



## DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

<b>TOPIC</b>	The company works with clients in the agroproducing industry on an ongoing basis.
<b>SUMMARY OF ISSUE</b>	<p>Agrosmart generates insights from collecting real-time data from sensors, satellites, and farmer interactions, and provides intelligence to support decision-making across the agriculture supply chain in Latin America, including Brazil.</p> <p>Agrosmart provides solutions that help farmers adopt better practices, increasing their yield, reducing inputs and water use, and avoiding greenhouse gas emissions. The data also allows farmers and corporations to communicate with their stakeholders with more transparency. Thus, by promoting traceability, they capture a value that generates extra income; the increase in income and improved efficiency in the same land also contribute to avoiding deforestation.</p>
<b>SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE</b> (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	More than 90% of the company's revenues comes from clients in the agriculture industry.
