Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Recalls

Issue Date	Recall in 2020, 2021 and 2022
Topic	Recalls
Summary of Issue	 KoRo had 8 product recalls between 2020 and 2022: For the year 2022: Organic cashew butter: Incorrect allergen warning indicated on the packaging. Organic date hazelnut cream: The presence of mold. Organic Cassia Cinnamon: Exposure to ethylene oxide. Organic hazelnut butter: Incorrectly labeled products For the year 2021: Organic Energy Ball Salted Peanut: Incorrect allergen warning indicated on the packaging. Organic Moringa powder: Exposure to ethylene oxide. Organic smoked tofu almond sesame: Exposure to ethylene oxide. In 2020 and 2021: Organic Tahin 250g and 500g: 3 recalls of various batches due to exposure to ethylene oxides, as part of a wave of recalls in Europe.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	KoRo's total recall percentage represents 0.43% of its sold units between 2020 and 2022.
Impact on Stakeholders	KoRo's recalls were carried out as a preventive measure to protect consumers and to minimise possible health effects on the end consumer. Recalls are supervised and evaluated by local food monitoring organisations. All recalls and mitigation measures are checked by auditors in KoRo's annual IFS audit. There have not been reports of serious adverse effects from consumers with regards to the recalls mentioned. • Severe risks from allergens are relatively low as most products containing potential allergens are clearly labeled. However, products containing nuts and peanuts pose a higher and more critical risk. • Residue contaminants like ethylene oxide and mycotoxins are banned in the EU and require recalls due to potential genotoxic risks. The overall risk is low to



	 medium, with higher concerns for long-term and large-quantity consumption. Recalls prioritizing consumer protection have been made all over Europe, even for contaminants present in small quantities or unevenly distributed. Mold is easily recognisable and does not produce toxins therefore the overall risk is low.
Resolution	KoRo has implemented procedures and conducted analyses following the product recalls. The company follows policies and practices set by food authorities, and all measures taken are reported to the management. KoRo undergoes annual audits by an external accredited certification body for the IFS certificate, and the final report is reviewed and validated by the company management.
Implemented Management Practices	KoRo has implemented a range of ambitious measures. The company takes measures directly and/or with the producer, depending on their contribution to overall prevention. Before taking any measures, the company coordinates with and informs the authorities and certification bodies. All measures had to be accepted by the local food authorities. Regarding ethylene oxide exposure: KoRo increased internal monitoring for ethylene oxide. KoRo requires batch-specific analyses for certain products, such as sesame. KoRo also conducts risk-based investigations for incoming goods. Regarding incorrect packaging: Manufacturing processes have been improved and respective training has been implemented. Raw materials are scanned to validate if they are suitable for the product. Additional protocols for quality checks were implemented. No further issues have occurred. Regarding incorrect allergens warnings: The label was amended to include allergens warnings as required. Regarding mold: KoRo switched the producer and supply chain. New suppliers are closely monitored. No further issues have occurred.

Summary of Issue	KoRo purchases its Fairtrade and Organic mango stripes directly from a tier 1 supplier in Burkina Faso with no intermediaries involved.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Mango stripes from Burkina Faso account for less than 1% of KoRo suppliers' expenditure (data from 2023).
Impact on Stakeholders	Business activities in conflict zones are considered high-risk because they are more likely to cause or contribute to conflict and sociopolitical instability.
Implemented Management Practices	KoRo takes supplier standards seriously. The company requires all their suppliers to complete a questionnaire to confirm their adherence to the ILO core labor standards. Additionally, for certain products such as the Mango stripes from Burkina Faso, KoRo prioritizes environmental responsibility by relying on Organic certification to ensure compliance with environmental standards; and Fairtrade certification for working conditions and fair pay to farmers and workers. To further ensure the quality of KoRo products, the company occasionally and in case of need conducts supplier visits.
