practices**

Client Screening Policy to evaluate potential clients who approach them from industries considered controversial. The decision to work with a client is based on a set of criteria that takes into account the client's industry, their Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) practices, and their potential negative impact on society. The evaluation process includes screening questions, background checks, and a comprehensive risk assessment. The company's risk assessment includes an evaluation of how the client's operations could negatively affect the company's reputation, client relationshipss or the broader community (including whether their business model encourages harm, unethical behaviour or public distrust).

In addition, the company has established the following client exclusionary list:

- -Illegal activities;
- -Tobacco and E-cigarettes;
- Weapons and Armament Manufacturers;
- Private Gambling Operations;
- -Companies with a History of Significant Harmful Practices.

Employees involved in the client intake process will undergo training on the Client Screening Policy and every year will receive a refresher course to review any updates to the policy.
