Issue Date	Ongoing
Торіс	Compulsory testing on animals in order to sell medical devices in the US.
Summary of Issue	SW Sustainability Solutions specializes in manufacturing and R&D of hand health technologies, selling medical grade gloves. As medical devices fall under the jurisdiction of the US Food & Drug Administration (FDA) in order to be sold in the US, the company is required to obtain a 510K approval; a premarket submission made to the FDA to demonstrate that the device is safe and effective. As part of this submission, the company is required to test the device with Biocompatibility in accordance with ISO 10993 for skin sensitization, irritation, and toxicity.
	Animal testing is outsourced and carried out by an accredited and certified laboratory.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2022, 97% of the company's total revenue came from grade gloves, products that had to be tested. The company's last animal testing was conducted in 2019.
Impact on Stakeholders	Animal testing and experimentation is widely used to develop and test the safety of new healthcare products. Many of these experiments can cause pain to the animals involved or reduce their quality of life in other ways.
Implemented Management Practices	SW Sustainability Solutions carries out animal testing as there is a standard alternative recognized by the FDA for these products. The company does not carry out any unnecessary animal testing outside the scope of the regulatory requirements of the FDA. The testing are carried out under ISO 10993 Standards which is a standard accepted and recognized by the FDA. This testing is required by the FDA for medical devices (including medical gloves) that come into direct contact or indirect contact with the human body in order to determine the potential for an unacceptable adverse biological response resulting from contact with the component materials of the device with the body.

	SW Sustainability Solutions chooses accredited and ISO 17025-certified laboratories to carry out animal testing. This means that they have a quality management system in place for their procedures. The laboratories the company chooses to work with also comply with Good Laboratory Practice Regulation (21 CFR, Part 58- see link below) covering animal treatment testing facilities.
	The test standard the company uses also specifies animal welfare requirements. Before each test is conducted a copy of the test protocol is provided for the company to review.
	The company does not currently have a public position statement regarding animal testing and is open to feedback or stakeholder concern, however as it is understood that FDA's 510K process requires animal testing, there has been no concern from customers.
