Торіс	Litigation and Arbitrations related to environment and employees
Summary of Issue	Pending case: During the acquisition of a subsidiary, a self-report was opened with ARPAT (regional agency responsible for the environment protection). The sampling plan was delivered to the Municipality for remediation and it was approved. The company is in the process of carrying out the analyzes of these samples. The remediation plan has been presented. Settled case: During the acquisition phase of a subsidiary, an underground tank was found that was no longer used and had to be removed. Both cases are from 2022.
	Settled cases: Numerous cases through the period of 2019 to 2024. Insubordination against managers, unfair hiring process, conciliation following the termination of contracts, unpaid social contributions, claims related to existing employment relationships, accidents that caused a permanent damage to an employee's finger, and wrongful termination of contracts.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	For the 2 cases related to the environment: 1 case is still pending the financial amount associated with the case is yet to be determined and the settled case is estimated to have amounted to less than 1% of the company's total annual revenue.
	For the 49 cases (in 5 years out of 7 different legal entities part of the group) related to employees, the company had spent 1-5% of total annual revenue in settlement.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	The primary impact in the cases were related to the environmental health and safety of the employees and financial impact to the employees.
Resolution	For the cases related to the environment, 1 case is pending, and the second one has been settled with a payment. All cases have been closed and settled with payments to the workers.
Implemented Management Practices	Pending case in relation to environment: To speed up the resolution, company has presented a remediation plan. Settled



case in relation to environment: Timely intervention and centralized management of all facility management by qualified Corporate personnel.

Resolution of the specific cases through payment and implementation of the 231 form (internal and confidential policies) to avoid future cases.
