Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Sale of Data

Topic	Civitech Sale of Data
Summary of Issue	Civitech is a public benefit corporation that builds solutions for candidates, activists, and local/state governments to ultimately improve access to government services. Their tools provide a streamlined process for registering to vote, requesting a vote-by-mail ballot, and getting the information voters needed to show up to the polls.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	15% of revenue is generated from selling data to third parties.
Impact on Stakeholders	Voter data is purchased from state Secretary of State offices and other publicly available sources. Customers work with the Civitech sales team to identify the data set of interest (geography, demographic, registration status), and then this data is shared with the customer as a CSV that can be imported into a mapping, texting or other tool. The company shares this data for the purposes of voter contact to help people register and vote during elections.
Implemented Management Practices	Civitech complies with state and national regulations on data privacy. The company does not sell data outside of the US nor do they sell regarding EU residents; however, do model their data policies on GDPR regulations. Civitech's privacy policy can be found on their webpage: https://civitech.io/privacy-policy/ The company ensures the protection of user data as all data is encrypted at rest, data access controls are routinely audited, and all third-party vendors must go through a security and legal audit before approval. Staff are also required to complete periodic security and compliance training. The company also has a Data Protection Officer to ensure the correct and safe handling of data.
