Biophilia. noun – “An innate and genetically determined affinity of human beings with the natural world.”

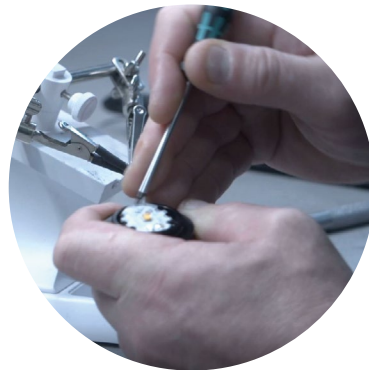

Motor parts and first lights sold in London.

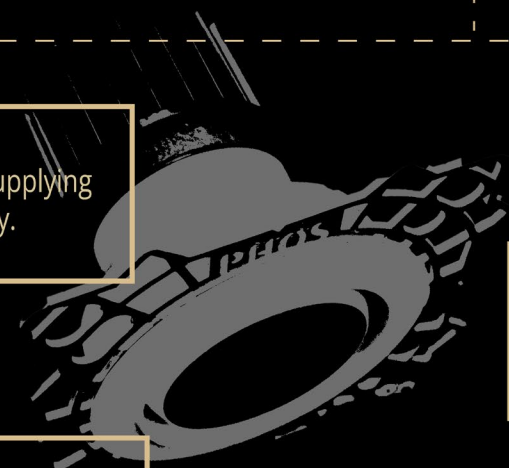


1930s
