Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Litigation

Issue Date	2021
Topic	Consumer Contract Error
Summary of Issue	Due to an error by a staff member of the company, several electricity contracts were not submitted on the British Gas portal. Once this was highlighted, the energy crisis meant that the company was unable to rectify the situation until the energy market was open for business. This meant the new energy price that the company could obtain for the client was significantly higher than the quoted rate. The company was liable for the difference as the error was caused by their employee. The total value of the claim was paid in full by the company's insurer and the company has retained the client who has subsequently renewed their energy contract.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Financial implication: payment of > 5% of the company's total revenue.
Impact on Stakeholders	There was a potential financial impact to the consumer.
Resolution	The case has been closed and the corresponding settlement has been paid in full by their insurers.
Management Practices	The company has since reviewed their processes and has not had similar issues since.

Торіс	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Business Cost Reduction Associates Ltd is a consultancy firm with a focus in the area of Energy and Net Zero solutions. The company helps clients with energy use reduction, control consumption, control emissions and reduce costs. They calculate scope 1, 2 and 3 carbon emissions and work with clients to build a carbon reduction plan.
	The company has had clients from the Alcohol, Animal Products/Services, Fossil-Fuel (non coal/oil-sands) and Nuclear Power or Hazardous Materials industries which are deemed controversial by B Lab. The services provided to the clients relate to providing energy procurement services, which includes gas and renewable energy together with support for Streamlined Energy Carbon Reporting (SECR) .
	The services provided to the clients can be sold to other clients in different industries, including other both non-controversial and controversial industries, although it is tailored from client/industry to client/industry based on the energy usage/need for the business operations.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the fiscal year end of 2023, the company had earned 4.4% of total revenue from clients in the alcohol industry, 1.7% of total revenue from clients in the animal products/services industry, 3.8% of total revenue from the fossil-fuel industry and 1.5% from clients in the nuclear power or hazardous materials industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.



Implemented Management Practices

Business Cost Reduction Associates currently does not have a formal position on working with particular sensitive industries or a policy to move away from them.

In terms of client screening processes, the company's key practice is to review prospective clients' policies as part of their onboarding process.
